

H1N1 Vaccine Walk-in Community Clinics

Pierce County Public Health Department has scheduled two walk-in community H1N1 vaccine clinics for persons in the targeted high risk groups:

- * Pregnant women
- * Those living with or providing care for children under six months old
- * Healthcare/EMS workers with direct contact with patients or infectious materials
- * Children six months through four years of age
- * Children 5-18 years old with medical conditions placing them at higher risk

These clinics are scheduled for Monday, November 16th from 3-6 p.m. at the Seyforth Building at the Pierce County fairgrounds in Ellsworth and on Thursday, November 19th from 3-6 p.m. at the Saint Bridget Catholic Church Fellowship Hall in River Falls. Due to limited amounts and types of H1N1 vaccine the Wisconsin Division of Public Health has further limited the targeted groups to receive H1N1 vaccine to the above groups. This will likely change as more vaccine becomes available.

Pierce County Public Health Department also also has a limited supply of injectable seasonal influenza vaccine for adults. Any adult wishing to receive a seasonal flu shot should call them at 273-6755 to schedule an appointment.
