The Game

The Falcons and Titans open WIAC play on Saturday at Titan Stadium. This is the only night game of the season for the Falcons. This is the first road game for UW-RF. UWO is off to a perfect 3-0 start. Both UW-RF losses have been to NCAA Div. II opponents. The Falcons haven't won a first WIAC game of the season since 2001 (RF 34, Whitewater 31).

River Falls - Pacific Lutheran Recap

The Falcon football team picked up its first win of the season, 45-14, over Pacific Lutheran at Ramer Field.

RF scored the first points of the game on their second possession. Zeke Secrist capped off a seven play 70-yard drive with a five-yard touchdown run at 8:42. The Falcons led after the first quarter, 7-0.

The Falcons scored the next points of the game on ball control. The Falcons drove 86 yards in 14 plays which was capped off by a 22-yard Dan Keller field goal. On PLU's next possession they took the ball all the way to the RF 15 where Tony Dorner forced an Adam Fallert fumble which was recovered by Matt Jordan. The Falcons took no time in scoring off the turnover. Jeremy Wolff ran 80-yards for an RF touchdown to make the score 17-0 RF at 5:02.

PLU got on the board later in the second quarter going 80 yards in eight plays which was capped off by Matt Steiner's three-yard touchdown run. RF scored the last points of the first half on Ryan Hansen's eight-yard touchdown catch from half-back Andy Kolstad. Kolstad took a pitch and on the halfback option hit Hansen in the end zone. The drive covered 64 yards in seven plays. RF led at the half, 24-7.

The Falcons scored the only points of the third quarter on Nathan Anderson's nine-yard touchdown run at 7:10. RF drove

the ball 42 yards in six plays.

RF continued its dominance of PLU with the first points of the fourth quarter on another Hansen touchdown catch this time from Wolff. The catch was from two-yards out and the drive covered 90 yards in 16 plays. RF scored once again after driving 73 yards in five plays; B.J. LeRoy scored from two-yards out to make the score 45-7 RF at 7:22. PLU got on the board one last time after Chris Maine connected for a 14-yard touchdown pass to Jacob Washburn.

Statistically, RF ran the ball 64 times for a whopping 506 yards. And Falcons with 205 yards and one touchdown. Wolff had 168 yards and one touchdown. Dave Affeldt had 75 yards and Ryan Hansen caught two passes for 10 yards and scored two touchdowns. PLU was led by Chris Maine's 434 yards passing and one touchdown. Craig Chiado caught 11 passes for 218 yards for PLU.

Falcon cornerback Shane Hanson led the Falcon defense with 10 solo and 12 total tackles. Andy Acosta (3-7), Tyler Hasse (3-7) and Jeff Cassellius (2-6) were next for the Falcons in tackles. Cassellius also added a sack. Gregg Neumann had five total tackles with two sacks. Dan Buker and Jesse Osttertag also had one sack each.

Oshkosh - Albion Recap

Andy Moriarty rushed for 130 yards and two touchdowns as the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh built an early lead and cruised to a 27-13 non-conference win over Albion College Saturday (Sept. 17) in Albion, Mich.

The UW-Oshkosh defense held Albion (1-1) to minus-four rushing yards as Ryan Neff recorded two sacks for the Titans. UW-Oshkosh also picked off four passes, including two by Bryan Kent, and recovered two fumbles.

"I think our defense really stepped up," Titans coach Phil Meyer said. "That's kind of the story of the game right there."

The Titans scored on their first three possessions to build a 13-3 halftime advantage. Lucas Raschke hit on field goals of 40 and 30 yards and Moriarty scored from 3 yards out.

The UW-Oshkosh lead moved to 20-3 in the third quarter as quarterback Joe Patek found Nick Kilton for a 32-yard touchdown pass.

Moriarty added another touchdown midway through the fourth quarter to seal the win.

"He had a nice game," Meyer said of his running back. "That was huge."

Besides Moriarty, the Titans were also led by Patek, who completed 8-of-18 passes for 124 yards, one touchdown and two interceptions.

Meyer said he was also pleased with the special teams play of Andy Heiman.

"Andy Heiman stepped up in the return game," Meyer said. "He had a couple of nice returns for 74 yards and that was key for us."

The victory gives the Titans (3-0) a perfect non-conference record for the third year in a row. It also was UW-Oshkosh's 11th straight non-conference win.

"To come out of there 3-0 is what our goal was and what we expected," Meyer said. "Now it's time to put the gloves on. Now comes the fun part and hard part of the season."

UWRF At Ramer Field

The Falcons are 26-21 at Ramer Field since 1995. The Falcons last winning season at Ramer Field was in 2000, when they went 3-1. In conference play, the Falcons are 22-13 at Ramer Field since 1995, with their last winning season in 2001, when they finished 2-1. The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in conference play.

UWRF On The Road

The Falcons are 25-28 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play. The Falcons are 20-18 on the road in conference play since 1995. In 1999 and 2000 the Falcons finished with 3-1 records on the road in conference play.

UWRF At Neutral Sites

The Falcons are 4-1 at neutral sites since 1995. They have not played a neutral site game since 2000, when they lost to Bemidji State at the Metrodome, 23-20.

UWRF Football History

The first year of Falcon football was in 1895 when the team finished with a 2-0 record after playing and beating New Richmond High School twice. The first game against a collegiate team was in 1899 when the Falcons lost to Superior, 12-0. It wasn't until 1923 when the Falcons started playing only collegiate teams. UW-RF has won 18 WIAC titles, third most of all WIAC institutions. The Falcons have a 470-304-49 record in 103 seasons.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is in his 17th year as head coach at UW-RF and stands second in all-time football wins.

Under O'Grady the Falcons have compiled an 90-70-3 overall record, a winning percentage of .561. Among WIAC active coaches he is third in wins and is eighth in all-time wins of all WIAC coaches. He needs just six wins to reach the seventh spot. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 16 seasons with the Falcons.

Year-in and year-out the Falcons are one of the top teams in the

WIAC under the veteran coach. In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14). In 1999 the Falcons were 6-4 and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

Last season the Falcons finished a disappointing 3-7 overall and 3-4 (fifth place tie) in the WIAC. In 2003 the Falcons were 2-7 overall and 2-5 (sixth place) in league play. In 2002 UWRF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in WIAC play (sixth place). The Falcons finished 4-5 overall and 4-3 (tie third place) in the WIAC in 2001. In 2000, the Falcons were 6-4 overall and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 59-46-3 record in WIAC play. O'Grady combines his vast football knowledge and intensity to help the Falcons succeed.

O'Grady, 52, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UW-RF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UW-RF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 166 of 167 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching, business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UW-RF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UW-RF for 32 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, special teams coach of the Baltimore Ravens, has been a counselor for 28 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has spoken at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 15 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football clinic in Gilman, Wis. The clinic was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 24, Jaelyn, 21 and Logan 18. Lindsey, a UW-RF graduate, teaches social studies and coaches volleyball and track & field at the Mauston middle school. Jaelyn is a senior at the University of Minnesota and will graduate in December, 2005 with a degree in film studies. She plans on going to graduate school. Logan will be a freshman at the University of St. Thomas this fall and will compete in cross country and track & field.

Last Season

UW-O 28, UW-RF 25

The Falcons lost a 28-25 decision to UW-Oshkosh Saturday afternoon (Oct. 30) at Ramer Field.

After trailing all of the game, the Falcons grabbed a 25-21 lead with 6:49 to play. But UWO took the ensuing kick off and drove 81 yards in eight plays to get the go-ahead touchdown to get the win.

The Falcons trailed 12-3 at the half. UWO opened the scoring at 9:34 of the first quarter when Aaron Chaltry scored on a one-yard run. The point after kick failed. The Falcons got to within 6-3 with 1:34 to play in the half when Spasimir Bodurski kicked a 41-yards field goal. But UWO took the kick off and drove 78 yards in eight plays to score. Joe Patek caught a two-yard touchdown pass from Nick Wara for the score. The Titans took just 1:09 off the clock. The extra point kick attempt was blocked.

The Falcons got to within 12-10 at 11:40 of the third quarter. Nathan Anderson scored the touchdown on a 15-yards run. UWRF drove 78 yards in eight plays and took 3:13 off the clock. UWO responded with a 15 play, 65 yards drive that took 4:58. Wara scored on a four-yard run and once again the UWO point after kick attempt was blocked, giving UWO an 18-10 lead with 6:36 to play in the third quarter.

The Falcons responded by scoring the next time they had the ball. John Peterlik raced 50 yards to score and finished a five play, 85-yard drive that took just 2:16. Peterlik ran in the two-point conversion to tie the game, 18-18, with 4:14 to play in the third quarter.

With 12:17 to play in the game, UWO's Lucas Raschke kicked a 25-yard field goal to give the Titans a 21-18 lead. The field goal capped a 19 play, 69-yard drive that took 6:52 off the clock. The Falcons took back the lead with 6:49 to play in the game when Peterlik scored his second rushing TD of the game on a one-yard run. With the point after the Falcons led 25-21. That drive took 11 plays and went 61 yards in 5:21.
