The Games

-The Falcons enter the second to last weekend of the WIAC season hosting UW-Eau Claire on Wednesday and then traveling to UW-Whitewater on Saturday.

-UWRF will try to get back on the winning track this week. After two wins two weeks ago, the Falcons lost both games last week. The Falcons dropped a 63-49 decision at home to UW-Stout and a 70-56 game at UW-Platteville. Hans Hoeg continues to lead the Falcons in scoring averaging 17.4 points a game. He is tied for second in the WIAC in scoring. He is also the top rebounder with a 4.5 average. Ryan Zylstra is second in scoring (8.8) and third in rebounding (3.9).

-UWEC is 3-3 in its last six games. Saturday the Blugolds step out of WIAC play and topped Finlandia, 90-84, in overtime. Jared Bardon is the leading scorer and he is sixth in the WIAC with a 14.6 per game average. Zack Ryan is second averaging 11 points a game. UWEC doesn't have a rebounder in the top 10 in the WIAC - Matt Riley is the leader (4.7) and he is 13th in the conference.

-UWW has won four of its last five games including a 91-63 win over UW-Superior on Saturday. UWW is one of the top teams in the WIAC. The Warhawks enter the week tied for second place and just a half game out of first. Jeremy Manchester leads UWW in scoring averaging 12.7 points a game. Andy Freund is the top rebounder averaging 5.8 per outing.

River Falls - Previous Week Recap

At home on Wednesday against UW-Stout the Falcons lost a 63-49 WIAC decision to the Blue Devils. Erik Olson had a career high 14 points to lead the Falcons. He was 5-9 from the field, including 4-6 from behind the arc. Ryan Thompson led the Falcons with five assists and he had two steals and three points. Mark James led the Falcons with six rebounds and he scored four points. UWS held a 50-25 advantage in rebounds.

At UW-Platteville on Saturday Hans Hoeg led the Falcons once again, scoring a game-high 23 points. He finished the game shooting 5-13 from the field, 4-7 from beyond the arc and 9-12 from the line. Entering the contest Hoeg was second in the WIAC in scoring, averaging 17.2 points per game. Ryan Zylstra was the only other Falcon in double digits, adding 13 points and a team-high six rebounds. Ryan Thompson led the Falcons with seven assists.

Head Coach - Rick Bowen

Rick Bowen begins his 20th season as the UW-River Falls basketball coach in 2005-06.

He will be the first to admit that his lengthy tenure surprises him as much as anybody. "I originally came here thinking I would stay a maximum of five years and move on, but the University and the community have been so good to me that it has just turned into 20 years.

"This is a very special place. I am allowed to teach and coach. I am allowed to live a life doing what I love to do. The University administration has its priorities in order. I have really come to respect basketball at the Div. III level. To have the opportunity to coach basketball at the highest of levels in the WIAC and UW-River Falls is a privilege."

Bowen currently is seventh all time in the WIAC win column. His 259 victories at UW-River Falls put him first all-time in Falcon victories. Combining his head high school and collegiate wins, Bowen is approaching the 400 win total for his career.

The 2003-04 season will go down in history as the season that ended 54 years of Falcon basketball frustration. The Falcons hit the 20-win mark for the first time since the 1950 season and brought the elusive WIAC championship home to Karges Center, the campus and the city of River Falls. He was named the WIAC basketball Coach of the Year award and his peers also selected him as the NABC West Region Coach of the Year.

This was not the only national recognition Bowen and the Falcons received. The NABC named 6-8 Rich Melzer as the Div. III National Player of the Year and a first team All-American for the second consecutive year. Melzer is now playing professionally for a team in New Zealand in the Australian professional league.

Success has not come easy for Bowen and UW-River Falls. The 2005-06 season begins the 94th season of collegiate basketball for the Falcons. The University sports an overall 883-927 record for a .490 win/loss percentage. Bowen is currently 259-234. Since the turn of the new century the Falcons have been 89-52 finishing 1st, 3rd, 3rd, 4th and 5th in the nation's most competitive basketball conference.

The seven consecutive winning seasons from 1989 to 1996 was a stretch that was last equaled in the 1915-22 Falcon basketball seasons. Bowen's Falcons made school history for the 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th time by landing a spot in the NAIA District 14 playoffs in 1987, 1990, 1991 and 1992.

"I know we have struggled at times. I make no excuses. We are what we are. We play in Karges Center, a sub-par facility. We lack the historical perspective of some of our competitors. I have enjoyed taking the kids that want to come to River Falls to get a good education, and play basketball, and make us competitive. We have been consistently good, and I am very proud of that."

In the 2004-05 academic year Bowen's responsibilities increased as he was named the permanent UWRF Athletic Director, He is the only coach in the WIAC doing double duty serving as a coach and Director of Athletics.

Bowen came to UW-RF in 1986 following five years as a Wisconsin Badger assistant coach where he served on the staff with current Badger Coach Bo Ryan. He previously was an assistant coach at Ball State University, working under Coach Steve Yoder at both institutions.

Bowen graduated from Indiana University with an undergraduate degree in physical education in 1966. He served the Hoosiers as a student-manager under two time National Champion Coach Branch McCracken. Like his father, son Matthew was a basketball manager at Indiana University under Coach Bob Knight. Basketball runs deep in the Bowen family. Grandfather Vernie Bowen was an Indiana High School coach for 40 years. Nephew Christopher is currently the basketball manager at the United States Military Academy under Coach Jim Crews. Nephew Andrew Bowen is currently the basketball manager at Bethel College in Mishawaka, Indiana.

Bowen began his career in Indiana teaching government and coaching basketball. He earned a Masters degree from St. Francis in 1971. He served in the United States Army as a combat medic from 1967-69 with service in Vietnam from December of 1967 to December of 1968. For his actions in Vietnam he was awarded a Bronze Star.



Rick and his wife Sandy met as students while at Indiana University. They have been married for 39 years and have two sons. Sandy is retired after teaching cell biology and botany at River Falls High School. Matthew is assistant basketball coach at Valparaiso University and married to Birmingham, Ala., native Ashli. They have a daughter, McKenzi, 3, and reside in Valparaiso, Ind.



Mike and his wife Pam, a UWRP graduate in marketing communications and former Falcon tennis player from Monticello, Minn., own and operate Bowen's Garage on Main Street in River Falls. Pam also works in the Graduate and Outreach department at the University. Mike is a graduate of Dakota County Technical School.

UW-River Falls vs. UW-Eau Claire -- Last Meeting

Dec. 7, 2005 at Eau Claire, Wis.

Eau Claire 57, River Falls 56

The Falcon dropped a 57-56 WIAC game at UW-Eau Claire on Wednesday night. With 12:27 remaining in the game the Falcons held a their largest lead at 51-32, but Eau Claire outscored River Falls 25-5 in the last 12 minutes to win the game.

Hans Hoeg led the Falcons with 21 points, while picking up six rebounds. Cory Rondeau played well in his first collegiate start, scoring 10 points on 5-6 shooting. Rondeau and Mark James led the Falcons with seven rebounds each.

The Falcons opened the first half on fire. The Falcons shot 58 percent (14-24) from the floor, 75 percent (6-8) from three point range and 100 percent (4-4) from the free throw line. The Falcons entered the half with a 34-20 advantage.

In the second half the Falcons turned the ball over 13 times, shot 39 percent (7-18) from the field, 31 percent (4-13) from beyond the arc and did not attempt a free throw. With 8:25 remaining in the game the Falcons held a 16 point advantage, but after a lay-up and three consecutive three-point baskets in the following two minutes the lead was dwindled down to five. Rondeau scored to give the Falcons a seven point lead with 5:53 remaining, this was the last time the Falcons would score. In the last 5:30 the Blugolds outscored the Falcons 8-0. Dan Ottney scored the game winning basket with 27 seconds remaining to give the Blugolds the win.

Jared Bardon led Eau Claire with 20 points, with 13 points coming in the second half.

The Falcons outrebounded their opponent for the first time since their WIAC Champion season in 2003-2004. The Falcons finished with 21 turnovers, while forcing 10.

UW-River Falls vs. UW-Whitewater -- Last Meeting

Whitewater 76, River Falls 65

The Falcons lost a 76-65 decision to UW-Whitewater Saturday afternoon at the Karges Center.

The Falcons, now 2-11 overall and 1-4 in the WIAC, grabbed a 2-0 lead just 20 seconds into the game when Ryan Zylstra hit a jumper. The Falcons would lead only one more tie in the game - that came with 15:23 to play in the first half when Hans Hoeg scored on a lay up to give the Falcons an 8-7 lead. UWW led by as many as five (17-12) with 10:22 to play in the first half, but the Falcons cut the lead to one (17-16) when Hoeg hit two free throws and Zylstra scored on another jumper. But then UWW went on a 10-0 run to take a 25-16 lead with 7:06 to play in the first half. UWW led 34-31 at the end of the first half. Whitewater led by as many as 15 twice in the second half - the first, 53-38, with 12:51 to play and the second, 60-45, with 10:17 to go. UWRf got as close as nine (70-61) with 1:50 to play when Hoeg hit two free throws.

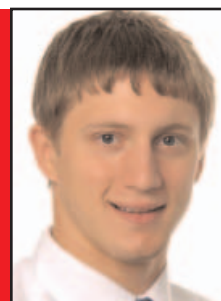
