The Game

The Falcons will try to get back on the winning track when they travel to UW-Stevens Point for a WIAC game on Saturday at Goerke Field. Both UWRP and UWSP lost WIAC games last weekend. UWRP lost at home to UW-Eau Claire (21-11) and UWSP lost at home to Whitewater (44-12).

- * UWRP holds a 35-26-3 lead in the all-time series. UWRP won last year's game, 24-22, at Ramer Field in the final game of the 2004 season. Both teams' longest winning streak is six games - the Falcons from 1971-76 and the Pointers from 1960-67. Before last year's UWRP win, UWSP had won three straight games.
- * UWRP is averaging 21.8 points a game and allowing 21.2. The Falcons are sixth and fifth in the WIAC respectively. UWSP averages 14.6 and allows 32.8 points a game and are eighth in both categories in the WIAC.
- * UWRP's Nathan Anderson is 16th in the NCAA Div. III in rushing yards per game (140.2).
- * UWRP's Jovin Kroll is ranked 35th in punting in the NCAA Div. III (39.0).
- * UWSP's Brandon Cszys is ranked 25th in total tackles (58) in the NCAA Div. III.
- * UWRP is ranked No. 9 in rushing offense in the NCAA Div. III averaging 293.4 yards per game.
- * UWRP is ranked No. 28 in team net punting (34.08), and UWSP is ranked No. 29 (33.97) in the NCAA Div. III.
- * UWRP is +2 in turnover margin - UWSP is -3 in turnover margin.
- * UWSP leads the WIAC averaging 15 yards per punt return.
- * UWRP leads the WIAC in red zone defense allowing opponents to score 70 percent of the time.
- * UWRP leads the WIAC in third down conversions (39-85), .459.

River Falls - Eau Claire Recap

The Falcon football lost its first WIAC game of the year, 21-11, to UW-Eau Claire Saturday afternoon.

The Blugolds took the opening possession and drove 80 yards in nine plays. Tony Hull capped off the drive with a five-yard touchdown catch from Jesse Krzyzanowski. After a Falcon punt, Eau Claire came right back on its next drive scoring again on a Krzyzanowski pass to Hull - this time from seven-yards out to make the score 14-0 after the first quarter.

RF got on the board early in the second quarter on Spasmir Bodurski's 21-yard field goal capping off a 15-play 67 yard drive. On their very next possession the Blugolds stormed down the field and scored again on a one-yard Joe Gast touchdown run. The drive was 10 plays covering 75 yards. UWEC led at the half, 21-3.

In the third quarter RF was driving the ball and got it all the way to the UWEC 18 when Jeremy Wolff fumbled and Eau Claire's Nate Jahn recovered. There was no third quarter scoring.

The Falcons scored the only points of the fourth quarter on Chris Anderson's 13-yard touchdown catch from Wolff. Dave Affeldt added the two-point conversion to make the score 21-11. The drive covered 85 yards in 10 plays. That ended the scoring.

RF was led by Nathan Anderson's 44 rushes for 232 yards on the ground - both were career highs. Wolff chipped in with 34 yards on the ground and one touchdown pass. Chris Anderson led the team with 34 yards receiving and one touchdown catch.

UWEC was led by Krzyzanowski's 183 yards passing and two touchdowns. He completed 15 straight passes to start the game. Gast led the team on the ground with 78 yards on 22 carries along with one touchdown. Hull had seven catches for 63 yards and two touchdowns.

Falcon cornerback Matt Jordan led the Falcon defense with six solo and 11 total tackles. Tony Dorner (3-10), Andy Acosta (4-9) and Shane Hanson (7-8) were next for the Falcons in tackles. Jeff Cassellius also added a sack for the Falcon defense.

Stevens Point - Whitewater Recap

A challenging five-game stretch is finally over for the UW-Stevens Point football team, culminating in a 44-12 loss to UW-Whitewater on Saturday in Stevens Point.

Battered with injuries and playing its fourth highly ranked foe in the first five games, the Pointers surrendered the most yards they've ever allowed in a single game. The Warhawks amassed 663 total yards as running back Justin Beaver had a career high for the second straight game with 212 yards on 34 carries and Derek Stanley totaled 143 yards receiving on four catches – all in the first quarter.

Stevens Point played without its top three running backs and suffered several more injuries on the afternoon. The eighth-ranked Warhawks continued their strong first half play by building a 20-0 halftime advantage and have now outscored their five opponents 133-22 in the first half. It was a complete turnaround from Whitewater's last visit to Goerke Field when the Pointers led 39-0 at the half in a 60-30 victory.

Whitewater scored touchdowns on its first two possessions as Stanley caught a 14-yard pass from Justin Jacobs on the first drive and Beaver broke loose for a 34-yard score to push the lead to 14-0.

The teams traded interceptions and the Warhawks finished off a big first quarter as Jacobs took the snap with one second remaining and fired a 53-yard pass to Stanley to the Pointers' 15-yard line, setting up a 32-yard field goal by Mike Chaulk. The Warhawks gained 236 yards on 19 plays in the first quarter. Chaulk added a 39-yard field goal midway through the half for a 20-0 advantage.

Another Chaulk field goal from 24 yards opened the second half and Beaver scored on a one-yard dive with 24 seconds left in the third quarter for a 30-0 lead.

Stevens Point mounted most of its offense in the fourth quarter, going 67 yards in five plays and scoring on a six-yard run by Eric Reible. After UW-Whitewater added a pair of touchdowns, the Pointers got another score on a one-yard sneak by quarterback Brett Borchart with 5:18 remaining.

Stevens Point finished with 255 total yards as Reible gained 54 yards on 15 carries. Jacob Dickert had 61 yards receiving on three catches.

Jacobs finished 16-for-28 passing for 316 yards and two touchdowns for UW-Whitewater. Jim Leszczynski added four catches for 95 yards. The Warhawks' 663 yards surpassed UW-Stevens Point's previous record of 612 yards given up against UW-River Falls on Oct. 29, 1983.

John Miech

In 17 seasons at UW-Stevens Point, head coach John Miech has over twice as many victories as any other coach in school history with a 114-60-2 record, which ranks fifth on the conference's all-time wins list.



Miech, having completed his 23rd year with the coaching staff, is coming off his 20th .500 or better season in the last 21 years. He has won three WIAC championships in the past seven years and earned the WIAC Coach of the Year award in 1998 and 2001.

Miech's association with Pointer football actually goes back to 1972 when he first joined the program as an offensive lineman, providing protection for the nation's top passing offense in both 1973 and 1974.

Along the way, he has developed numerous players who went on to play in the NFL, CFL, AFL and European leagues. Most notable among those players is Clint Kriewaldt, who was drafted in the sixth round by the Detroit Lions in 1999 and is currently beginning his seventh year in the NFL with the Pittsburgh Steelers. Others include Barry Rose, who had stints with both the Buffalo Bills and Denver Broncos, Kirk Baumgartner, a draft choice of the Green Bay Packers and Pete Lucas, a draft pick by the Atlanta Falcons.

In 1975, following graduation with a degree in physical education, Miech began his coaching career with a three-year stint as an assistant with the Pointers before moving on to Stephen F. Austin State University. There, he served as a graduate assistant for the Lumberjacks while working on his master's degree, which he received in 1979.

Miech returned to Wisconsin in 1979 and served as the head coach at Whitnall High School and then Jefferson High School for three seasons each before returning to UW-Stevens Point in 1985 as the defensive coordinator. As defensive coordinator with the Pointers, his unit allowed just over 275 yards per game and four yards per play in three seasons to lead the conference.

Miech and his wife, Sheila, who serves as the head coach of the highly-successful Pointer women's soccer program, have two sons. His son, Jesse, is a soccer player at Morningside College, and his son, Ryan, is a junior hockey player.

UWRF At Ramer Field

The Falcons are 26-22 at Ramer Field since 1995. The Falcons last winning season at Ramer Field was in 2000, when they went 3-1. In conference play, the Falcons are 22-14 at Ramer Field since 1995, with their last winning season in 2001, when they finished 2-1. The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in conference play.

UWRF On The Road

The Falcons are 26-28 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play. The Falcons are 21-18 on the road in conference play since 1995. In 1999 and 2000 the Falcons finished with 3-1 records on the road in conference play.

UWRF At Neutral Sites

The Falcons are 4-1 at neutral sites since 1995. They have not played a neutral site game since 2000, when they lost to Bemidji State at the Metrodome, 23-20.

UWRF Football History

The first year of Falcon football was in 1895 when the team finished with a 2-0 record after playing and beating New Richmond High School twice. The first game against a collegiate team was in 1899 when the Falcons lost to Superior, 12-0. It wasn't until 1923 when the Falcons started playing only collegiate teams. UW-RF has won 18 WIAC titles, third most of all WIAC institutions. The Falcons have a 471-305-49 record in 103 seasons.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is in his 17th year as head coach at UW-RF and stands second in all-time football wins.

Under O'Grady the Falcons have compiled an 91-71-3 overall record, a winning percentage of .560. Among WIAC active coaches he is third in wins and is eighth in all-time wins of all WIAC coaches. He needs just six wins to reach the seventh spot. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 16 seasons with the Falcons.

WIAC under the veteran coach. In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14). In 1999 the Falcons were 6-4 and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

Last season the Falcons finished a disappointing 3-7 overall and 3-4 (fifth place tie) in the WIAC. In 2003 the Falcons were 2-7 overall and 2-5 (sixth place) in league play. In 2002 UWRF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in WIAC play (sixth place). The Falcons finished 4-5 overall and 4-3 (tie third place) in the WIAC in 2001. In 2000, the Falcons were 6-4 overall and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 60-47-3 record in WIAC play. O'Grady combines his vast football knowledge and intensity to help the Falcons succeed.

O'Grady, 52, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UW-RF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UW-RF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 166 of 167 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching, business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UW-RF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UW-RF for 32 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, special teams coach of the Baltimore Ravens, has been a counselor for 28 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has spoken at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 15 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football clinic in Gilman, Wis. The clinic was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 24, Jaclyn, 21 and Logan 18. Lindsey, a UW-RF graduate, teaches social studies and coaches volleyball and track & field at the Mauston middle school. Jaclyn is a senior at the University of Minnesota and will graduate in December, 2005 with a degree in film studies. She plans on going to graduate school. Logan will be a freshman at the University of St. Thomas this fall and will compete in cross country and track & field.

Statistical Comparisons

Last Season

UW-RF 24, UW-SP 22

The Falcon football team (3-7, 3-4) ends the season on a high note crushing the conference title hopes of Stevens Point (6-4, 4-3) with a 24-22 victory. With a win the Pointers would have gotten at the least a piece of the WIAC title. River Falls controlled the game by controlling the ball for almost twenty more minutes than the Pointers. Stevens Point battled from 14 points down in the second half to pull within two with seven minutes to play. The Pointers found themselves losing by two because of a missed extra point by freshman kicker John Ryan and then a failed two point conversion.

UWRF had a total of 377 yards on 73 plays while UWSP racked up 409 yards on 74 plays. The Falcons ran the ball 71 times for 351 yards while the Pointers threw the ball 49 times for a total of 307 yards. Each team turned the ball over once, Stevens Point threw an interception while the Falcons lost one of their two fumbles. Both teams were solid on third downs, the Pointers were 7-17 while RF was 8-16. River Falls played a gutsy game kicking two onside kicks, recovering one and going for it on fourth down three times converting two of them. UWSP didn't convert their only fourth down attempt.

Stevens Point scored four out of five times in the red zone while the Falcons capitalized on their only two trips.

Senior John Peterlik led the Falcons in his final game at Ramer Field with 168 yards on 24 carries and two touchdowns. He also completed two passes to senior receiver Corey Strinmoen, one on a two point conversion and one third down for 26 yards late in the game. Wide out Tony Romano was Borchart's favorite target catching 10 balls for 109 yards and a TD.
