The Game

The Falcons end their 2005 campaign at UW-Whitewater on Saturday. UWRF will be looking to end the season on a high note - much like in 2004 when the Falcons beat UW-Stevens Point, 24-22, on the last Saturday of the season. UWW is in first place in the WIAC and is undefeated in nine games this year. The Warhawks have clinched at least a tie for the WIAC Championship and a spot in the NCAA Div. III playoffs. UWW will be looking to end the season undefeated - equaling the 1997 Warhawk team that finished the regular season undefeated with a 9-0 record.

* UWRF is averaging 19.9 and allowing 23.5 points a game. The Falcons are seventh in scoring offense and sixth in scoring defense in the WIAC.

* UWRF has had nine 100+ and three 200+ rushing performances. Jeremy Wolff rushed for 136 vs. Platteville, 207 at Stevens Point, 168 vs. Pacific Lutheran and 161 vs. Bemidji. Nathan Anderson has rushed for 156 vs. Platteville, 230 vs. Eau Claire, 168 vs. Pacific Lutheran, 115 vs. Bemidji and 145 vs. Stout.

* UWRF's Nathan Anderson has reached the 1,000 yard rushing mark. He has 1,167 this year. The UW-RF record is 1,585 by Jim Baier set in 1966. Anderson is 13th in the NCAA Div. III in rushing yards per game (129.7).

* UWRF is ranked No. 1 in the WIAC in rushing offense (287.3). UWW is ranked No. 1 in 13 of the WIAC's 30 team statistic categories; including scoring offense (42.7) and scoring defense (14.0).

* UWW's running back Justin Beaver, quarterback Justin Jacobs and wide receiver Jim Leszczynski are among the leaders in several categories in the WIAC. Beaver is the top rusher in both the NCAA Div. III and the WIAC (177.2 yards per game) and is No. 4 in scoring (98 points). Jacobs leads in passing (247.1 yards per game) and total offense (252.3) and Leszczynski leads in receiving yards per game (98.2).

* UWRF is ranked No. 6 in rushing offense (287.3) in the NCAA Div. III.

* UWW is No. 4 in total offense (526) and No. 9 in scoring

River Falls - La Crosse Recap

The Falcons lost their fourth conference game of the year, 40-25, to UW-La Crosse Saturday afternoon at Ramer Field.

RF scored the first points of the game on a Spasmir Bodurski 38-yard field goal. The drive covered 52 yards in 12 plays. Later in the first quarter UWL got on the board with a two-yard John Schumann to Dustin Esser touchdown pass to make the score 7-3 UWL. The drive covered 74 yards in 17 plays. After a Matt Jordan fumbled kick return, La Crosse scored another touchdown four plays later on a two-yard Kevin Schultz touchdown run. The extra point was blocked and returned all the way for two points by Joey Simonson. The score after the first quarter was 13-5 UWL.

After a Gregg Neumann blocked punt at the UWL 14-yard line, the Falcons capitalized with a four-yard Jeremy Wolff touchdown run to pull the Falcons to within 13-11. Two-point conversion failed. The drive covered 14 yards in four plays. That was how the first half ended.

The Eagles wasted little time scoring in the third quarter, taking the opening possession for a touchdown which was capped off by an 11-yard Schumann to Eric Kettenhofen 11-yard pass. The drive covered 72 yards in 12 plays. UWL added one more touchdown in the third quarter on a Corey Celdernick 14-yard touchdown run to put UWL ahead, 25-11.

RF scored the first points of the fourth quarter on a four-yard Nathan Anderson touchdown run to make the score 25-17. The extra point was missed. The Eagles put the game away on their very next possession scoring on another Schumann touchdown pass this time to Jason Wagner from four-yards out. Two-point conversion was good. The drive covered 59 yards in seven plays.

After a Wolff fumble at the UWL 35, the Eagles scored again on a 23-yard Steve Tennes to Scott Swanson touchdown pass. The drive covered 35 yards in five plays. The Falcons scored the last points of the game on a Wolff to Josh Grover 12-yard touchdown pass. The drive covered 68 yards in eight plays. That got the Falcons to within 40-25, but that was all the scoring for the day.

RF was led by Anderson's 95 yards on the ground and one touchdown. Wolff chipped in with 76 yards and one rushing touchdown. He also added 48 yards passing and one touchdown. UWL was led by Schumann who had 214 yards and three touchdowns. Kettenhofen had six catches for 55 yards and one touchdown to lead the Eagles.

On defense the Falcons were led by Robby Nesvig who had eight solo and eight assisted tackles. Ryan Agrimson (4-11), Tony Dornier (4-5), and Dan Buker (3-6) were next for the Falcons in tackles.

Whitewater - Stout Recap

The University of Wisconsin-Whitewater defeated UW-Stout 32-10 at Williams Stadium in Menomonie Saturday afternoon, clinching sole possession of the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference championship and earning the leagues automatic berth in the National Collegiate Athletic Association Division III championship playoffs.

UW-W, ranked second, second and fourth in the three national Division III polls, improved to 9-0 overall and 6-0 in the WIAC. UW-Stout is 6-3 overall and 3-3 in league play.

The WIAC championship is Whitewater's 26th, the seventh since Bob Berezowitz became head coach in 1985, and the first since 1998.

Whitewater's 9-0 record is the schools best since 1997, when the Warhawks ended the regular season 9-0. UW-W lost in the first round of the NCAA III playoffs that year to wind up 9-1. 1997 was also the last time that UW-W went undefeated in league play, which it will attempt to duplicate next week. Also at stake next week, a ten-game win streak (10-0) in one season, which the 1990 team accomplished. That team went 10-1, losing in the NCAA playoffs to the University of Saint Thomas (MN).

UW-W trailed in the game at Stout 10-0 at the end of a quarter and 10-7 at the half. The only other time that Whitewater trailed in a game this season was a 9-7 deficit in the third quarter at UW-La Crosse.

Warhawk tailback Justin Beaver rushed 47 times for 207 yards, the third time this season he has gone over 200 yards. It is the 22nd 200+ yard rushing game in UW-W history, and only Spencer Johnson (four) has more 200 yard games in his career. Beavers 1,418 yards this season is the sixth highest total in the school record book, and two TDs today bring his season total to 16, third best all-time.

Quarterback Justin Jacobs passed for 103 yards, which give him 2,224 this season, just 31 yards shy of breaking current UW-W head coach Bob Berezowitz's record, set in 1966. Jacobs also moved in to second place in the record book with his 22nd TD toss of the season, equaling the total Ty Grovesteen threw in 1988.

Senior wide receiver Jim Leszczynski also moved into the upper echelons of the record book, with his three catches for 66 yards moving him to fifth place for career receiving yards with 1,191 yards, ahead of Jerry Young (1,863 1997-99) and Roger Gename (1,875 1973-75). Leszczynski has 884 yards this season, third all-time.

has been head football coach at UW-Whitewater since 1985. Some of Berezowitz's accomplishments are WSUC/WIAC championships won - 1987, 1988, 1990, 1994, 1997, 1998;



WSUC/WIAC Football Coach of the Year five times; Wisconsin College Coach of the Year 1997; American Football Coaches Association Regional Coach of the Year two times; NCAA playoff appearances - three; Member of UW-Whitewater Hall of Fame, NAIA District 14 Hall of Fame, and Wisconsin Football Coaches Association Hall of Fame.

Berezowitz is ranked second in games won among Whitewater football coaches. Berezowitz was a standout quarterback during his days with the Warhawks. He still has two school records and is tied for first in two others. He guided the Warhawks to a second place finish in America in 1966 when Whitewater played Waynesburg, PA in the NAIA championship game.

During his standout year of 1966, Berezowitz was selected Associated Press Small College All-American. Berezowitz continued his football career in the Central United States Football League (semi-professional football), being named the MVP of the league in 1968.

Berezowitz was not only a star quarterback but he was selected as an all-American in baseball as a catcher while at Whitewater. He had opportunities to sign professional baseball contracts but decided to become a coach instead. During his tenure at Whitewater his teams have always been in title contention winning six conference championships. UW-W football players have earned a total of 45 all-American honors as well as numerous all-conference honors under Berezowitz's tenure. Bob, Stan Zweifel, and Brian Borland, wrote a book on Whitewater's zone offense, and he has a video tape on the market dealing with quarterback fundamentals.

Bob's wife, Jan, has retired from working for the Whitewater school district as the gifted and talented program coordinator. They have four children Dan, a former UW-W quarterback, Steve, Becky and Bonnie.

UWRF At Ramer Field

The Falcons are 27-23 at Ramer Field since 1995. The Falcons last winning season at Ramer Field was in 2000, when they went 3-1. In conference play, the Falcons are 22-15 at Ramer Field since 1995, with their last winning season in 2001, when they finished 2-1. The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in conference play.

UWRF On The Road

The Falcons are 26-30 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play. The Falcons are 21-18 on the road in conference play since 1995. In 1999 and 2000 the Falcons finished with 3-1 records on the road in conference play.

UWRF At Neutral Sites

The Falcons are 4-1 at neutral sites since 1995. They have not played a neutral site game since 2000, when they lost to Bemidji State at the Metrodome, 23-20.

UWRF Football History

The first year of Falcon football was in 1895 when the team finished with a 2-0 record after playing and beating New Richmond High School twice. The first game against a collegiate team was in 1899 when the Falcons lost to Superior, 12-0. It wasn't until 1923 when the Falcons started playing only collegiate teams. UW-RF has won 18 WIAC titles, third most of all WIAC institutions. The Falcons have a 472-308-49 record in 103 seasons.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is in his 17th year as head coach at UW-RF and stands second in all-time football wins.

Under O'Grady the Falcons have compiled an 92-74-3 overall record, a winning percentage of .553. Among WIAC active coaches he is third in wins and is eighth in all-time wins of all WIAC coaches. He needs just six wins to reach the seventh spot. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 16 seasons with the Falcons.

Year-in and year-out the Falcons are one of the top teams in the

WIAC under the veteran coach. In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14). In 1999 the Falcons were 6-4 and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

Last season the Falcons finished a disappointing 3-7 overall and 3-4 (fifth place tie) in the WIAC. In 2003 the Falcons were 2-7 overall and 2-5 (sixth place) in league play. In 2002 UWRF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in WIAC play (sixth place). The Falcons finished 4-5 overall and 4-3 (tie third place) in the WIAC in 2001. In 2000, the Falcons were 6-4 overall and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 60-47-3 record in WIAC play. O'Grady combines his vast football knowledge and intensity to help the Falcons succeed.

O'Grady, 52, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UW-RF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UW-RF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 166 of 167 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching, business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UW-RF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UW-RF for 32 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, special teams coach of the Baltimore Ravens, has been a counselor for 28 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has spoken at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 15 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football clinic in Gilman, Wis. The clinic was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 24, Jaclyn, 21 and Logan 18. Lindsey, a UW-RF graduate, teaches social studies and coaches volleyball and track & field at the Mauston middle school. Jaclyn is a senior at the University of Minnesota and will graduate in December, 2005 with a degree in film studies. She plans on going to graduate school. Logan will be a freshman at the University of St. Thomas this fall and will compete in cross country and track & field.

The River Falls football team (1-5, 1-2) didn't give the Ramer Field crowd much to cheer for in the home opener with a 42-3 loss to Whitewater (6-1, 3-1). The Warhawks warmed up quickly in the frigidly cold temperatures scoring on their first two possessions of the game and returning a blocked punt for a touchdown to go up 21-0 by the end of the first quarter. UW-W had a 28-3 lead at halftime and held the Falcons to 60 total yards in the second half to secure the win.

The Warhawks were led on the ground by WIAC rushing leader Colin Burns. The sophomore gained 152 yards on 24 carries and had one touchdown. Burns backfield mate Keiya Square had three touchdowns, all in the first half, to go with 33 yards on eight rushes. Square led the Warhawks in receiving with two catches for 37 yards. Sophomore quarterback Justin Jacobs was 5-9 for 78 yards and a TD. Whitewater was 5-6 in red zone scoring opportunities.

The River Falls offense couldn't get it going all game long against the WIAC's top rated rush defense. The RF offense was 2-13 on third downs and 1-3 on fourth downs. Punter Jovin Kroll had six attempts with an average of 27.5 yards a punt. The Falcon offense coughed the ball up four times, only losing two. Senior John Peterlik led the Falcons with 132 yards on 18 carries. Freshman fullback Nathan Anderson snapped his two game 100 yard plus rushing streak, only gaining 56 yards on 17 attempts. Sophomore QB Andy Kolstad ran the ball 17 times for 41 yards.
