## The Game

The Falcons host UW-Eau Claire Saturday at Ramer Field in the second WIAC game of the season. Both teams opened WIAC play last weekend with the Falcons winning in overtime at Oshkosh, 13-10, while Eau Claire dropped a 28-7 decision at Whitewater. Two of UW-RF's losses have been to NCAA Div. II teams while UW-EC has lost three times to teams ranked in the NAIA (St. Francis) and NCAA Div. III (St. John's, Whitewater).  
\* UW-EC will be going for a fourth straight win over UWRF.  
\* The UWEC offense has averaged 37.6 points a game in the last three games between the teams - all UWEC wins.  
\* UWRF is averaging 24.5 points a game and UWEC is allowing an average of 24.5 points a game. Both teams have scored 13 touchdowns.  
\* Before now, the last time UWRF has won two straight games was late in the 2002 season. The last time UWRF has won three straight games was late in the 2000 season.  
\* UWRF is ranked No. 9 in rushing offense in the NCAA Div. III averaging 289.8 yards per game.  
\* UWEC is ranked No. 16 in team net punting (36.26), and UWRF is ranked No. 23 (35.0) in the NCAA Div. III.  
\* UWEC's Tony Hull is ranked No. 34 in receptions per game, 6.8, and No. 29 in receiving yards per game, 101, in the NCAA Div. III.  
\* UWRF is +2 in turnover ratio - UWEC is -3 in turnover ratio.  
\* UWRF's Jovin Kroll leads the WIAC in punting - but has a very narrow lead over UWEC's Mitch Schaeuble. Kroll averages 39.7 and Schaeuble 39.6. Kroll is ranked No. 24 and Schaeuble is No. 26 in the NCAA Div. III.  
\* UWRF's Gregg Neumann is tied for second in the WIAC with three sacks.

## River Falls - Oshkosh Recap

Spasimir Bodurski kicked a 33-yard field goal to help lift the Falcons to a 13-10 overtime win at UW-Oshkosh.

The team's second win of the season came in a come-from-behind fashion at Titan Stadium.

After a scoreless first quarter, UWO got on the board first with a Tyler Jandrin one-yard touchdown plunge. He capped off a 14-play, 57-yard drive.

UWRF responded right before halftime on Chris Anderson's five-yard touchdown catch from Jeremy Wolff with just :09 to play. The drive was 10 plays covering 72 yards.

Halfway through the third quarter UWO got on the board again - this time on Raschke's 26 yard field goal at 7:59 to give the Titans a 10-7 lead. The field goal capped off an eight-play 27-yard drive. That was the only scoring of the third quarter.

The Falcons fought back once again this time scoring with under two minutes left in the fourth quarter on a Bodurski 21-yard field goal with 1:51 left in the game. It capped off a four-play, eight-yard drive. The Falcons took control of the ball after Andy Acosta intercepted a pass to give the Falcons a first down at the UWO 12.

UWO took the ensuing kick off and the Falcon defense came up with another big play. Defensive tackle Arron Retzlaff sacked the Titan quarterback and forced a fumble that was recovered by Ryan Agrimson at the UWRF 49. The Falcon offense drove to the UWO 36 before the drive stalled. But Bodurski's 53-yard field goal fell short and the game moved into overtime.

The Falcons played defense first in the overtime. On a first down play at the UWRF 25, Dan Buker dropped a Titan back for a three-yard loss. Two incomplete passes followed and the Titans attempted a 45-yard field goal that missed wide left.

The Falcons then got the ball at the UWO 25 and two running plays by Nathan Anderson netted seven yards and a Jeremy Wolff run added two more yards. Bodurski's 33 yard field goal won the game.

RF was led by Nathan Anderson's 87 rushing yards on 22 carries. Wolff also pitched in with 72 yards on the ground and 84 passing to go along with his one touchdown pass. Chris Anderson led the team with three catches for 33 yards and one touchdown.

Buker led the Falcon defense with eight solo and 10 total tackles. Tony Dorner (4-9), Ben Hogle (3-9) and Agrimson (4-8) were next for the Falcons in tackles. Retzlaff and Gregg Neumann had one sack each.

## Eau Claire - Whitewater Recap

The 19th ranked UW-Eau Claire football team was unable to produce a lot offense today in their 28-7 loss to No. 10 Whitewater.

In a game that was streamed to a national audience via the internet, the Blugolds had a tough time getting the ball deep into Warhawk territory. The Blugolds could only produce 233 yards of total offense, compared to 425 yards for the Warhawks. The Blugolds only had 28 yards of total offense in the first half.

The game started out as a defensive struggle. Neither team produced much offensively in the first quarter, with both teams trading punts. It wasn't until early in the second quarter that the first score took place when the Warhawks' Lance Douglas caught a 35-yard touchdown pass from quarterback Justin Jacobs.

With Whitewater driving again, the Blugolds' defense stepped up as Derek Sikora intercepted the Jacobs' pass, ripping the ball away from the intended receiver. However, the Blugolds could not do anything with the football. The Warhawks then scored just before the half, when Jacobs snuck it in from a yard out to give the Warhawks a 14-0 halftime lead.

Whitewater kept the momentum going early in the third quarter when running back Justin Beaver broke free for a 48-yard touchdown run. The Blugolds finally got on the board late in the third when Jesse Krzyzanowski hit Tony Hull for a 3-yard touchdown pass.

The Blugolds had some momentum going into the fourth quarter only down by two touchdowns, but a Blugold fumble at midfield ended that. The Warhawks then sealed the deal when Beaver rushed it in from 22 yards out.

Jesse Krzyzanowski threw for 169 yards on 19-38 passing with one touchdown and one interception for the Blugolds. Hull had nine catches for 97 yards and one touchdown. Brent Tieri led the Blugolds in tackles with nine.

## Todd Hoffner enters

his seventh season as the UW-Eau Claire head coach. The 2001 and 2002 teams set the school record for winning percentage over a two-year period, going 16-4 over that span (.800). The previous school mark was set by the 1983 and 1984 teams who went 16-5 (.762).

Under Hoffner's tutelage the Blugolds have finished with a .500 or better record over the last five years going 34-16 during that stretch. In three seasons the Blugolds went from 2-8 in 1999 to winning a conference championship in 2001 going 8-2. The 2002 squad posted another 8-2 record highlighted by wins over national semifinalists St. John's (MN) and 2001 NCAA playoff participant Bethel College.

In the spring of 2002 Hoffner led a squad of 42 Blugold players from the 2001 roster to Finland and Sweden for 10 days where they faced two European football teams. The Blugolds defeated the Tyreso Royal Crowns, the Swedish National Champions and a 2002 Euro Bowl participant, by a score of 61-6. The second game saw the Blugolds hold off the Helsinki Roosters by a score of 27-22.

The 2001 Blugolds blossomed under Hoffner's play-calling, leading the conference in passing efficiency, second in passing offense, scoring offense and sacks against while finishing third in total first downs. Individually, quarterback Brian Rasmussen led the WIAC in passing efficiency and ranked second in total offense and passing yards per game. Running back Darrell Souhrada led all WIAC in rushing yards with 1,038 yards despite playing in just seven games in addition to placing second in total touchdowns with 10. Souhrada completed his Blugold career as the school's all-time leader in rushing yards in a career (4,373), season (1,588) and carries in a game (51) while becoming the conference record holder in career rushing yards (3,542), points (240), touchdowns (40) and carries in a game (51).

During his eight seasons at Stevens Point, Hoffner served the last two as defensive coordinator after four years as the offensive coordinator. In 1993 the Pointers were the WIAC's top offensive team in 1993, averaging 441 yards per game (197 rushing, 243 passing). Hoffner's last season in Stevens Point saw the Pointers become one of four teams to share the WIAC championship in 1998 along with the Blugolds, UW-Whitewater and UW-River Falls.

### UWRF At Ramer Field

The Falcons are 26-21 at Ramer Field since 1995. The Falcons last winning season at Ramer Field was in 2000, when they went 3-1. In conference play, the Falcons are 22-13 at Ramer Field since 1995, with their last winning season in 2001, when they finished 2-1. The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in conference play.

### UWRF On The Road

The Falcons are 26-28 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play. The Falcons are 21-18 on the road in conference play since 1995. In 1999 and 2000 the Falcons finished with 3-1 records on the road in conference play.

### UWRF At Neutral Sites

The Falcons are 4-1 at neutral sites since 1995. They have not played a neutral site game since 2000, when they lost to Bemidji State at the Metrodome, 23-20.

### UWRF Football History

The first year of Falcon football was in 1895 when the team finished with a 2-0 record after playing and beating New Richmond High School twice. The first game against a collegiate team was in 1899 when the Falcons lost to Superior, 12-0. It wasn't until 1923 when the Falcons started playing only collegiate teams. UW-RF has won 18 WIAC titles, third most of all WIAC institutions. The Falcons have a 471-304-49 record in 103 seasons.

### Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is in his 17th year as head coach at UW-RF and stands second in all-time football wins.

Under O'Grady the Falcons have compiled an 91-70-3 overall record, a winning percentage of .564. Among WIAC active coaches he is third in wins and is eighth in all-time wins of all WIAC coaches. He needs just six wins to reach the seventh spot. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 16 seasons with the Falcons.

Year-in and year-out the Falcons are one of the top teams in the

WIAC under the veteran coach. In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14). In 1999 the Falcons were 6-4 and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

Last season the Falcons finished a disappointing 3-7 overall and 3-4 (fifth place tie) in the WIAC. In 2003 the Falcons were 2-7 overall and 2-5 (sixth place) in league play. In 2002 UWRF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in WIAC play (sixth place). The Falcons finished 4-5 overall and 4-3 (tie third place) in the WIAC in 2001. In 2000, the Falcons were 6-4 overall and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 59-46-3 record in WIAC play. O'Grady combines his vast football knowledge and intensity to help the Falcons succeed.

O'Grady, 52, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UW-RF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UW-RF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 166 of 167 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching, business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UW-RF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UW-RF for 32 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, special teams coach of the Baltimore Ravens, has been a counselor for 28 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has spoken at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 15 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football clinic in Gilman, Wis. The clinic was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 24, Jaclyn, 21 and Logan 18. Lindsey, a UW-RF graduate, teaches social studies and coaches volleyball and track & field at the Mauston middle school. Jaclyn is a senior at the University of Minnesota and will graduate in December, 2005 with a degree in film studies. She plans on going to graduate school. Logan will be a freshman at the University of St. Thomas this fall and will compete in cross country and track & field.

## Last Season

### UW-EC 35, UW-RF 17

The Falcons (0-4, 0-1) wore down in the second half and lost their WIAC opener 37-15 at Eau Claire (3-1, 1-1). The Falcons gave up 30 points in the second half after giving up a total of seven in the first.

UWRF senior running back John Peterlik capped off a five play 27 yard drive with a one yard TD run to tie the Blugolds at seven with 9:18 to play in the third quarter. From their the Blugolds went on a 30 point streak to seal a 37-15 homecoming victory. Falcon quarterback Dave Affeldt ran a touchdown in from one yard late in the game.

The story to the Blugolds success was junior running back Joe Gast. Gast carried the ball 30 times for 135 yards and four touchdowns. The junior earned the yards the hard way averaging 4.5 yards per carry. EC senior quarterback Nels Fredrickson threw 26 times, completing 16 for 188 yards with one TD and one interception. Wide out Tony Hull had five catches for 55 yards and one touchdown to lead the Blugolds in receiving. On defense Eau Claire held River Falls to 11 first downs and 180 total yards, zero through the air. The Blugold defense had one interception and forced three RF fumbles, recovering all three. Linebacker Jared Roeker led EC with 11 total tackles, seven solo.

The Falcon offense gained all of their 180 yards on the ground. Freshman fullback Nathan Anderson accounted for 100 of those yards on 21 carries. Senior running back John Peterlik fumbled once and was held to 68 yards on 19 carries, but did score one touchdown. Quarterback Dave Affeldt started the game at quarterback and ran eight times for 26 yards and fumbled twice, both lost. Sophomore QB Andy Kolstad alternated under center and completed none of his three passes while gaining a net of negative eight yards on six carries. The RF defense gave up a total of 393 yards but did force three EC turnovers, two fumbles and one interception. Senior safety Matt Farmer made the pick and had nine tackles. Linebacker Ryan Agrimson led the Falcons in tackles with 11 while filling in for injured linebacker Ben Gillett.
