The Game

The Falcons host UW-Platteville in the Homecoming and Hall of Fame game. Eight new members will be inducted into the UWRP Athletic Hall of Fame - Mark Cota (football), Merilee (Healy) Cardinal (gymnastics), Dick Novak (hockey), Chris Stainer (softball), Steve Stocker (cross country, track & field), Keven Syverson (cross country, track & field), Steve Walker (football) and Doris (Hop) Wolf (service).

* UWRP is averaging 18.7 points a game and allowing 23.9. The Falcons are seventh in scoring offense and ninth in scoring defense in the WIAC. UWP averages 21.9 points and allows 34.9 points a game. They rank No. 6 in scoring offense and No. 8 in scoring defense.

* UWRP has had seven 100+ and three 200+ rushing performances. Jeremy Wolff rushed for 207 at Stevens Point, 168 vs. Pacific Lutheran and 161 vs. Bemidji. Nathan Anderson has rushed for 230 vs. Eau Claire, 168 vs. Pacific Lutheran, 115 vs. Bemidji and 145 vs. Stout.

* UWRP's Nathan Anderson needs 84 yards to reach 1,000 this year. He finished 124 yards short of the 1,000 yard mark as a freshman in 2004.

* UWRP's Nathan Anderson is 17th in the NCAA Div. III in rushing yards per game (130.9).

* UWP's Brian Gallick is No. 12 in receptions per game in the NCAA Div. III (7.3). He is first in receptions per game (7.3) in the WIAC.

* UWP's David Pietrowiak is No. 30 in punt return yards per game in the NCAA Div. III (12.7)

* UWRP is ranked No. 7 in rushing offense (288.1) in the NCAA Div. III.

* UWRP is +3 in turnover margin - UWP is -9 in turnover margin.

River Falls - Stout Recap

The Falcons lost for the third week in a row, this time to UW-Stout 38-6 Saturday afternoon at Williams Stadium.

UW-Stout scored the first points of the game on the last play of the first quarter on a Jeremy Wolff fumble, which was returned 22 yards by Stephen Schills for the touchdown. The score after the first quarter was 7-0.

The Blue Devils got on the board halfway through the second quarter on a 35-yard Evan Larson field goal to make the score 10-0. The drive covered 35 yards which took 12 plays. Stout ended the first

half with another touchdown this time on the ground by Andy Reese from 17 yards out at 1:14. The drive covered 66 yards in eight plays.

In the third quarter, Stout took to the air to get into the end zone on a Tanner Katre pass to Jesse Wendt covering 15 yards. The drive covered 55 yards in 12 plays. After a Rob Weinstein interception of Wolff, Katre and Wendt connected for another touchdown this time covering 10 yards. The drive went 31 yards in three plays. The Blue Devils capped off a dominate third quarter on a 69-yard Joe Seep punt return for a touchdown to make the score 38-0 after the third quarter.

RF scored the only points of the fourth quarter on a Nathan Anderson two-yard touchdown run to make the score 38-6. They missed the two-point conversion. The drive covered 82 yards in 11 plays. That ended the scoring.

The Falcons were led by Anderson's 145 rushing yards and one touchdown. Wolff chipped in with 54 on the ground.

UW-Stout was led by Reese's 116 yards rushing and one touchdown. Kattrra had 100 yards rushing and 66 yards passing to go along with his two touchdown passes. Wendt had nine catches for 63 yards and two touchdowns.

Cornerback Shane Hanson led the Falcon defense with eight solo and three assisted tackles. Tony Dorner (1-9), Ryan Agrimson (4-5) and Nathan Renk (3-4) were next for the Falcons in tackles. Renk also added a sack.

Platteville - Whitewater Recap

Sixth-ranked UW-Whitewater beat visiting UW-Platteville 63-28 Saturday in the George Chryst Memorial Bowl.

UW-Whitewater remained undefeated at 7-0 and atop the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference at 4-0, while the injury-riddled Pioneers fell to 1-6, 0-4.

The Warhawks, averaging 42 points and 540 yards per game, raced to a 21-0 lead and held that three-score advantage at the half, 35-14. The Pioneers had a chance to cut the lead to 14 in the third quarter, but fumbled on the UWW 26.

Justin Jacobs threw for 287 yards and a two touchdowns, receiver Jim Leszczynski caught 11 passes for 165 yards and three scores, while Justin Beaver ran for 123 yards and scored three times for the Warhawks, who totalled a school-record 706 yards.

The Pioneers, already missing starting quarterback Brent Nelson for the rest of the season, played without the WIAC's leading receiver, 6-3 Brian Gallick and his 6-6 partner on the other side, Joe Danielson. Leading rusher Mike Haynes also sat out the game with an injury.

In their places, some underclassmen had chances to shine. Freshman Tyson Droessler rushed for 117 yards and three touchdowns, covering 18, 4 and 14 yards. Freshman Chris Zillman led the receivers with seven catches for 103 yards.

Droessler's three rushing touchdowns were the most for the Pioneers since older brother Damian ran for three against UW-Stevens Point in 2003. Damian completed the Pioneer scoring Saturday with a 28-yard halfback option pass to Marcus Ninneman in the fourth quarter.

The George Chryst Memorial Bowl is played in honor of the late Pioneer coach, who compiled a 79-60-2 mark in 1979 until his sudden death in 1992. The assembled media vote upon players of the game, and Tyson Droessler and defensive end Chris Booze earned the Pioneer honors, while Leszczynski and safety Kyle Johnson were the Warhawk honorees.

Booze totalled seven tackles and had the lone sack in the game, a seven-yard loss.

Emendorfer earned the WIAC Coach of the Year Award for 2004, a season in which the Pioneers achieved their first winning record since 1992.

The Pioneers finished 6-4, beating top-20 teams Augustana, Whitewater and Eau Claire. Emendorfer also took his team out to Pennsylvania, where the Pioneers beat Thiel 40-14. Along the way, the team toured Notre Dame and its stadium as well as the Pro Football Hall of Fame.

In his six years, Emendorfer has guided the Pioneers to the most explosive offensive era in the 106-year history of the UWP football program.

The Pioneers have rewritten the record books, establishing 25 school records and breaking 10 Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference marks. In addition, Emendorfer's teams have produced 35 all-conference players, two all-Americans, five academic all-district selections and a WIAC Scholar-Athlete winner. The Pioneers have ranked among the nation's passing leaders in each of the last four years. They finished 15th in 2004.

Excitement has been the trademark of the football program in the last three years, as an incredible 16 games have been won or lost on the final play of the game, with three 2002 games needing overtime. The Pioneers have produced some memorable moments in that time, such as beating WIAC favorite UW-Stout 34-31 in overtime on Homecoming 2002 and topping NCAA Division I Drake 21-20 in 2003 and by 33-23 in 2004. UW-Platteville won two games on the final play in 2004, defeating Augustana 25-23 on a last-second field goal and UW-Eau Claire 20-17, when Emendorfer by-passed a chip shot field goal and went for the win with a successful one-yard touchdown plunge.

Emendorfer came to UW-Platteville from Hanover (Ind.) College, where he had been the offensive coordinator for eight years. During that time, Hanover won three conference titles, produced two NCAA III playoff berths and led the nation in passing four times. The Pioneers repeated that success in 2001 by leading all of NCAA III in passing yardage.

UWRF At Ramer Field

The Falcons are 26-22 at Ramer Field since 1995. The Falcons last winning season at Ramer Field was in 2000, when they went 3-1. In conference play, the Falcons are 22-14 at Ramer Field since 1995, with their last winning season in 2001, when they finished 2-1. The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in conference play.

UWRF On The Road

The Falcons are 26-30 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play. The Falcons are 21-18 on the road in conference play since 1995. In 1999 and 2000 the Falcons finished with 3-1 records on the road in conference play.

UWRF At Neutral Sites

The Falcons are 4-1 at neutral sites since 1995. They have not played a neutral site game since 2000, when they lost to Bemidji State at the Metrodome, 23-20.

UWRF Football History

The first year of Falcon football was in 1895 when the team finished with a 2-0 record after playing and beating New Richmond High School twice. The first game against a collegiate team was in 1899 when the Falcons lost to Superior, 12-0. It wasn't until 1923 when the Falcons started playing only collegiate teams. UW-RF has won 18 WIAC titles, third most of all WIAC institutions. The Falcons have a 471-307-49 record in 103 seasons.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is in his 17th year as head coach at UW-RF and stands second in all-time football wins.

Under O'Grady the Falcons have compiled an 91-73-3 overall record, a winning percentage of .551. Among WIAC active coaches he is third in wins and is eighth in all-time wins of all WIAC coaches. He needs just six wins to reach the seventh spot. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 16 seasons with the Falcons.

WIAC under the veteran coach. In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14). In 1999 the Falcons were 6-4 and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

Last season the Falcons finished a disappointing 3-7 overall and 3-4 (fifth place tie) in the WIAC. In 2003 the Falcons were 2-7 overall and 2-5 (sixth place) in league play. In 2002 UWRF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in WIAC play (sixth place). The Falcons finished 4-5 overall and 4-3 (tie third place) in the WIAC in 2001. In 2000, the Falcons were 6-4 overall and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 60-47-3 record in WIAC play. O'Grady combines his vast football knowledge and intensity to help the Falcons succeed.

O'Grady, 52, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UW-RF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UW-RF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 166 of 167 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching, business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UW-RF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UW-RF for 32 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, special teams coach of the Baltimore Ravens, has been a counselor for 28 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has spoken at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 15 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football clinic in Gilman, Wis. The clinic was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 24, Jaclyn, 21 and Logan 18. Lindsey, a UW-RF graduate, teaches social studies and coaches volleyball and track & field at the Mauston middle school. Jaclyn is a senior at the University of Minnesota and will graduate in December, 2005 with a degree in film studies. She plans on going to graduate school. Logan will be a freshman at the University of St. Thomas this fall and will compete in cross country and track & field.

The Falcon football team came back with a strong second half and earned a 25-21 win at UW-Platteville.

UWRF trailed 21-3 at the half, but the Falcon defense held the Pioneers scoreless and the offense scored 22 second half points.

In the second half the Falcons opened the scoring at 12:36 of the third quarter when John Peterlik caught a 28-yard touchdown pass from Dave Affeldt. The score was set up when Ben Gillett recovered a fumble at the UWP 39. The drive took four plays and covered 39 yards.

The Falcons drew to within 21-18 at 8:24 of the fourth quarter. The Falcons covered 76 yards in nine plays capped by an 18-yard touchdown pass from Andy Kolstad to Corey Strinmoen. Peterlik ran in the important two-point conversion.

The Pioneers took the kick off and drove to the RF 48. On a third-and-eight play at the RF 48, Falcon safety Kyle Hoegh intercepted a UWP pass and gave the Falcons great field position at the Pioneers 44. On the next play Peterlik took a pitch and hit a wide open Strinmoen who walked into the end zone for the winning points. The pass play covered 44 yards and there was 4:19 to play.

The Pioneers went three and out on their next possession and the Falcons worked the final 3:16 off the clock to preserve the win.

After stopping the Falcons on their first possession of the game, UWP started the scoring in the first quarter. The Pioneers dove 81 yards in 12 plays capped off on a three-yard touchdown pass from Ryan Munz to Dan Holz.

UWP, ranked 20th in last week's D3football.com Top 25, jumped out to a 14-0 lead at 14:28 of the second quarter. Damian Droessler scored on a 12-yard run to cap a 12-play, 72-yard drive.

UWRF made it a 14-3 game at 9:48 of the second quarter when Spasimir Bodurski kicked a 23-yard field goal.

UWP scored with 4:14 left in the first half to take a 21-3 lead. Holz caught a 22-yard touchdown pass from Brent Nelson.

Nathan Anderson led the Falcon rushing attack with 170 yards on 31 carries. It was his best rushing game of his career. Peterlik finished with 86 yards on 17 carries. The Falcon finished with 264 rushing yards. Kolstad finished 2-6 passing for 29 yards and one TD, Affeldt was 1-2 for 28 yards and one score and Peterlik was 1-1 for 44 yards and the TD. Strinmoen caught two passes, both touchdowns, for 62 yards.

Matt Farmer led the Falcon defense with nine tackles. Arron Retzlaff and O'Neal Hampton made eight tackles.
