The Game

The Falcons play for the second straight week on the road when they travel just 40 miles down I-94 to UW-Stout for a WIAC game at Williams Stadium. UWRF has lost two straight games, including a 23-16 loss at UW-Stevens Point last weekend. Stout has also lost the past two weeks after starting the year 4-0. Last weekend Stout lost at Eau Claire, 17-9.

* UWRF is averaging 20.8 points a game and allowing 21.5. The Falcons are sixth in both categories in the WIAC. UWS averages 29.5 and allows 15.2 points a game and are second in both categories in the WIAC.

* UWRF has had six 100+ and three 200+ rushing performances. Jeremy Wolff rushed for 207 at Stevens Point, 168 vs. Pacific Lutheran and 161 vs. Bemidji. Nathan Anderson has rushed for 230 vs. Eau Claire, 168 vs. Pacific Lutheran and 15 vs. Bemidji.

* UWRF's Nathan Anderson is 23rd in the NCAA Div. III in rushing yards per game (128.5). UWS's Evan Larsen is ranked No. 19 in field goals per game (1.0) in the NCAA Div. III.

* UWRF is ranked No. 4 in rushing offense (294.7) and UWS is ranked No. 30 in rushing defense (94.3) in the NCAA Div. III.

* UWRF is +4 in turnover margin - UWS is +8 in turnover margin.

* UWS leads the WIAC in kick off returns (22.1), total defense (247.2) and sacks (19). UWS is ranked No. 17 in total defense and No. 31 in kick off returns in the NCAA Div. III.

* UWRF leads the WIAC in third down conversions (46-100), .460.

* UWRF's Jovin Kroll is third in the WIAC in punting (39.0).

* UWS's Jesse Wendt is fourth in scoring in the WIAC (7.2)

* UWS's Joe Seep leads the WIAC in punt returns, and is ranked No. 13 in the NCAA Div. III (15.4).

River Falls - Stevens Point Recap

The Falcons lost for the second week in a row, this time to UW-Stevens Point 23-16 Saturday afternoon at Goerke field.

UWSP took the opening drive and got it all the way to the RF one-yard line. They had to settle for a 23-yard Dan Heldmann field goal. On the drive Stevens Point QB Brett Borchart was 7-8 passing for 49 yards.

UWSP got on the board early in the second quarter, again having to settle for another field goal. Heldmann connected on a 26-yard field goal to make the score 6-0. The drive covered 71 yards in 10 plays. After a Nathan Renk fumble recovery at the UWSP 28 the Falcons took tree plays and drove three-yards and had to settle for a 42-yard Spasimir Bodurski field goal.

Later in the second quarter, UWSP scored the first touchdown of the game on a 22-yard Borchart run to make the score 13-3 at 6:12. The drive covered 70 yards in six plays. With under a minute left in the first half, RF scored its first touchdown on a Jeremy Wolff 32-yard run. Bodurski missed the extra point after the Falcons were penalized 15 yards after the score. The drive covered 73 yards and it took eight plays. The score at halftime was 13-9 UWSP.

UWSP got on the board halfway through the third quarter on another Heldmann field goal - this time from 24 yards out. The drive covered 74 yards and it took 11 plays. RF answered right back two plays later on Wolff's 69 yard run and it tied the score at 16. The drive covered 75 yards. The score after the third quarter was tied at 16.

Stevens Point put the game away on the drive of the game. The drive covered 86 yards in 15 plays and Borchart ran it in from one-yard out to make the score 23-16 UWSP.

The Falcons got the ball back with 7:21 to play and moved it to the UWSP 42 before turning the ball on downs. UWSP was then able to run the final 3:10 off the clock.

RF was led by Wolff's career-high 207 yards on the ground and two touchdowns. Nathan Anderson added another 70 on the ground. Chris Anderson led the team with 37 yards receiving.

UWSP was led by Borchart who had 255 yards passing and 84 yards rushing to go along with his two touchdown runs. Cody Childs caught 11 passes for 107 yards.

Cornerback Matt Jordan led the Falcon defense with nine solo and 10 total tackles. Andy Acosta (7-1), Tony Dorner (7-1) and Robby Nesvig (7-0) were next for the Falcons in tackles.

Stout - Eau Claire Recap

On a picturesque fall day where the festive atmosphere and the efforts of student-athletes from long-time rival post-secondary institutes made it extremely unfortunate one team had to lose, the Blugolds (3-3, 2-1 WIAC) produced enough breaks for a 17-9 victory over the Blue Devils (4-2, 1-2 WIAC) that gave the UWEC-partial members of the homecoming crowd another cause for celebration.

Eau Claire kicker Mitch Schaeuble booted a 22-yard field goal with 93 seconds remaining in the contest, giving Stout the ball and the opportunity to generate some last-minute heroics. The Blue Devils' final drive, however, netted -15 yards and, after one kneel-down by Blugold quarterback Jesse Krzyzanowski, it was time for Stout to take a long, 30-minute ride home while UWEC relished the spoils that go to victors.

Eau Claire seized the early momentum and fired up its faithful with 5 minutes, 16 seconds left in the first quarter, when Joe Gast plunged into the end zone from six yards out to help put the home team in front, 7-0.

Late in the second quarter Stout narrowed the 'Golds' edge to 7-3 when placekicker Evan Larsen drilled a 27-yard field goal that kicked his career points total up to 161 (fourth on Stout's all-time scoring list).

Late in the third quarter, the Blugolds' Dan Rogeny picked off an errant pass from the hand of Stout QB Keldric Stokes and raced to the Blue Devils' 22 yard line. One play later, Gast motored to pay dirt for a 14-3 Blugold advantage.

Coincidentally, it was Stokes who put Stout in position to keep everyone in Carson Park - and listening elsewhere - nervous until the final whistle. Stokes capped a 14-play, 89-yard Blue Devil drive that ended at the 8:07 mark of the deciding quarter with a one-yard dive that brought Stout to within 14-9. Stokes' two-point conversion pass fell incomplete.

The Blue Devils netted 265 offensive yards on 69 plays, while Eau Claire totaled 235 on 54 plays. Eau Claire committed two turnovers to Stout's one.

Andy Reese led Stout's ground attack with 95 yards on 26 carries, while Stokes picked up 23 yards on 10 keeps. Stokes completed 10-of-20 passes for 118 yards, while Jesse Wendt hauled in nine receptions for 100 yards. Joe Seep picked up an interception for the Blue Devils and Travis Hoffmann recovered a fumble.

Gast tallied 80 rushing yards on 26 carries, while Krzyzanowski completed 17-of-22 aerial attempts for 150 yards. Darin Krzyzanowski led the Golds in receiving with three catches for 31 yards.

Todd Strop begins his

second year as the head coach of UW-Stout.

Strop, the team's defensive coordinator for six seasons before becoming the head coach in January, 2004, was the main architect of the defense that has consistently ranked at the top of the (WIAC) and has found its way into the national rankings several times. The 2002 Blue Devil defense allowed an NCAA Division III low 500 rushing yards, and was ranked 13th in overall defense.

Strop's first season started out with a bang as his defense handed him a 23-0 season opening shutout. The Blue Devils finished the season at 5-4 overall.

When Strop walked onto the Stout campus seven years ago, he immediately fell in love with the Stout and Menomonie communities. Growing up in nearby Ladysmith, Strop was familiar with Stout and the WIAC.

Strop, who was the WIAC assistant coach of the year in 2000, worked specifically with the defensive backs and was the team's recruiting coordinator. Over Strop's tenure, the Blue Devil defense has had five All-America picks and two players that went on to play in the NFL - Jeff Hazuga with the Minnesota Vikings and Tony Beckham, who is currently staring at a starting spot with the Tennessee Titans.

Strop played at Wisconsin from 1987-92 for present coach Barry Alvarez as a defensive back and special teams player. Strop has a special place in his heart for special teams, and wants to put more of an emphasis on that part of Stout's game.

After receiving a degree in history from Wisconsin in 1992, Strop was the special teams coordinator at UW-Platteville from 1992-94. He was a graduate assistant at Ohio University from 1994-95, where he earned an advanced degree in physical education athletic administration, then became the head football coach and taught history at nearby Durand High School from 1995-98. Strop took over a program that had been averaging fewer than two wins a season, and had the Panthers in the WIAA playoffs his final two seasons in Durand. Strop came to Stout from Durand.

UWRF At Ramer Field

The Falcons are 26-22 at Ramer Field since 1995. The Falcons last winning season at Ramer Field was in 2000, when they went 3-1. In conference play, the Falcons are 22-14 at Ramer Field since 1995, with their last winning season in 2001, when they finished 2-1. The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in conference play.

UWRF On The Road

The Falcons are 26-29 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play. The Falcons are 21-18 on the road in conference play since 1995. In 1999 and 2000 the Falcons finished with 3-1 records on the road in conference play.

UWRF At Neutral Sites

The Falcons are 4-1 at neutral sites since 1995. They have not played a neutral site game since 2000, when they lost to Bemidji State at the Metrodome, 23-20.

UWRF Football History

The first year of Falcon football was in 1895 when the team finished with a 2-0 record after playing and beating New Richmond High School twice. The first game against a collegiate team was in 1899 when the Falcons lost to Superior, 12-0. It wasn't until 1923 when the Falcons started playing only collegiate teams. UW-RF has won 18 WIAC titles, third most of all WIAC institutions. The Falcons have a 471-306-49 record in 103 seasons.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is in his 17th year as head coach at UW-RF and stands second in all-time football wins.

Under O'Grady the Falcons have compiled an 91-72-3 overall record, a winning percentage of .557. Among WIAC active coaches he is third in wins and is eighth in all-time wins of all WIAC coaches. He needs just six wins to reach the seventh spot. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 16 seasons with the Falcons.

Year-in and year-out the Falcons are one of the top teams in the

WIAC under the veteran coach. In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14). In 1999 the Falcons were 6-4 and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

Last season the Falcons finished a disappointing 3-7 overall and 3-4 (fifth place tie) in the WIAC. In 2003 the Falcons were 2-7 overall and 2-5 (sixth place) in league play. In 2002 UWRF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in WIAC play (sixth place). The Falcons finished 4-5 overall and 4-3 (tie third place) in the WIAC in 2001. In 2000, the Falcons were 6-4 overall and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 60-47-3 record in WIAC play. O'Grady combines his vast football knowledge and intensity to help the Falcons succeed.

O'Grady, 52, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UW-RF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UW-RF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 166 of 167 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching, business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UW-RF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UW-RF for 32 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, special teams coach of the Baltimore Ravens, has been a counselor for 28 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has spoken at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 15 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football clinic in Gilman, Wis. The clinic was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 24, Jaclyn, 21 and Logan 18. Lindsey, a UW-RF graduate, teaches social studies and coaches volleyball and track & field at the Mauston middle school. Jaclyn is a senior at the University of Minnesota and will graduate in December, 2005 with a degree in film studies. She plans on going to graduate school. Logan will be a freshman at the University of St. Thomas this fall and will compete in cross country and track & field.

The Falcon football team (2-5, 2-2) scored on four out of its last five drives to beat UW-Stout 28-10 (3-3, 1-3). It was the story of two halves as Stout controlled the ball for almost twenty minutes in the first half, driving inside the Falcon 20 yard line on their first four possessions. The Blue Devils only came away with three points on the four drives. Stout finally got into the end zone in the third quarter to go up 10-0, but RF responded scoring on their next three possessions to take a 21-10 lead. The Falcons controlled the second half, possessing the ball for 21 minutes and 53 seconds. Stout was within 11 and driving, early in the fourth when senior Matt Farmer recovered a fumble by running back Andy Reese at the RF two. The Falcons sealed the game with an 18 play 80 yard drive that took up almost nine minutes and resulted in a three yard touchdown run by quarterback Dave Affeldt.

The Falcons finished with 315 yards of total offense, 280 on the ground, while Stout had 321 yards of offense. Affeldt didn't throw a pass but ran for 84 yards on nine carries and two touchdowns. Sophomore halfback Jeremy Wolff threw RF's only pass, completing it to senior running back John Peterlik for a 35-yard touchdown. Peterlik finished with 35 yards on 11 carries and a TD. Freshman fullback Nathan Anderson led the Falcons in rushing with 127 yards on 29 carries. Senior linebacker Ben Gillett led the River Falls defense with 16 total tackles, 10 solo, two tackles for a loss, one forced fumble and one sack. Roman Johnson grabbed an interception to go along with eight total tackles, six solo, and two pass breakups. Defensive lineman Aaron Retzlaff and Josh Meyer each had a sack.

Senior QB Nick Ohman led the Stout offense completing 17-28 for 176 yards with two interceptions. Ohman ran the ball 14 times for 46 yards and a touchdown. Sophomore running back Ryan Englebirt only played in the first half but led the Blue Devils with 50 yards on 15 rushing attempts. River Falls native Evan Larsen made one of three field goals in his return to Ramer Field. Linebacker Travis Phillips led the Stout defense with 14 tackles, eight solo, and one tackle for loss. Linebacker Nate Rykal chipped in 13 tackles, six solo.
