The Game

- * The Falcons return to Ramer Field when they host UW-Stevens Point at 2 p.m. in a WIAC game.
- * Both teams lost WIAC games last weekend. The Falcons lost at Eau Claire, 23-3 and the Pointers lost at Whitewater, 31-13.
- * The Sack Attack is alive and well with the Falcon defense. UWRF is second in the WIAC in sacks with 13. Only Whitewater has more, with 16. Falcon end Gregg Neumann leads the WIAC with 4.5 sacks. The Falcons have already eclipsed last year's season total of 12 sacks - the 2006 Falcons have 13.
- * Making The Pick - Not only have the Falcons improved their pass rush, but UWRF has matched its interception total from 2005. The Falcons have eight interceptions this year, matching last year's total. Shane Hanson leads the team with three.
- * Home Sweet Home - The Falcons will play at Ramer Field for just the second time this season on Saturday. UWRF has two more home games after this weekend - on Oct. 21 vs. Stout and on Nov. 11 vs. Whitewater. Since 1970, the Falcons are 13-5-0 against Stevens Point at Ramer Field.
- * This is the 66th meeting between the two teams. The series started in 1912 with UWRF winning that first game, 38-0. UWRF holds a 35-27-3 lead in the series. Both teams' longest winning streak is six games. The Falcon streak ran from 1971-76 and the Pointer streak ran from 1960-67. UWSP has won four of the last five games.
- * Falcon Coach John O'Grady, in his 18th season at UW-RF, has a 93-79-3 career record. He is 8-9 against UWSP. He is a 1979 graduate of UW-RF and is third among active WIAC coaches in wins. He needs two wins to get to No. 7 in all-time wins in the WIAC.
- * Coach John Miech is in his 19th season at UWSP and has a 119-65-2 career record. The UWSP graduate is second in career wins among active WIAC coaches.

River Falls - Eau Claire Recap

The Falcon football team could not muster up enough big plays and the Blugolds capitalized on offense, en-route to a 23-3 victory Saturday afternoon at Carson Park.

"I thought we prepared well for the game. We just did not get any breaks and we did not make enough big plays to win the game," Coach John O'Grady said.

In the first quarter the Falcons could not move the ball. Their longest drive of the first quarter was five plays for 17 yards. EC put together an 11 play 64 yard drive that ate up 5:26 off the clock, which was capped off by a Craig Kolb 41-yard field goal. The score after the first quarter was 3-0 UWEC.

After another RF punt, the Blugolds went to work right away on offense to begin the second quarter. UWEC went 65 yards in 10 plays which was capped off by another Kolb field goal this time from 27 yards out to make the score 6-0.

On RF's next possession they finally made some noise going 59 yards in 12 plays, which was capped off by a 33-yard Spasimir Bodurksi field goal to make the score 6-3 UWEC with only 1:20 left in the half.

UWEC big play ability on offense showed on its next drive. With only about one minute left in the half they went 80 yards in four plays, which was capped off by a 38-yard Kyle Paulson to Chris Hull touchdown pass. The score at recess was 13-3 UWEC.

"That was the turning point in the game. We had just scored and they came back right away just before half and score a touchdown on us that hurt," O'Grady said.

In the third quarter, UWEC used the momentum they got at the end of the first half and brought it to the second. After a Falcon turnover at their own 27-yard line the Blugolds drove three yards on four plays which was capped off by a another Kolb field goal this time from 41 yards out to make the score 16-3. After an RF interception, UWEC put the icing on the cake on their next possession with a one play Paulson to Evensen hookup for a touchdown to make the score 23-3. That ended the scoring.

RF was led by Nathan Anderson's 83 yards on 25 attempts. Jeremy Wolff threw 13 times, completing six of those for 76 yards. Connor Graves led the team with three catches for 30 yards. On defense the Falcons were led once again by Bruce Baillargeon who had five solo and 10 total tackles. Gregg Neumann chipped in with two sacks and Andy Kolstad added an interception.

"Neumann and Baillargeon both had a good game. They each made a few nice plays for us on defense," O'Grady said.

The story of the game was Paulson who threw for 251 yards and two touchdowns. Hull and Evensen both had over 100 yards receiving and combined for 206 yards and two touchdowns. On the ground UWEC was led Eddy Kaiser who ran for 65 yards on 16 carries.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is in his 18th year as head coach at UW-RF and stands second in all-time football wins.

Under O'Grady the Falcons have compiled an 93-79-3 overall record, a winning percentage of .543. Among WIAC active coaches he is third in wins and is eighth in all-time wins. He needs just two wins to reach the seventh spot. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 17 seasons with the Falcons.

Year-in and year-out the Falcons are one of the top teams in the WIAC under the veteran coach. In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14). In 1999 the Falcons were 6-4 and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

Last year UW-RF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in the WIAC. They placed seventh. In 2004 the Falcons finished a disappointing 3-7 overall and 3-4 (fifth place tie) in the WIAC. In 2003 the Falcons were 2-7 overall and 2-5 (sixth place) in league play. In 2002 UWRF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in WIAC play (sixth place). The Falcons finished 4-5 overall and 4-3 (tie third place) in the WIAC in 2001. In 2000, the Falcons were 6-4 overall and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 61-52-3 record in WIAC play. O'Grady combines his vast football knowledge and intensity to help the Falcons succeed.

O'Grady, 53, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UW-RF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UW-RF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 166 of 167 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching, business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UW-RF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UW-RF for 33 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, special teams coach of the Arizona Cardinals, has been a counselor for 29 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has spoken at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 15 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football clinic in Gilman, Wis. The clinic was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 25, Jaclyn, 22 and Logan 19. Lindsey, a UW-RF graduate, teaches social studies and coaches volleyball and track & field at the Mauston middle school. Jaclyn graduated from the University of Minnesota in 2005 with a degree in film studies. She plans on going to graduate school. Logan will be a sophomore at the University of St. Thomas this fall and competes in cross country and track & field.

Stevens Point - Whitewater Recap Recap

Entering the game as the leading offensive team in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference, it took until the fourth quarter for UW-Stevens Point to enjoy success against the league's top defense in a 31-13 loss Saturday at second-ranked UW-Whitewater.

The Warhawks' defense limited the Pointers to just 47 yards through three quarters in building a 31-0 advantage en route to its 15th straight regular season victory and a 5-0 record this year. UW-Stevens Point fell to 2-3 overall and 0-2 in the WIAC and has suffered all three losses to teams ranked in the top 10 of the NCAA Division III rankings.

UW-Stevens Point got off to a strong start, forcing the Warhawks to punt after three-and-outs on their first two possessions. UW-Stevens Point's Cody Childs, the league's leading rusher entering the game, rushed for 10 yards and a first down on the Pointers' first offensive play. However, that turned out to be one of the Pointers' few offensive highlights for the first three quarters. In fact, Childs finished the day with 26 yards on 21 carries after averaging 138.8 yards through the first four games.

Later in the first quarter, UW-Whitewater faced a third-and-five from its own 15-yard line when Justin Jacobs found Derek Stanley down the right sideline for a 32-yard pass play. A roughing the passer penalty and a late hit out of bounds added 30 more yards onto the play and Travis Reuland finished the drive with the first of his three touchdowns on a one-yard run.

UW-Stevens Point's Eric Reible returned the ensuing kickoff 75 yards to the Warhawks' eight-yard line. The Pointers moved the ball to the two-yard line, but Ryan Graboski missed a 20-yard field goal.

UW-Whitewater added two touchdowns in the second quarter, getting a four-yard pass from Jacobs to Pete Schmitt and then another one-yard run by Reuland that was set up by a 47-yard pass to Matt Gifford down to the one-yard line for a 21-0 halftime lead.

Reuland, who scored on his first three carries, added a third one-yard touchdown score early in the third quarter and Jeff Schebler kicked a 27-yard field goal for a 31-0 lead.

Pointers' junior quarterback Nick Venden took over in the second quarter for injured starter Brett Borchart and led the fourth quarter rally. Venden started the comeback with an 87-yard touchdown pass to Luke Gunderson for the fifth-longest pass play in school history. After a Warhawks' punt, he drove the Pointers down the field again and then lofted a perfect pass to Brad Kalsow, who leaped between two defenders for a 13-yard touchdown catch in the corner of the endzone. A missed extra point put the deficit at 31-13 midway through the final quarter.

Venden finished the day nine-for-15 passing for 172 yards as the Pointers totaled 171 of their 218 yards in the fourth quarter. UW-Whitewater finished with 383 yards as Justin Beaver had 25 carries for 146 yards rushing. Jacobs was 16-for-26 passing for 181 yards.

Brandon Czys led the Pointers' defensive effort with 15 tackles. Luke Frisch posted the third-highest single-game punting average in Pointers' history with a 46.2 average on five punts, including a 70-yarder.

John Miech

In 18 seasons at UW-Stevens Point, head coach John Miech has more than twice as many victories as any other coach in school history with a 117-62-2 record, tying for fourth on the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference all-time wins list.

Miech, having completed his 24th year with the coaching staff, has posted 20 seasons with a .500 or better record during the last 22 years. He has won three WIAC championships and earned the WIAC Coach of the Year award in 1998 and 2001. The 2005 season was atypical for Miech, whose team finished 4-6 overall against one of the nation's top schedules that featured four top 15 teams in the first five games of the year.

Miech's association with Pointer football actually goes back to 1972 when he first joined the program as an offensive lineman, providing protection for the nation's top passing offense in both 1973 and 1974.

Along the way, he has developed numerous players who went on to play in the NFL, CFL, AFL and European leagues. Most notable among those players is Clint Kriewaldt, who was drafted in the sixth round by the Detroit Lions in 1999 and played in the 2006 Super Bowl as a member of the world champion Pittsburgh Steelers. Others include Barry Rose, who had stints with both the Buffalo Bills and Denver Broncos, Kirk Baumgartner, a draft choice of the Green Bay Packers and Pete Lucas, a draft pick by the Atlanta Falcons.

In 1975, following graduation with a degree in Physical Education, Miech began his coaching career with a three-year stint as an assistant with the Pointers before moving on to Stephen F. Austin State University. There, he served as a graduate assistant for the Lumberjacks while working on his Master's Degree, which he received in 1979.

Miech returned to Wisconsin in 1979 and served as the head coach at Whitnall High School and then Jefferson High School for three seasons each before returning to UW-Stevens Point in 1985 as the defensive coordinator. As defensive coordinator with the Pointers, his unit allowed just over 275 yards per game and four yards per play in three seasons to lead the conference.

Miech and his wife, Sheila, who serves as the head coach of the highly-successful Pointer women's soccer program, have two sons, Jesse and Ryan.

In conference play, the Falcons are 22-15 at Ramer Field since 1995, with their last winning season in 2001, when they finished 2-1. The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in conference play.

UW-RF On The Road

The Falcons are 27-35 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play. The Falcons are 21-19 on the road in conference play since 1995. In 1999 and 2000 the Falcons finished with 3-1 records on the road in conference play.

UW-RF At Neutral Sites

The Falcons are 4-1 at neutral sites since 1995. They have not played a neutral site game since 2000, when they lost to Bemidji State at the Metrodome, 23-20.

UW-RF Football History

The first year of Falcon football was in 1895 when the team finished with a 2-0 record after playing and beating New Richmond High School twice. The first game against a collegiate team was in 1899 when the Falcons lost to Superior, 12-0. It wasn't until 1923 when the Falcons started playing only collegiate teams. UW-RF has won 18 WIAC titles, third most of all WIAC institutions. The Falcons have a 473-313-49 record in 103 seasons.

The Falcons lost for the second week in a row, this time to UW-Stevens Point 23-16 Saturday afternoon at Goerke Field.

UWSP took the opening drive and got it all the way to the RF one-yard line. They had to settle for a 23-yard Dan Heldmann field goal. On the drive Stevens Point QB Brett Borchart was 7-8 passing for 49 yards.

UWSP got on the board early in the second quarter, again having to settle for another field goal. Heldmann connected on a 26-yard field goal to make the score 6-0. The drive covered 71 yards in 10 plays. The Falcons got the ball back with 7:21 to play and moved it to the UWSP 42 before turning the ball on downs. UWSP was then able to run the final 3:10 off the clock.

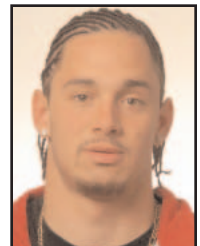
