The Game

- * The Falcons play their first home game of the 2006 season on Saturday when they host UW-Oshkosh in a WIAC game at Ramer Field. Kickoff is set for 7 p.m.
- * The Falcons haven't played a night game at Ramer Field since Oct. 3, 1981 against Bethel. UW-RF won that game, 7-3.
- * Both teams lost games last weekend. The Falcons lost a 63-8 none-conference decision at St. Francis while the Titans opened WIAC play at home with a 17-3 loss to Whitewater.
- * The Falcons finally get a chance to play at home after games at St. John's (Sept. 9), Pacific Lutheran (Sept. 16) and St. Francis (Sept. 23).
- * This is the 52nd meeting between the teams and UW-RF holds a 35-15-1 lead in the all-time series. The Falcons have won 14 of the last 15 games between the teams, including a 13-10 win in overtime at UWO last year. The last two games between the teams have been decided by three points including a 28-25 win by UWO in 2004 at Ramer Field.
- * Falcon Coach John O'Grady, in his 18th season at UW-RF, has a 93-77-3 career record. He is 15-2-1 against UWO. He is a 1979 graduate of UW-RF and is third among active WIAC coaches in wins. He needs two wins to get to No. 7 in all-time wins in the WIAC.
- * Coach Phil Meyer is in his seventh season with the Titans and has a 28-35 career record. The Illinois State graduate has a 12-31 record in WIAC play. He is 1-5 against UW-RF.

River Falls - St. Francis Recap

The Falcons could not sustain any long drives and St. Francis handled RF's defensive pressure all afternoon in a 63-8 win Saturday afternoon at Bishop John M'Darcy Stadium.

The Falcons kept it close in the first quarter forcing an Eric Hooks interception on St. Francis' first possession. RF took over at its 42 yard line and drove the ball 43 yards in 11 plays. The drive stalled at the 15-yard line and Spasimir Bodurski missed a 32-yard field goal attempt.

In the second quarter, USF started out quickly scoring on the first play with a Hooks to Ryan Kauchak pass for 12 yards. On their next possession the Cougers went 54 yards in six plays which was capped off by a Hooks to Brian Schultz pass for 10 yards to make the score 14-0. The Cougers ended the half strong scoring another touchdown with only 32 seconds left. This time Hooks connected with Zach Rainey for 11 yards to make the score 21-0 at recess.

In the third quarter the Cougers picked up where they left off scoring on their second possession of the half on a Doug Wasylyk run that covered 49 yards. After a Jovin Kroll 39-yard punt, the Cougers scored two plays later on a Jeff Wedding 50-yard pass to Bo Thompson. After another stalled RF drive Kroll's punt was blocked and returned to the Falcon nine-yard line. On the very next play Hooks ran nine yards for another touchdown to make the score 42-0. On RF's next drive Jeremy Wolff went back to pass and was sacked for a 12-yard loss and Joe Piwoszkun picked up the Wolff fumble and ran it back 22 yards for a Couger touchdown.

In the fourth quarter RF was on the 44-yard line when Wolff was sacked again and fumbled the ball, which was picked up by Anthony Harbor. USF cashed in five plays later on Marcus Rush's six-yard burst. RF finally got on the board on its next drive going 75 yards in 16 plays, which was capped off by a Beau DeBruin 10-yard run. The time of possession was 8:33. Wolff added the two-point conversion on the ground. St Francis answered right back with a five-play 69-yard drive, which was capped off by a Taylor Vieck 44-yard run.

RF was led by Nathan Anderson who ran for 118 yards on 35 attempts. DeBruin ran for 40 yards and one touchdown. Wolff passed for 29 yards on 4-12 throwing. The Falcon defense was led by Andy Kolstad and Bruce Baillargeon who each had eight tackles. Shane Hanson added two interceptions and Kolstad had one. Tyler Hasse had one sack.

Oshkosh - Whitewater Recap Recap

The nationally-ranked Whitewater football team made a 17-3 halftime lead stand up for the game's final score as it defeated Oshkosh on Saturday at J.J. Keller Field at Titan Stadium.

Whitewater (3-0/1-0 WIAC) took a 7-0 lead when All-American Justin Beaver scampered a school-record 97 yards for a touchdown at the 4:28 mark of the first quarter. The score came immediately after Oshkosh's Lucas Raschke had a punt downed at the Warhawks' three.

Oshkosh (2-2/0-1 WIAC) punted the football away after losing two yards on three plays on its next possession. The Warhawks took the ensuing possession and marched 16 yards in six plays before Jeff Sheller booted a 42-yard field goal with 40 seconds left in the first period.

Whitewater took the football following another Oshkosh punt and paraded 80 yards in seven plays for a touchdown. The drive was capped by Justin Jacobs' 13-yard touchdown pass to Neil Marvin with 8:23 remaining in the second quarter.

Oshkosh recovered a Beaver fumble late in the second quarter and turned the miscue into three points. Raschke provided the scoring for the Titans as he kicked a 32-yard field goal with 1:46 left before intermission. Raschke established a WIAC record on the play by kicking his 32nd career field goal.

Neither team scored in the second half as they combined for seven punts and four change of possessions due to a loss of downs. Oshkosh had five possessions end Whitewater territory in the second half, while the Warhawks had three possessions end on the Titans' section of the field.

Whitewater totaled 15 first downs and 355 yards of offense, but only six first downs and 99 yards offense came after intermission. The Warhawks' 17 points scored were their fewest in 18 games.

Individually, Beaver rushed 43 times for 218 yards and one touchdown. The Warhawks had only one other rushing attempt in the game, a two-yard jaunt by Jacobs. In the air, Jacobs completed 15 of 28 passes for 135 yards and one touchdown. Mrkvicka led the Whitewater with six pass receptions for 38 yards and one touchdown.

Oshkosh compiled 15 first downs and 263 yards of offense. The Titans had 253 of their yards in the air as the Warhawks held Oshkosh to just 10 yards rushing in 25 attempts. Steve Levonowich rushed twice for nine yards to lead Oshkosh.

In the air, Joe Patek completed 23 of 50 passes for 253 yards. Andy Heiman caught six passes for 68 yards while Andy Moriarty grabbed six for 62 and Steve Stoltz five for 76.

Tristan Borzick led Whitewater with 13 tackles, while Dave DeJewski and Jason Manikowski each totaled 11.

Phil Meyer



On April 20, 2000, UW-Oshkosh tabbed Phil Meyer as its 20th head football coach. In doing so, UW-Oshkosh Director of Athletics Allen Ackerman hired a football coach who was ready to accept the challenge of taking the Titans to a new level of performance.

Echoes of glories have been faintly heard since the Titans' last WIAC championship in 1976, making Meyer's mission of transforming the UW-Oshkosh football program into a source of pride a major goal. Meyer has emphasized during his tenure at the school that he wants each player to be accountable, write his own chapter, make his own place, work together and succeed in the classroom. Meyer is convinced that the ultimate bottom line will be rewarding, as he believes that his program is ready to become a regular upper-division staple in the WIAC standings.

Meyer enters his seventh season at UW-Oshkosh with a 26-33 coaching record. Last fall, Meyer guided the Titans to a 7-3 record, including a third-place 4-3 mark in the WIAC. UW-Oshkosh's overall record in 2005 was its best since 1976. Two years ago, Meyer coached UW-Oshkosh to a 5-5 record and the school's first non-losing football season since 1995.

During his first two seasons at UW-Oshkosh, Meyer led the Titans to wins over the defending WIAC champion, victories of 38-31 over UW-Stevens Point in 2000 and 19-7 over UW-Stout in 2001. In 2003, highlighted by a 15-7 win over 11th-ranked UW-Stout, Meyer coached UW-Oshkosh to its first 4-0 start since the 1968 season.

UW-Oshkosh has won 14 of its 17 non-conference games under Meyer's leadership, including victories of 54-0 over NCAA Division II University of Minnesota-Morris in 2000, 31-27 over perennial Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference power Simpson College in 2001 and 27-13 over eventual NCAA Division III Playoff participant Albion College (Mich.) in 2005.

Meyer came to UW-Oshkosh from Iowa State University, where he tutored the quarterbacks for two seasons and the tight ends and special teams for three. In 1998, Meyer coached Todd Bandhauer, the first quarterback in Iowa State University history to notch a pair of 2,000-yard passing seasons.

Meyer attended Milwaukee Pius XI High School, where he was a starter on the Popes' 1972 WISAA state championship football team. He went on to play one season of college football at UW-Milwaukee and three at Illinois State University. In all, Meyer started 44 straight games in the defensive secondary for the two schools.

UW-RF At Ramer Field

The Falcons are 27-23 at Ramer Field since 1995. The Falcons last winning season at Ramer Field was in 2000, when they went 3-1. In conference play, the Falcons are 22-15 at Ramer Field since 1995, with their last winning season in 2001, when they finished 2-1. The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in conference play.

UW-RF On The Road

The Falcons are 27-34 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play. The Falcons are 21-19 on the road in conference play since 1995. In 1999 and 2000 the Falcons finished with 3-1 records on the road in conference play.

UW-RF At Neutral Sites

The Falcons are 4-1 at neutral sites since 1995. They have not played a neutral site game since 2000, when they lost to Bemidji State at the Metrodome, 23-20.

UW-RF Football History

The first year of Falcon football was in 1895 when the team finished with a 2-0 record after playing and beating New Richmond High School twice. The first game against a collegiate team was in 1899 when the Falcons lost to Superior, 12-0. It wasn't until 1923 when the Falcons started playing only collegiate teams. UW-RF has won 18 WIAC titles, third most of all WIAC institutions. The Falcons have a 473-311-49 record in 103 seasons.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is in his 18th year as head coach at UW-RF and stands second in all-time football wins.

Under O'Grady the Falcons have compiled an 93-77-3 overall record, a winning percentage of .546. Among WIAC active coaches he is third in wins and is eighth in all-time wins. He needs just two wins to reach the seventh spot. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 17 seasons with the Falcons.



Year-in and year-out the Falcons are one of the top teams in the WIAC under the veteran coach. In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and

5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14). In 1999 the Falcons were 6-4 and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

Last year UW-RF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in the WIAC. They placed seventh. In 2004 the Falcons finished a disappointing 3-7 overall and 3-4 (fifth place tie) in the WIAC. In 2003 the Falcons were 2-7 overall and 2-5 (sixth place) in league play. In 2002 UWRF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in WIAC play (sixth place). The Falcons finished 4-5 overall and 4-3 (tie third place) in the WIAC in 2001. In 2000, the Falcons were 6-4 overall and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 61-50-3 record in WIAC play. O'Grady combines his vast football knowledge and intensity to help the Falcons succeed.

O'Grady, 53, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UW-RF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UW-RF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 166 of 167 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching, business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UW-RF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UW-RF for 33 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, special teams coach of the Arizona Cardinals, has been a counselor for 29 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has spoken at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 15 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football clinic in Gilman, Wis. The clinic was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 25, Jaclyn, 22 and Logan 19. Lindsey, a UW-RF graduate, teaches social studies and coaches volleyball and track & field at the Mauston middle school. Jaclyn graduated from the University of Minnesota in 2005 with a degree in film studies. She plans on going to graduate school. Logan will be a sophomore at the University of St. Thomas this fall and competes in cross country and track & field.

Last Season

UW-RF 13, UW-O 10 OT

The Falcon football team picked up its second win of the season, 13-10, over UW-Oshkosh at J.J. Keller Field Saturday night.

After a scoreless first quarter, UWO got on the board first with a Tyler Jandrin one yard touchdown plunge. He capped off a 14 play 57 yard drive. UWRF responded right before half time on Chris Anderson's five yard catch from Jeremy Wolff at :09. The drive was 10 plays covering 72 yards. The score at half was tied at seven.

Halfway through the third quarter UWO got on the board again this time on Lucas Raschke's 26 yard field goal at 7:59 to make the score 10-7 UWO. It capped off an eight play 27 yard drive. That was the only scoring of the third quarter.

The Falcons fought back once again this time scoring with under two minutes left in the fourth quarter on Spasimir Bodurski's 21 yard field goal with 1:51 left in the game. It capped off a four play eight yard drive. The score after regulation was tied at 10.

In overtime, the Falcons won the toss and elected to play defense. Dan Buker dropped a UWO runner for a three-yard loss on first down. Then two UWO passes fell incomplete. A 45-yard field goal attempted

missed wide left and the defense accomplished its goal.

The Falcon offense then produced just enough yards to get the win. Nathan Anderson picked up seven yards on two running plays and Wolff added two more yards that put the ball at the UWO 16. Bodurski then coolly booted a 33-yard field goal to win the game.

RF won the game and improved to 1-0 in WIAC play and 2-2 overall. It was the first overtime game for the Falcons since the 2001 season when UWRF topped UW-Eau Claire, 24-23.

RF was led by Anderson's 87 rushing yards on 22 carries. Wolff also pitched in with 72 yards on the ground and 84 passing to go along with his one touchdown pass. Anderson led the team with three catches for 33 yards and one touchdown.

Falcon linebacker Dan Buker led the defense with eight solo and 10 total tackles. Tony Dorner (4-9), Ben Hognlund (3-9) and Ryan Agrimson (4-8) were next for the Falcons in tackles. Aaron Retzlaff and Gregg Neumann also had one sack each.
