The Game

* The Falcons open their 2006 season Saturday at St. John's with kickoff set for 1 p.m. at Clemens Stadium in Collegeville, Minn.
* SJU opened its season last Saturday at Clemens Stadium with a 15-11 win over UW-Eau Claire in front of 8,713 fans.
* UW-RF has not won a season-opening game since a 29-22 win over Winona State in 1996. All previous nine losses were to scholarship schools. Before 1996 the Falcons had won seven straight season-opening games.
* SJU is ranked No. 4 in this week's D3Football.com poll. the Johnnies were ranked No. 4 in the pre-season poll.
* St. John's has been one of the elite teams in the country winning the NCAA Div. III title in 2003 and going 69-11 since 2000. SJU Coach John Gagliardi was recently inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame and enters Saturday's game with a 433-118-11 record. He has a 409-112-10 record at SJU.
* Falcon Coach John O'Grady has made a change in the team's offense going to a zone offense. The Falcons had run the wish-bone since midway through the 1974 season. But in the last few years the Falcons had turned the ball over too much for O'Grady and the change was put in during spring practice. The new offense, plus a defense that is in its third year under coordinator Kevin Bullis, is the base for the plan of success for the 2006 Falcons.
* UW-RF quarterback Jeremy Wolff will direct the offense that O'Grady hopes will have a 60/40 run/pass mixture. Wolff is a talented athlete who delivers passes on a line. If he can't find an

open receiver, he has the skill to break plays open by running. Before moving to quarterback at the start of the 2005 season, he played halfback.

* Another key Falcon returnee for the offense is tailback Nathan Anderson, who rushed for 1,265 yards in 2006. He will be the feature back with hopes of at least matching his 2005 output. B.J. LeRoy will be a lead blocker at the fullback spot and he has the skill to pick up the tough yards. John Ward will play at fullback and Bea DeBruin will help at tailback.

* A question that has to be answered will be who will man the wide receiver spots for the Falcons. Josh Grover returns as one wide receiver while Chad Nolechek, Jake Jenson and Londe Richardson will also play.

* The Falcon defense lost four starters and the biggest loss was tackle Aaron Retzlaff. But the Falcons return several linebackers and defensive backs. Gregg Neumann, who had a great sophomore campaign, returns at end and Jesse Ostertag will be on the other end. Mike Larson has been moved from a linebacker spot to defensive tackle and Scott Kane will also be a run stopper in the middle.

* Falcon linebacker Dan Buker has been a starter for three seasons and will be looked at to be one of the defensive leaders. Joining Buker as linebackers are Jesse Goebel, Robby Nesvig and Ryan Agrimson.

* UW-RF's Shane Hanson had a great year at corner and returns to that spot. Nesvig played free safety last year but with his move to linebacker, Joe Simonson will be at free safety. Jamie Bisch will man the other corner spot.

* The Falcon special teams is solid with place kicker Spasimir Bodurski and punter Jovin Kroll both back. Retzlaff was the snapper and with his departure Ryan Agrimson and Andy Marx will handle that important job. Kroll will also hold. Jamie Bisch will handle punt returns and Grove kickoff returns.

* "We're very excited and we're off to a good start in the pre-season," said O'Grady. "I'm excited about the offense and the defense is doing some new things that will stress offenses. They are doing things that will limit the passing game. "St. John's is one of the best Div. III programs in the nation," said O'Grady. "They are very successful when playing at home and it's a beautiful setting. There will be 6-10,000 people there and it will be a challenge."

* After Saturday's game at SJU, the Falcons will travel to Pacific Lutheran on Sept. 16 for a game against the Lutes that starts at 11:30 a.m.

St. John's - Eau Claire Recap

Led by the arm of junior quarterback Alex Kofoed and junior Craig Luberts' two rushing touchdowns, #4 Saint John's edged Wis.-Eau Claire, 15-11 in the 2006 season opener for both teams on Saturday, Sept. 2 at Clemens Stadium in Collegetown.

Kofoed recorded his fourth career 300-yard passing game by throwing for an even 300 yards to six different receivers in the game.

Wis.-Eau Claire jumped on the board first with a 37-yard field goal by Craig Kolb with 6:38 left in the first quarter to give the visiting Blugolds a 3-0 lead. The Johnnies answered with an eight-play, 60-yard drive resulting in a 5-yard option run by Luberts. The missed extra point attempt gave the Johnnies a 6-3 lead with 2:40 left in the first quarter.

After pinning the Blugolds to a three-and-out possession on their own 1-yard line, SJU began its second scoring drive at the Eau Claire 24-yard line with just over three and a half minutes to play in the second quarter. Three plays later, Luberts again scored on an option run from two yards out. The following PAT by junior Brian McKenna gave the Johnnies a 13-3 lead heading into the half.

Junior wide receiver Brian Weber provided a welcome surprise with 109 yards receiving on four catches in the first half for the Johnnies.

In the third quarter, however, it was the Johnnies' defense that provided the spotlight. With just over five minutes remaining in the third quarter, Saint John's thwarted two Blugold attempts from the Johnnies' 1-yard line. On third-and-goal, junior safety John Cloeter upended Wis.-Eau Claire's Cory Sartorelli for no gain. After a timeout, the Blugolds decided to go for the touchdown rather than three points. On four-and-goal, senior cornerback Mike Burtzel spun quarterback Kyle Paulson out of bounds on a rollout keeper for a 1-yard loss.

On a first down from the 10-yard line, Saint John's defense, courtesy of sophomore defensive tackle Nick Gunderson and senior linebacker Jamie Steffensmeier, added two points to the Johnnie lead (15-3) by sacking Paulson in the end zone for a safety. Following an interception by Dave Wicklund, the Blugolds found the end zone with less than two minutes remaining in the game. Paulson found Matthew Evensen on an 11-yard corner fade with 1:39 showing on the clock. The two point conversion was good, cutting the SJU lead to 15-11.

The ensuing onside kick was fielded by senior wide receiver Kyle Gearman, sealing the victory for Saint John's. Gearman finished the game with seven receptions for 99 yards.

Defensively for Saint John's, Steffensmeier tallied 13 tackles (4 solo) and 1.5 sacks for a loss of 13 yards. Gunderson added 10 tackles and 1.5 sacks, including the critical third quarter safety. Junior linebacker James Shockman recorded SJU's only pass interception on the day.

Paulson completed 19-of-33 passes for 214 yards and one touchdown. Evensen added 84 yards receiving on eight catches. Defensively for Wis.-Eau Claire, Ryan Schulz and Dan Rogney recorded nine and eight tackles, respectively.

Luberts ended the day with 47 yards rushing on 13 carries and two touchdowns, while senior Mike Lofboom tallied six catches for 52 yards in addition to 14 yards rushing. Kofoed completed 23-of-38 attempts for 300 yards and had one interception. Junior punter Zach Reif averaged 44.3 yards per punt on three attempts for the Johnnies.

John Gagliardi

The first active head coach to be inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame (Class of 2006), Saint John's University legendary head coach John Gagliardi begins his 58th season as a collegiate head football coach and 54th season as head coach in Collegetown in 2006. The winningest coach all-time in college football history, Gagliardi currently owns a 432-118-11 (.780) collegiate career record and a 408-112-10 (.779) record at SJU. Gagliardi's 57 years of collegiate coaching is tied for the most in college football history with former Pacific coach Amos Alonzo Stagg (1890-1946).



Gagliardi tied the all-time collegiate win record, held by former Grambling State head coach Eddie Robinson, on Nov. 1, 2003 and broke the all-time record on Nov. 8, 2003 on the way to a perfect 14-0 season and an NCAA championship.

Gagliardi's coaching career began when his high school coach at Trinidad, Colo. Catholic was drafted into World War II, Gagliardi, as captain, took over the reins at the age of 16 in 1943. His teams won four conference titles in Gagliardi's six years of coaching high school at Trinidad Catholic and St. Mary's in Colorado Springs.

After graduation from Colorado College in 1949, his first college coaching position was at Carroll College in Helena, Mont. The college was thinking about dropping football because of losing seasons and lack of interest.

Gagliardi led Carroll to three conference titles in his first four seasons as a college coach. Gagliardi coached basketball and baseball and also won championships.

His success caught the attention of Saint John's University in Collegetown, Minn. Saint John's needed a coach to succeed the legendary Johnny "Blood" McNally, a charter member of the Professional Football Hall of Fame.

Compared to Carroll, Saint John's football program was healthy before Gagliardi's arrival but not exactly thriving. SJU had not won a conference title in 15 years. Gagliardi took over the program in 1953 with a mandate to turn the program around. Meanwhile, Blood offered this gloomy prediction: "Nobody could ever win at Saint John's."

Once again, Gagliardi surprised the skeptics by winning the MIAC title that fall. He also won championships with SJU's track team, and he also coached the SJU hockey team for five seasons, compiling a 42-25-1 record, which is still the best career winning percentage of any hockey coach in school history.

UW-RF At Ramer Field

The Falcons are 27-23 at Ramer Field since 1995. The Falcons last winning season at Ramer Field was in 2000, when they went 3-1. In conference play, the Falcons are 22-15 at Ramer Field since 1995, with their last winning season in 2001, when they finished 2-1. The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in conference play.

UW-RF On The Road

The Falcons are 26-32 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play. The Falcons are 21-19 on the road in conference play since 1995. In 1999 and 2000 the Falcons finished with 3-1 records on the road in conference play.

UW-RF At Neutral Sites

The Falcons are 4-1 at neutral sites since 1995. They have not played a neutral site game since 2000, when they lost to Bemidji State at the Metrodome, 23-20.

UW-RF Football History

The first year of Falcon football was in 1895 when the team finished with a 2-0 record after playing and beating New Richmond High School twice. The first game against a collegiate team was in 1899 when the Falcons lost to Superior, 12-0. It wasn't until 1923 when the Falcons started playing only collegiate teams. UW-RF has won 18 WIAC titles, third most of all WIAC institutions. The Falcons have a 472-309-49 record in 103 seasons.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is in his 18th year as head coach at UW-RF and stands second in all-time football wins.

Under O'Grady the Falcons have compiled an 92-75-3 overall record, a winning percentage of .550. Among WIAC active coaches he is third in wins and is eighth in all-time wins. He needs just three wins to reach the seventh spot. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 17 seasons with the Falcons.



Year-in and year-out the Falcons are one of the top teams in the WIAC under the veteran coach. In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and

5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14). In 1999 the Falcons were 6-4 and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

Last year UW-RF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in the WIAC. They placed seventh. In 2004 the Falcons finished a disappointing 3-7 overall and 3-4 (fifth place tie) in the WIAC. In 2003 the Falcons were 2-7 overall and 2-5 (sixth place) in league play. In 2002 UWRF was 3-7 overall and 2-5 in WIAC play (sixth place). The Falcons finished 4-5 overall and 4-3 (tie third place) in the WIAC in 2001. In 2000, the Falcons were 6-4 overall and 5-2 (third place) in the WIAC.

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 61-50-3 record in WIAC play. O'Grady combines his vast football knowledge and intensity to help the Falcons succeed.

O'Grady, 53, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UW-RF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UW-RF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 166 of 167 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching, business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UW-RF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UW-RF for 33 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, special teams coach of the Arizona Cardinals, has been a counselor for 29 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has spoken at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 15 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football clinic in Gilman, Wis. The clinic was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 25, Jaclyn, 22 and Logan 19. Lindsey, a UW-RF graduate, teaches social studies and coaches volleyball and track & field at the Mauston middle school. Jaclyn graduated from the University of Minnesota in 2005 with a degree in film studies. She plans on going to graduate school. Logan will be a sophomore at the University of St. Thomas this fall and competes in cross country and track & field.
