The Falcons open WIAC play this week with two games. On Wednesday UWRF travels to Superior and on Saturday the Falcons will host Stevens Point.

UWRF enters WIAC play 1-2 overall. Four players average in double figures in scoring; Ryan Thompson (17.3), Jontae Koonkaew (14.7), Nate Robertson (14.7) and Courtney Davis (14.0). Thompson and Davis are juniors while Robertson and Koonkaew are freshmen. Robertson was named the team's Player of the Week after he scored 26 points and grabbed 15 rebounds in the 87-73 loss to Macalester on Saturday at the Karges Center.

UWS is under first year Coach David Buchanan. The Jacket leader is Leonard Cobb who was named to the 2006 All-WIAC first team. He is averaging 24.3 points and 11.3 rebounds a game.

UWSP enters the week with a perfect 3-0 record. They open WIAC play on Wednesday at Oshkosh. UWSP is ranked No. 9 in this week's D3Hoops.com poll. Jon Krull, who was also named to the 2006 first All-WIAC team, leads the Pointers averaging 23.3 points and six rebounds a game. UWSP has shot 94-188 (.500) from the floor so far in 2006.

Jeff Berkhof

Head Coach

Jeff Berkhof takes over as head men's interim basketball coach at UW-River Falls for the 2006-07 season.

Berkhof is no stranger to Falcon basketball. He was former Coach Rick Bowen's top assistant for the past nine seasons and a member of the Falcon coaching staff dating back to the 1994-95 season.

During his 12-year span as an assistant coach, Berkhof has held many responsibilities. He has coordinated the Falcon recruiting efforts, directed the Falcon summer basketball camps, and organized scouting / film exchange. He has also had numerous administrative duties and on the floor coaching responsibilities.

While an assistant to the men's basketball program, Berkhof was also the head women's golf coach at UW River Falls from 2002-06. He was named the WIAC women's golf Coach of the Year in 2004 after leading the golf team to a third place finish in the WIAC meet.

Before joining the coaching ranks, Berkhof spent two seasons playing for the Falcons in 1992-94. During his senior season, he was selected to the 1994 All-WSUC team and was chosen Co-MVP and Co-Captain by his teammates. Before coming to UW-River Falls, Berkhof played two years at Worthington Junior College, in Worthington, Minn. In 1997, he was inducted into the Minnesota Junior College Athletic Hall of Fame. Prior to his time at Worthington JC, he attended South Dakota State University in Brookings, S.D., and was a member of the SDSU football squad.

The Hills, Minn., native received his masters of education degree in sport management at the University of Minnesota in 2005. He completed his bachelor of science degree at UW-River Falls with a major in physical education and a minor in athletic coaching in 1994. Berkhof is an instructor in the health and human performance department at UW-River Falls.

Jeff and his wife Jill reside in Hudson. Jill is a UW-River Falls alum and fifth grade teacher at Lake Elmo, Minn. They have one son, Benjamin, who was born in June of 2004.

UW-River Falls vs. Superior -- Last Meeting Jan. 25, 2006 at Superior, Wis. River Falls 75, Superior 60

The Falcon won on the road Wednesday night, defeating the Yellowjackets 75-60 in Superior, Wis.

Hans Hoeg led the Falcons, scoring a career-high 31 points in leading to Falcons to victory. Hoeg finished the game shooting 10-18 from the field, 4-7 from three-point range and 7-9 from the free throw line. Ryan Thompson picked up his first career double-double, dishing out ten assists and scoring 12 points. Erik Olson was the only other Falcon in double figures, scoring 11 points, he shot 3-5 from beyond the arc.

Superior was led by Tyler Hildebrandt's 15 points and six rebounds. Leonard Cobb scored 11 and picked up a team-high eight rebounds for the Yellowjackets.

The Falcons had one of their best shooting performances of the season. They finished the game shooting 53 percent (27-51) from the field and 52 percent (11-21) from three-point range. The Falcons didn't fare as well at the free throw line, only shooting 63 percent on 10-16 shooting.

The Falcons also out-rebounded their opponent for one of the few times this season. The Falcons finished with 31 rebounds while relinquishing only 28. Hoeg led the Falcons with nine boards.

The win improved the Falcons to 4-14 overall and 3-7 in WIAC play. The loss dropped Superior to 4-14 overall and 0-10 in conference play.

UW-River Falls vs. Stevens Point -- Last Meeting Jan. 18, 2006 at River Falls, Wis. Stevens Point 70, River Falls 56

The Falcon men's lost 70-56 Saturday night at the Karges Center to Stevens Point.

The Falcons finished with three players in double figures. Ryan Zylstra led the Falcons with 18 points and grabbed seven rebounds. Hans Hoeg scored 14 points on 4-9 shooting and Ryan Thompson scored 10 points, while dishing out a game-high eight assists and grabbing five rebounds. Mark James led both teams with ten rebounds.

With 14:02 remaining in the first half Stevens Point Freshman Pete Rortvedt scored to give the Pointers a 9-8 lead, shortly after Jon Krull hit a three-pointer giving the Pointers a lead that they would never relinquish. Stevens Point played a methodical and composed game in the first half, knocking down 50 percent (15-30) of their shots from the field and 50 percent (6-12) of their shots from beyond the arc in the first half, while limiting their turnovers to five.

The Falcons shot 40 percent (10-25) from the field in the first half and 29 percent (2-7) from beyond the arc. They knocked down all of their free throws, going 6-6 from the charity stripe. The Falcons trailed the Pointers 36-28 at the half.

The Falcons scored first in the second half bringing them within six, but the Pointers followed with a 7-0 run of their own to bring the lead back up to thirteen. The closest River Falls came after that was within seven when Eric Kossoris scored to bring the Falcons within seven. Stevens Point answered with two quick threes and the Falcons never recovered.

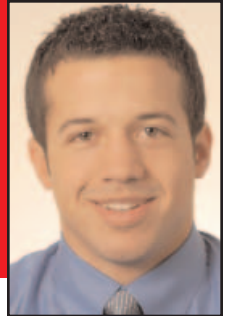

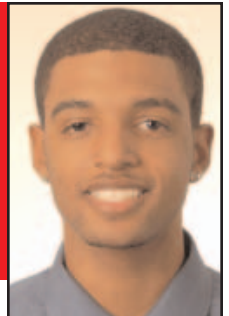

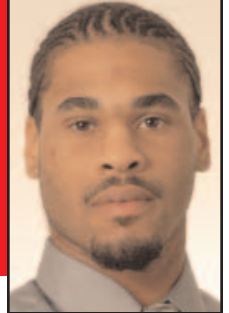
