The Falcons will take a break from WIAC play with three non-conference games scheduled this week. Tuesday the Falcons host Bethany Lutheran, Thursday they travel to Crown and Saturday are at Concordia-St. Paul.

UWRF will try to snap a three game losing streak. The Falcons lost two WIAC games last week by a combined five points. Four Falcons average in double figures in scoring - Courtney Davis (14.9), Nate Robertson (14.6), Ryan Thompson (14.4) and Jontae Koonkaew (13.). Robertson (42-65, .646) leads the WIAC in shooting percentage. He is fifth in rebounding (8.3) and third in blocks (16). Thompson is second in the WIAC in three-pointers made per game (2.57).

Head Coach

Jeff Berkhof takes over as head men's interim basketball coach at UW-River Falls for the 2006-07 season.

Berkhof is no stranger to Falcon basketball. He was former Coach Rick Bowen's top assistant for the past nine seasons and a member of the Falcon coaching staff dating back to the 1994-95 season.

During his 12-year span as an assistant coach, Berkhof has held many responsibilities. He has coordinated the Falcon recruiting efforts, directed the Falcon summer basketball camps, and organized scouting / film exchange. He has also had numerous administrative duties and on the floor coaching responsibilities.

While an assistant to the men's basketball program, Berkhof was also the head women's golf coach at UW River Falls from 2002-06. He was named the WIAC women's golf Coach of the Year in 2004 after leading the golf team to a third place finish in the WIAC meet.

Before joining the coaching ranks, Berkhof spent two seasons playing for the Falcons in 1992-94. During his senior season, he was selected to the 1994 All-WSUC team and was chosen Co-MVP and Co-Captain by his teammates. Before coming to UW-River Falls, Berkhof played two years at Worthington Junior College, in Worthington, Minn. In 1997, he was inducted into the Minnesota Junior College Athletic Hall of Fame. Prior to his time at Worthington JC, he attended South Dakota State University in Brookings, S.D., and was a member of the SDSU football squad.

The Hills, Minn., native received his masters of education degree in sport management at the University of Minnesota in 2005. He completed his bachelor of science degree at UW-River Falls with a major in physical education and a minor in athletic coaching in 1994. Berkhof is an instructor in the health and human performance department at UW-River Falls.

Jeff and his wife Jill reside in Hudson. Jill is a UW-River Falls alum and fifth grade teacher at Lake Elmo, Minn. They have one son, Benjamin, who was born in June of 2004.

UW-River Falls vs. Bethany Lutheran -- Last Meeting

River Falls 79, Bethany Lutheran 61

The Falcons ended their losing skid Friday night with a 79-61 win over Bethany Lutheran in Mankato, Minnesota. The Falcons improve their record to 2-8 on the season.

The Falcons started with a make shift line-up, including sophomore Tim Pearson and freshman Jimmy Glaeser. Pearson scored a career high, leading the Falcons with 19 points, he shot 7-9 from the field, 2-2 from three-point range and 3-4 from the free-throw line. Hans Hoeg scored 16 points and led both teams with a game-high five rebounds.

The Falcons shot well in the first half, hitting 43 percent (13-30) from the floor, 46 percent (6-13) from beyond the arc, and 80 percent (4-5) from the free throw line. The Falcons entered the half with a 36-30 lead.

The second half was more of the same for the Falcons, hitting 62 percent (18-29) from the field, 46 percent (5-11) from three-point land, and 67 percent (2-3) from the charity stripe.

The Falcons finished the game with four players scoring in double-figures. Pearson and Hoeg led the team, and Scott Kelly and Ryan Thompson added 11 and 10 each. Eric Kossoris led the Falcons with four assists.

UW-River Falls vs. Con.-St. Paul -- Last Meeting

Con.-St. Paul 57, River Falls 54

The Falcons opened the season Friday night with a 57-54 loss to Division II opponent, Concordia-St. Paul.

The first half was played with a very high tempo and a low shooting percentage. The Falcons shot 37.9 percent from the field in the first half, knocking down 11-29 shots. They also knocked down 30 percent from beyond the arc, shooting 3-10. Concordia-St. Paul didn't shoot much better in the first half, hitting 40.6 percent of their shots from the field on 13-32 shooting. They also shot 2-11 from three-point range and 1-3 from the free throw line. The Falcons had the lead entering the half, 30-29.

The Falcons finished the game shooting 33.9 percent from the field on 19-56 shooting. They also shot 23.5 (4-17) percent from beyond the arc. The Falcons were able to shoot well from the free throw line, knocking down 92.3 percent, hitting 12-13. The Golden Bears finished the game shooting 39 percent (4-17) from the floor, 31.3 percent (5-16) from three-point range and 50 percent (6-12) from the free throw line.

Hans Hoeg led the Falcons in scoring with 16 points, he also picked up seven rebounds and two assists. Ryan Zylstra was the only other Falcon in double figures, he scored 14 points and pulled down five rebounds. Eric Kossoris led the Falcons with four assists. Mark James also grabbed seven rebounds on the game.

Concordia-St. Paul was led by Pointer, who scored 21 points. Kyle Marxhausen led the Golden Bears with seven rebounds. Ty Thomas led the team with four assists and scored ten points as well.

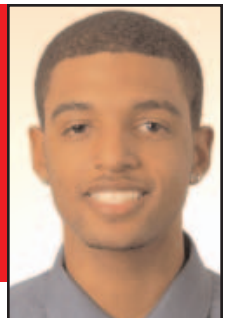
