Head Coach

Jeff Berkhof takes over as head men's interim basketball coach at UW-River Falls for the 2006-07 season.

Berkhof is no stranger to Falcon basketball. He was former Coach Rick Bowen's top assistant for the past nine seasons and a member of the Falcon coaching staff dating back to the 1994-95 season.

During his 12-year span as an assistant coach, Berkhof has held many responsibilities. He has coordinated the Falcon recruiting efforts, directed the Falcon summer basketball camps, and organized scouting / film exchange. He has also had numerous administrative duties and on the floor coaching responsibilities.

While an assistant to the men's basketball program, Berkhof was also the head women's golf coach at UW River Falls from 2002-06. He was named the WIAC women's golf Coach of the Year in 2004 after leading the golf team to a third place finish in the WIAC meet.

Before joining the coaching ranks, Berkhof spent two seasons playing for the Falcons in 1992-94. During his senior season, he was selected to the 1994 All-WSUC team and was chosen Co-MVP and Co-Captain by his teammates. Before coming to UW-River Falls, Berkhof played two years at Worthington Junior College, in Worthington, Minn. In 1997, he was inducted into the Minnesota Junior College Athletic Hall of Fame. Prior to his time at Worthington JC, he attended South Dakota State University in Brookings, S.D., and was a member of the SDSU football squad.

The Hills, Minn., native received his masters of education degree in sport management at the University of Minnesota in 2005. He completed his bachelor of science degree at UW-River Falls with a major in physical education and a minor in athletic coaching in 1994. Berkhof is an instructor in the health and human performance department at UW-River Falls.

Jeff and his wife Jill reside in Hudson. Jill is a UW-River Falls alum and fifth grade teacher at Lake Elmo, Minn. They have one son, Benjamin, who was born in June of 2004.

UW-River Falls vs. UW-Eau Claire -- Last Meeting

Feb. 8, 2006 at Eau Claire, Wis.

River Falls 59, Eau Claire 57

The Falcons men's basketball team defeated UW-Eau Claire Wednesday night in a thriller at the Karges Center.

Hans Hoeg hit the game-winner on an off-balanced jump shot from the free throw line with 18 seconds remaining in the game. The Blugolds had one last shot, but Eau Claire guard Jared Bardon's shot attempt fell short with six seconds to play. Alex Maas knocked down one of two free throws with 0.1 on the clock to give the Falcons a 59-57 win.

The Falcons were led by Ryan Zylstra, who scored a career-high 27 points, blocked a career-high five shots and tied his career high with nine rebounds. Hoeg was the only other Falcon in double figures, scoring 21 points. Ryan Thompson led the Falcons with four assists.

The Falcons held their largest lead of five points with 7:45 remaining in the half, when Ryan Thompson hit a three point basket giving the Falcons a 17-12 lead. Eau Claire came back and tied the game at 17-17 with 6:39 to go. The Blugolds went on to lead by as many as four points in the first half. Hoeg hit a jumper as time expired to bring the Falcons within two, with the Falcons trailing 29-27 at the half.

In the first half the Falcons shot 45 percent (9-20) from the field, 25 percent (2-8) from beyond the arc, and 78 percent (7-9) from the free throw line.

The Falcons didn't have the lead in the second half until there was ten minutes remaining. Hoeg hit a three point shot to break a 45-45 tie. Soon after Hoeg's three the Blugolds regained the lead and led until 2:26 in the game when Zylstra hit a short jumper. Bardon scored soon after on an alley-oop lay-up before Hoeg hit the game winner with 18 seconds to play.

On the game the Falcons shot 44 percent (20-45) from the field, 22 percent (4-18) from three-point range, and 58 percent (15-26) from the free-throw line. The Blugolds shot 40 percent (20-50) from the field, 25 percent (4-16) from beyond the arc, and 81 percent (13-16) from the line.

UW-River Falls vs. Platteville -- Last Meeting

Platteville 70, River Falls 56

The Falcons men's basketball team lost their second consecutive game Saturday night 70-56, this time at the hands of the Platteville Pioneers.

Hans Hoeg led the Falcons once again, scoring a game-high 23 points. He finished the game shooting 5-13 from the field, 4-7 from beyond the arc and 9-12 from the free throw line. Entering the contest Hoeg was second in the WIAC in scoring, averaging 17.2 points per game. Ryan Zylstra was the only other Falcon in double digits, adding 13 points and a team-high six rebounds. Ryan Thompson led the Falcons with seven assists.

The Falcons held a brief 2-0 lead in the first minute of play, but never touched the lead again. With 16:05 remaining in the first half the Falcons came within one point, but the Pioneers went on a 10-0 run over the next six minutes to take a substantial lead. The Falcons managed to fight back again, coming within three points with 6:20 remaining in the half, when Hoeg hit a three-pointer to make the score 20-17 Platteville. Over the last six minutes of the half the Pioneers outscored River Falls 20-9 and took a 40-26 lead into the half.

The Pioneers extended their lead to 19 points with 13:45 remaining in the game when LeVon Crawford scored on a tip. The Falcons were never able to bring the score within single digits in the second half. UWRF is now 5-16 overall and 4-9 WIAC play.

The Falcons finished the game shooting 38 percent (17-45) from the field, 50 percent (7-14) from beyond the arc, and 65 percent (15-23) from the free throw line. Platteville finished the game shooting 39 percent (18-46) from the field, 31 percent (5-16) from three-point range, and 91 percent from the free throw line, hitting an astounding 29-32 from the charity stripe.

The Pioneers had four players in double figures. Crawford led the team with 19 points, eight rebounds and four assists. Josh Langenfeld (11), Mark Gossens (10) and Sean Krause (10) were the other Pioneers with double-digit scoring.

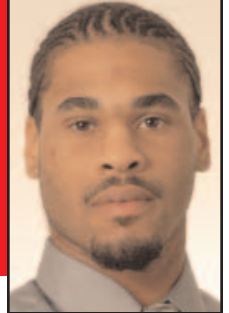
