

YOUTH DAY CAMP

Dates: June 11-14 Grades: 4-6 (Fall '07)
Time: 9 a.m.-12 Noon Fee: \$70



The Youth Day Camp is designed to teach the basic fundamentals of basketball. Each session will include skill development that will focus on dribbling, passing, shooting and defense. Team skill contests and two 5 on 5 games will also be included in each session. Team play will be stressed and each camper will receive equal playing time grouped by age and ability.

BIG MAN/GUARD CAMP

Dates: June 14-15 Grades: 9-12 (Fall '07)
Fee: \$90 Resident or \$70 Commuter



The Big Man/Guard Camp is designed for personalized instruction covering all offensive scoring phases for post players and guards concentrating on footwork and shot development. Each player will work on ball handling and passing, creating space and attacking the rim. Included will be strength and conditioning concepts to help in the total development of each camper. This camp will be run at a high intensity level similar to a college basketball practice. Overnight and meal accommodations will be provided. Apply early as enrollment is limited for this camp.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT CAMP

Dates: June 20-22 Grades: 7-10 (Fall '07)
Fee: \$170 Resident or \$145 Commuter



The skill development camp is designed for personalized instruction covering all phases of skill improvement. Each session will include fundamental teaching stations that will consist of repetitive skill work with proper technique and footwork being emphasized. The teaching stations will be done with high intensity and will be broken down into different aspects of the game.

Each session will include 5-on-5 games with campers grouped by age and ability while receiving equal playing time. Offensive and defensive team concepts, game situations and the ability to compete against the area's best young players will aid in the development of each camper's skill development. Overnight and meal accommodations will be provided.

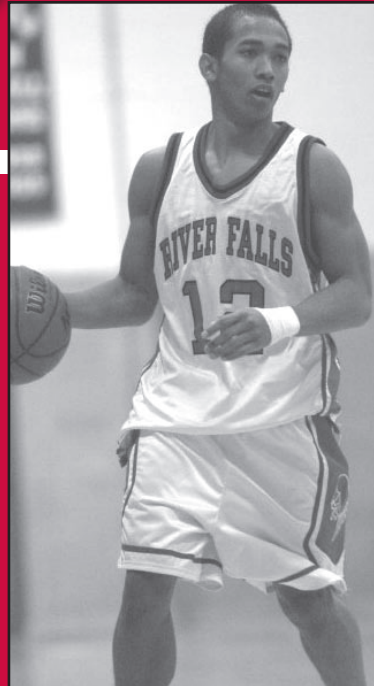

DEPOSIT / CANCELLATIONS

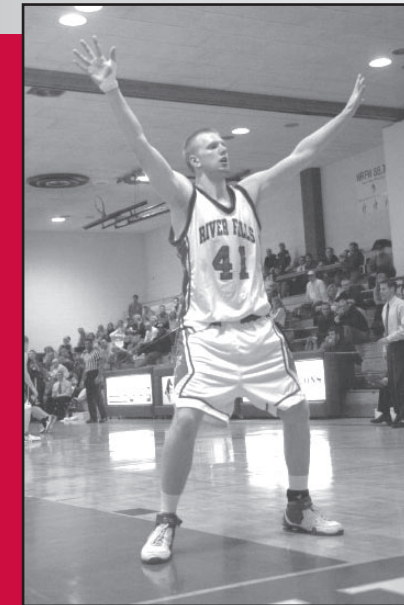
