- \* The Falcons return home for the first time in three weeks on Saturday when they host Eau Claire at 1 p.m.
- \* RF lost a 38-12 WIAC game at Whitewater last Saturday. UWW jumped out to a 21-0 first quarter lead and never looked back. EC beat No. 6 ranked La Crosse at home, 31-29. Craig Kolb kicked a 46-yard field goal with just 24 second to play. EC is ranked No. 16 in this week's D3Football.com poll.
- \* This is the 87th meeting between the teams. The Falcons hold a 46-33-7 lead in the series. EC has won the last five games including a 23-3 win last season.
- \* The Falcons threw a season-high four pass interceptions last week at UWW. RF has turned the ball over 12 times (10 interceptions, two fumbles) and came up with 11 turnovers (four interceptions, seven fumbles).
- \* Falcon senior running back Nathan Anderson did it again - he rushed for over 100 yards for the 18th time in his career. He carried the ball 23 times for 126 yards and one touchdown at Whitewater. He has gone over the 100 yard mark in four of the team's five games this year. His career best is a 230 yard effort against Eau Claire in 2005. He is third in the WIAC in rushing yards.
- \* Falcon senior linebacker Bruce Baillargeon was named the WIAC Defensive Player of the Week after he made 22 tackles at UWW. He had 17 solo stops and one tackle for loss. He leads the WIAC in tackles per game (12.8).
- \* Falcon senior end Gregg Neumann leads the WIAC in sacks with 8.5. He had two at UWW and has had six in the past two games.
- \* UWRf freshman wide receiver Michael Zweifel leads the WIAC in receptions (42), touchdown catches (5) and receiving yards (574). He had six catches for 100 yards and scored on a 52-yard pass play at UWW.
- \* Junior quarterback Storm Harmon is getting closer to the UWRf single season passing record. He has thrown for 1,105 yards this year. He has already tied or broke three UWRf passing records. Against Pacific Lutheran he was 26-49 which set records for completions and attempts in a game. Against Hope he threw four touchdown passes which tied the school record. The Falcon record for yards in a season is 1,506.
- \* Falcon Coach John O'Grady, in his 19th season at UWRf, has a 96-86-3 career record. He is a 1979 graduate of UWRf and is third among active WIAC coaches in wins. He is 9-9 against UWEC.

- \* After Saturday's game against Eau Claire the Falcons are back on the road with a WIAC game at Stout. Kick off is set for 1 p.m.

**Whitewater 38, River Falls 12**

The Falcons lost their fourth consecutive game Saturday as No. 3 ranked UW-Whitewater won at home, 38-12.

UWW scored touchdowns on three of its first four drives, all in the first quarter, leading them to a 21-0 lead after the first period.

After stopping the Falcons with a three-and-out, the Warhawks marched 59 yards in five plays to take a 7-0 lead when Justin Beaver scored on a 15-yard run. After a River Falls punt was returned 22 yards by Neil Mrkvicka to the Falcon 33, UWW took five plays to go the rest of the way. Max Wasikowski scored on a 1-yard run with 3:51 to play in the opening stanza to give UWW a 14-0 lead. The Warhawk defense again stopped the Falcons in three plays and took over at its 49 with 2:57 to play in the quarter. Another five play drive netted the 51 yards needed. Beaver scored from 16 yards out to make it a 21-0 game.

The Falcons used a turnover to score the only points of the second quarter. On a third-and-15 play at midfield, Falcon safety Joseph Simonson intercepted a Warhawk pass and returned it 31 yards to the UWW 37. The Falcons converted two third-and-five situations to keep the drive alive. Nathan Anderson scored from six-yards out to make it a 21-6 game after the point after kick failed.

UWW added 10 third quarter points to take a 31-6 lead. The first score was set up when a Jesse Finer 48-yard field goal attempt was blocked and recovered at the UWW 31. Eight plays later Danny Jones rambled 19 yards for the score with 10:02 to play in the quarter.

UWRF then put together a nine-play drive and had a first down at the UWW 15. But Storm Harmon's pass was intercepted by Matt Blaziewske at the UWW 10. He returned it to midfield. From there the Warhawks drove 44 yards in eight plays before the Falcon defense stiffened. Jeff Schabler kicked a 23-yard field goal with 4:48 to play in the third quarter to give UWW a 31-6 lead.

The teams traded fourth quarter touchdowns.

UWW scored first when Jace Rindahl intercepted a Harmon pass to give his team a first down at the UWRF 10. Two plays later Jones scored his second rushing touchdown of the day on a 6-yard run to make it a 38-6 game.

But the Falcons took the ensuing kick off and marched 80 yards in six plays that ended in the team's biggest play of the game. Backup quarterback Ryan Lessen hit wide receiver Michael Zweifel with a 52-yard pass play that went for a touchdown.

On UWW's next possession UWRF cornerback Jamie Bisch intercepted a Jones pass to stop the drive. But Luessenheide threw two interceptions in the team's last two drives.

The story of the day was the rushing game. Two of the conference's top three rushers were featured; UWW's Beaver and RF's Anderson. Neither senior runner disappointed, with both going over the 100-yard mark.

Anderson carried the ball 23 times for 126 yards and a touchdown. But it was Beaver who scored on the 15-yard and a 16-yard runs. He rushed the ball 25 times for 233 yards and those two touchdowns.

Altogether WWW finished with 291 rushing yards and five rushing touchdowns on the day.

The RF offense moved the ball well, gaining 346 total yards, but was unable to maintain, or finish off, drives by throwing four interceptions. RF also had a season high 10 penalties for 62 yards.

The top receiver in the conference, Zweifel, had another big game catching six passes for 100 yards and a 52-yard touchdown pass in the fourth quarter.

Zweifel leads the conference in receptions (42), yards (574), receiving touchdowns (5), and receptions per game (9).

Senior defensive end Gregg Neumann added two sacks to his conference-leading total, now up to 8.5 sacks on the year. Senior linebacker Bruce Baillargeon had 17 solo tackles and five assists, for 22 total stops.

## Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is a determined football coach.

The Falcons have finished 3-7 in each of the last three seasons and O'Grady is determined to return the football program to the success it enjoyed in the past.

A big change came last season when the Falcons ran a zone offense. That ended a streak of 30-plus years of the Falcons utilizing the run oriented wishbone offense. As with any change, there were growing pains. But O'Grady saw improvements throughout the season.

"Our offense is a strong run oriented system. We have to be able to run and pass the ball. It is still what I consider a strong rushing offense, but we need to do both well."

O'Grady will coach the Falcon offense again in 2007 and will get plenty of support from Assistant Coach Andy Kotelnicki who is the team's offensive coordinator.

When the Falcons put together back-to-back NCAA playoff appearances in 1995 and 1996, the Falcon defenses dominated opponents and played a key role in the team's success.

Many of the defensive coaches return and that gives the team needed consistency in coaching methods and strategies. "Jeff Rogers (linebackers) and Woody Fangmeier (defensive line) are assistant coaches who will all be back," said O'Grady. "They will be crucial to our success. We've been running the system for three years and we're all still learning it. Having the assistant coaches back will help in continuing our defensive improvement." The addition of former Falcon Scott Imrie to the staff is also a key. He will coach the defensive backs – the position he played with the Falcons from 1993-96.

O'Grady enters his 19th year as head coach at UWRF and stands second in all-time football wins with a 95-82-3 overall record. Among WIAC active coaches he is second in wins and is seventh in all-time wins of all WIAC coaches. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 18 seasons with the Falcons.

In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the NCAA playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the NCAA playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14).

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 68-58-3 record in WIAC play.

O'Grady, 53, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UWRF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UWRF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 181 of 182 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching and business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UWRF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UWRF for 34 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, a special teams coach for several NFL teams, has been a counselor for 30 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has given presentations at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 17 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football camp in Gilman, Wis. The camp was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 26, Jaclyn, 23 and Logan 20. Lindsey, a UWRF graduate, is completing her master's degree in curriculum and instruction at the University of St. Thomas. Jaclyn graduated in 2005 from the University of Minnesota with a degree in film studies. She is now working on a master's degree in film studies in Australia. Logan studied for two years at St. Thomas but has transferred to UW-La Crosse and is majoring in communications. He was a member of the Tommie cross country and track & field teams the past two years and will compete with the Eagles highly successful cross country and track & field teams.

## Eau Claire 31, La Crosse 29

With 24 seconds left in the game, Craig Kolb nailed a 46-yard field goal to give the UW-Eau Claire football team a thrilling 31-29 victory over sixth-ranked UW-La Crosse.

The game brings the Blugolds to 2-1 in Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) play and 5-1 overall.

It was also the fourth consecutive homecoming win for Eau Claire and the kick that won it is tied for fifth longest in Eau Claire history.

Eau Claire had the early lead over the Eagles due to a blocked punt in the first quarter. La Crosse's opening drive got to the Eau Claire 48, but Chris Hull knocked down the Brett Nagan punt and it rolled to the La Crosse 9 before Nils Dillon recovered. Three plays later, Mitch Schaeuble threw a perfect pass to Tony Hull in the back of the end zone for a 7-0 lead. Each team mostly stayed on its respective half for the rest of the quarter.

With 13:04 left in the second quarter, the Blugolds began a much longer scoring drive. A couple key third down plays fueled the drive, including a 24-yard pass to Tony Hull on one third down and a 28-yard reverse to Spencer Kehoe on another. The team got to the Eagles' 17 and threw a toss to the end zone. A pass interference call then moved the ball to the 2 and Cory Sartorelli burst in one play later to make it 14-0.

On the ensuing kickoff, Mike DeLong gave La Crosse good field position with a return to the Eagles' 47. Alex Seguin passed La Crosse to the Blugolds' 25 before Dan Hall had rushes of 11 and then 14, with the last one making it to pay dirt. Chris Below blocked the extra point and the scoreboard read 14-6 with 8:09 left in the quarter.

Two La Crosse drives later, the Eagles started at their 22. After a 13-play series, they hit a 24-yard field goal just before half to make it 14-9. Hall had 30 of the yards on the ground.

On the second half kickoff, Tony Hull returned it to the Blugolds' 39 before fumbling. The Eagles recovered to set up a scoring opportunity. They made it within the red zone and even to the 7, but Nate Jahn sacked Seguin for a 13-yard loss. On the 37-yard Dylan Rude field goal, Sam Cummings got his hand on the ball and it rolled for a touch-back.

Eau Claire then went on an 80-yard, 15-play drive to set up Sartorelli's second score of the day. Kehoe had another reverse for 16 yards and Schaeuble connected with Sartorelli for a 15-yard gain. Sartorelli ran for 31 of the yards and punched in a 3-yard touchdown on third down as Eau Claire went up 21-9.

La Crosse wouldn't strike until the fourth, but came back with a lot of points. However, Eau Claire scored first in their next drive after the Sartorelli score. The 60-yard drive ended on a 17-yard completion to Chris Hull.

With 12:31 left in the fourth, Seguin led La Crosse for an 80-yard drive. He had consecutive completions of 23, 11, 11, and 15 on the way to the 7. Eau Claire kept the Eagles from reaching the end zone for three plays, but La Crosse went for the score on fourth. A Tyler Keeney 6-yard snag got La Crosse one score closer with 9:07 to play.

Two plays into the ensuing Blugold drive, Schaeuble fumbled during a rush and La Crosse pounced on it to put it at the Eau Claire 23. Just four plays later, Hall carried it in from 10 yards out to close the margin to 28-23 with 7:14 left.

Eau Claire went three-and-out on their next drive and the Eagles took the punt to the La Crosse 27. The Eagles' series took 16 plays and 5:27, ending with a 1-yard touchdown from Mike Schmidt. There was a key fourth-and-1 during the drive that La Crosse converted. A run on the two-point conversion fell short as the Eagles took their first lead of the day at 29-28.

The Blugolds then had 1:10 to march from their 35 and take the game. The big play of the drive came two plays in with a 31-yard pass to Dillon. Dillon juggled the ball, but came up with a circus catch while falling down to bring Eau Claire to the Eagles' 34. A 5-yard gain followed in the following plays and Kolb came on for the 46-yarder. He nailed it to send the homecoming crowd into a frenzy.

## Todd Glaser has

returned to University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire...again. This time as the Blugolds' 15th head football coach.

Glaser had been the head coach at Marietta College in Marietta, Ohio the past three seasons after serving as Hoffner's defensive coordinator the four seasons prior to that.

Glaser is a Blugold alum who played for current Seattle Seahawks' coach Jim Lind during the 1987, 88, 89 and 90 seasons. He was the first of three brothers to don a blue and gold jersey for their collegiate careers with Tyler and Chad following in his footsteps.

Once his collegiate eligibility was completed, Glaser served as a student assistant for Lind for one season and then assisted Greg Polnasek for three seasons before leaving to become the head coach at Neillsville High School during the 1995 and 1996 campaigns. He returned to UWEC during Bob Nielson's final two years as head coach to serve as line-backer coach and strength and conditioning coordinator. He was a staff member when the Blugolds advanced to the NCAA Division III semifinals during the 1998 season.

During his final two years as the defensive coordinator in 2001 and 2002, the Blugolds produced 8-2 season records, shared the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference championship in 2001 and had the second-ranked defense in yardage allowed both years.

In the 10-team Ohio Athletic Conference, which produced this year's Division III national champion Mount Union College, Glaser guided Marietta to its first back-to-back non-losing seasons in 10 years. He was the OAC Coach of the Year in 2004 when Marietta finished with a 6-4 mark. He increased the Pioneers' squad size from 48 to 125 players during his three seasons there. He was also involved in a drive that raised \$2 million for a new football field, new football locker room, new softball field and new soccer field. He was also the assistant director of the M-Team, which is the athletics' fund-raising arm of the college.

Several Blugold coaches followed Glaser to Marietta with Curt Wiese serving as his offensive coordinator and Tony Jennison as his defensive coordinator. In addition, during his three years, former Blugold players and coaches Steve Murray, Dan Larson and Nick Goeser helped coached the Pioneers.

While a Blugold player, Glaser served as a team co-captain during the 1990 season and accumulated 199 career tackles as a defensive lineman.

The Falcon football team could not muster up enough big plays and the Blugolds capitalized on offense, en-route to a 23-3 victory Saturday afternoon at Carson Park.

In the first quarter the Falcons could not move the ball. Their longest drive of the first quarter was five plays for 17 yards. EC put together an 11 play 64 yard drive that ate up 5:26 off the clock, which was capped off by a Craig Kolb 41-yard field goal. The score after the first quarter was 3-0 UWEC.

After another RF punt, the Blugolds went to work right away on offense to begin the second quarter. UWEC went 65 yards in 10 plays which was capped off by another Kolb field goal this time from 27 yards out to make the score 6-0.

On RF's next possession they finally made some noise going 59 yards in 12 plays, which was capped off by a 33-yard Spasimir Bodurksi field goal to make the score 6-3 UWEC with only 1:20 left in the half.

UWEC big play ability on offense showed on its next drive. With only about one minute left in the half they went 80 yards in four

plays, which was capped off by a 38-yard Kyle Paulson to Chris Hull touchdown pass. The score at recess was 13-3 UWEC.

In the third quarter, UWEC used the momentum they got at the end of the first half and brought it to the second. After a Falcon turnover at their own 27-yard line the Blugolds drove three yards on four plays which was capped off by a another Kolb field goal this time from 41 yards out to make the score 16-3. After an RF interception, UWEC put the icing on the cake on their next possession with a one play Paulson to Evensen hookup for a touchdown to make the score 23-3. That ended the scoring.

RF was led by Nathan Anderson's 83 yards on 25 attempts. Jeremy Wolff threw 13 times, completing six of those for 76 yards. Connor Graves led the team with three catches for 30 yards. On defense the Falcons were led once again by Bruce Baillargeon who had five solo and 10 total tackles. Gregg Neumann chipped in with two sacks and Andy Kolstad added an interception.

The story of the game was Paulson who threw for 251 yards and two touchdowns. Hull and Evensen both had over 100 yards receiving and combined for 206 yards and two touchdowns. On the ground UWEC was led Eddy Kaiser who ran for 65 yards on 16 carries.
