Ramer Field (River Falls, Wis.)



- * The Falcons host UW-La Crosse at Ramer Field on Saturday in the annual Parents' Day game.
- * The Falcons earned a 42-36 come-from-behind win over UW-Platteville in overtime at Ramer Field last weekend. UWL lost a 31-28 decision at home to UW-Stout
- * This is the 93rd meeting between the teams and the Eagles hold a 56-29-7 lead in the series. UWL has won the past 14 games.
- * Falcon senior running back Nathan Anderson had his second most productive rushing game of his career against UWP. He finished with 215 yards and scored three times, including the game-winning points in overtime. His career best is a 230 yard effort against Eau Claire in 2005. He set a school career rushing mark and enters Saturday's game with 3,869 yards.
- * Falcon senior linebacker Bruce Baillargeon continues to lead the WIAC in tackles with 113. Twice he has had more than 20 tackles in a game. He also leads the conference in fumbles forced (3). Last weekend he returned kick offs and had three for 107 yards with a long of 47.
- * Falcon senior end Gregg Neumann continues to lead the WIAC in sacks (9.5) and is tied for the lead in tackles for loss (11.5). He has 20.5 career sacks.
- * UWRF freshman wide receiver Michael Zweifel tied a WIAC single game receptions record against Platteville. He had 17 catches for 140 yards and one touchdown. He continues to lead the WIAC in catches (67) and receiving yards (796). He has set a Falcon record for season receiving yards. The old record was 778.
- * Junior quarterback Storm Harmon has thrown for 1,727 yards this year. He has tied or broke four UWRF passing records. Against Pacific Lutheran he was 26-49 which set records for completions and attempts in a game. He tied the completions mark with 26 against UWP. Against Hope he threw four touchdown passes which tied the school record.
- * Falcon Coach John O'Grady, in his 19th season at UWRF, has a 98-87-3 career record. He is a 1979 graduate of UWRF and is third among active WIAC coaches in wins. He is 1-18-1 against UWL.

- * After Saturday's game against La Crosse the Falcons end their season at UW-Oshkosh on Nov. 10. Kick off is set for 1 p.m.

River Falls 42, Platteville 36 OT

Nate Anderson's 215 yards rushing and three scores helped the Falcons rally from a 15 point half time deficit to beat Platteville 42-36 at Ramer Field on Saturday.

Rushing was the way to move the ball down the field for both teams Saturday afternoon. Platteville had 276 rushing yards off 42 carries, lead by Junior Mike Grenslinger. The Falcons rushed the ball for 244 yards on 52 carries and four scores. Anderson led the Falcons with 215 and three scores.

The Falcons led the game with explosively, scoring within the first minute on the pursuing drive. Storm Harmon connected with Michael Zweifel for 33 yards on consecutive passes to set up a five yard touchdown pass from Storm Harmon to Ryan Hansen.

Platteville ended their first series with a punt. The Falcons marched all the way to the Platteville 18 yard line, after a return of 13 yards by Shane Hanson, when Harmon's pass was intercepted.

The Falcons again were knocking on Platteville's door. With the ball at midfield, Storm Harmon's pass intended for Michael Zweifel was intercepted by Quincy Hudson for a 63-yard Platteville touchdown.

A muffed snap deep in Falcon territory set up Platteville for their second score of the game. A snap intended for Falcon punter, Eric Stoller, went to his left and was recovered by the Pioneers on the Falcon's six yard line. After a holding penalty, Mike Grenslinger ran in it for a 16-yard touchdown.

After going three and out on the following series, the Eric Stoller punted the ball 47 yards to the Pioneer 16 yard line. The Pioneers muffed the catch and the Falcons recovered the ball on the 16 yard line. This set up for a Nathan Anderson 1-yard touchdown to tie the game at 14.

The next drive for the Pioneers was all Mike Greenslinger. Consecutive runs of 8, 19, and 30 yards got him into the end zone for the second time on the day. The Pioneers 2-point conversion was good, 22-14 Platteville.

Again the Falcons would punt the ball away after a false start and a holding penalty sent the Falcons back 15 yards. The Pioneers took the ball from their own 37 and scored on a 29-yard Joe Burkelund run.

After a three and out, the Pioneers punted the ball to the Falcon 38 yard line. A Nathan Anderson rush of 24 yards to the Platteville 3 yard line set up a Falcon touchdown. Storm Harmon connected with Michael Zweifel for the successful two point conversion that brought the Falcons within seven.

With 7:20 left in the fourth quarter, the Falcons got the ball back. Ryan Hansen caught a fourth down pass for a gain of 14 yards to keep the Falcon drive alive with less than four minutes to play. A Storm Harmon TD run capped off the Falcons drive, but kicker Dan Keller missed the extra point, leaving the Falcons down by one with 2:11 left in regulation

An onside attempt failed as the Pioneers recovered at the Falcon's 37 yard line. Tyson Droessler ran 17 yards for another Platteville touchdown and after the extra point increased their lead to 36-28 with 1:20 remaining.

Ryan Hansen kept the drive alive for the Falcons. The Sophomore Tight End caught a fourth down pass for a gain of 16 yards and another third down pass for a gain of 15 yards setting up for a Michael Zweifel lob from Harmon for a Falcon score. Harmon connected with Andy Marx for two, tying the game with seven seconds left in regulation.

The Falcons held the Pioneers to only five yards on their first and only overtime series. This set up a 37-yard Pioneer field goal attempt. Nathan Tenut got his hands up and blocked what would have been go ahead field goal.

Instead the Falcons took over on the Pioneer 25. A Michael Zweifel reception of 11 yards put the Falcons on the Pioneer four yard line. Nathan Anderson punched it into the endzone for his third score of the game, and the victory as River Falls defeated Platteville 42-36.

Andersons 215 yards put him at 1117 yards this season. Zweifel's 17 receptions tied a WIAC record.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is a determined football coach.

The Falcons have finished 3-7 in each of the last three seasons and O'Grady is determined to return the football program to the success it enjoyed in the past.

A big change came last season when the Falcons ran a zone offense. That ended a streak of 30-plus years of the Falcons utilizing the run oriented wishbone offense. As with any change, there were growing pains. But O'Grady saw improvements throughout the season.

"Our offense is a strong run oriented system. We have to be able to run and pass the ball. It is still what I consider a strong rushing offense, but we need to do both well."

O'Grady will coach the Falcon offense again in 2007 and will get plenty of support from Assistant Coach Andy Kotelnicki who is the team's offensive coordinator.

When the Falcons put together back-to-back NCAA playoff appearances in 1995 and 1996, the Falcon defenses dominated opponents and played a key role in the team's success.

Many of the defensive coaches return and that gives the team needed consistency in coaching methods and strategies. "Jeff Rogers (linebackers) and Woody Fangmeier (defensive line) are assistant coaches who will all be back," said O'Grady. "They will be crucial to our success. We've been running the system for three years and we're all still learning it. Having the assistant coaches back will help in continuing our defensive improvement." The addition of former Falcon Scott Imrie to the staff is also a key. He will coach the defensive backs – the position he played with the Falcons from 1993-96.

O'Grady enters his 19th year as head coach at UWRF and stands second in all-time football wins with a 95-82-3 overall record. Among WIAC active coaches he is second in wins and is seventh in all-time wins of all WIAC coaches. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 18 seasons with the Falcons.

In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the NCAA playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the NCAA playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14).

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 68-58-3 record in WIAC play.

O'Grady, 53, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UWRF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UWRF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 181 of 182 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching and business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UWRF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UWRF for 34 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, a special teams coach for several NFL teams, has been a counselor for 30 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has given presentations at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 17 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football camp in Gilman, Wis. The camp was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 26, Jaclyn, 23 and Logan 20. Lindsey, a UWRF graduate, is completing her master's degree in curriculum and instruction at the University of St. Thomas. Jaclyn graduated in 2005 from the University of Minnesota with a degree in film studies. She is now working on a master's degree in film studies in Australia. Logan studied for two years at St. Thomas but has transferred to UW-La Crosse and is majoring in communications. He was a member of the Tommie cross country and track & field teams the past two years and will compete with the Eagles highly successful cross country and track & field teams.

Stout 31, La Crosse 28

Stout used big plays on offense and defense and stopped a late La Crosse drive as the Blue Devils recorded a 31-28 victory over the Eagles Saturday afternoon at Roger Harring Stadium at Veterans Memorial Field. UW-L falls to 3-4 overall and 1-4 in the WIAC while UW-Stout improves to 4-4 overall and 3-2 in the conference.

After a scoreless first quarter, UW-Stout took a 7-0 lead in the second quarter as Tanner Kattre scored on a one-yard run with 6:54 left. UW-L came back to tie the contest at 7-7 with 1:10 left in the first half as Griffin Moe hit Ted Everson with a 12-yard touchdown pass. The Eagles' Billy Niggeman recovered a Blue Devils' fumble with :35 left in the first half and UW-L drove to the UW-Stout 16-yard line before Moe was intercepted by Jake Pomputis at the three-yard line to force a 7-7 halftime tie.

UW-Stout then scored 24 unanswered points in the third quarter to lead 31-7. Kattre hit Shawn Korth with a 45-yard touchdown pass with 9:06 remaining in the period and after UW-L's Dan Hall fumbled at UW-Stout's 39-yard line, Kattre hit Calvin White with a 61-yard touchdown pass on the next play from scrimmage to make it 21-7 with 6:24 left. Moe was then intercepted on the Eagles' next possession with Stephen Schils returning it 25-yards for a touchdown and UW-Stout led 28-7. Kyle Martin later hit a 27-yard field goal with 1:14 remaining in the third quarter.

UW-L cut the margin to 31-14 with 13:30 left in the game as Alex Seguin hit Jason Wagner with a 23-yard touchdown pass. Kattre then fumbled on UW-Stout's next possession and UW-L cut the lead to 31-20 as Hall scored on a four-yard run with 11:14 remaining. Seguin's two-point pass failed.

The Eagles then forced a Blue Devils' punt and drove to the four-yard line where Hall carried the ball to the UW-Stout one-yard line and fumbled, but Brian Edmiston recovered in the end zone for the touchdown. Hall scored on the two-point run to make it 31-28 with 8:04 remaining.

UW-L had two more possessions. The Eagles drove to the Blue Devils' 24-yard line with 1:23 remaining, but Seguin's fourth-down pass was incomplete. UW-L later forced a UW-Stout punt and took over at its own 35-yard line with :15 left. UW-Stout was called for roughing the passer on the first play and Seguin hit Wagner with a 25-yard completion to the Blue Devils' 30-yard line with just over :02 left. After a UW-L incomplection and two UW-Stout timeouts, Dylan Rude's 47-yard field goal was short on the final play of the game.

UW-L finished with 489 yards of offense, including 60 rushing and 429 passing. Hall rushed for 57 yards and a touchdown on 18 carries. Moe was 17-of-30 passing for 246 yards with one touchdown and two interceptions while Seguin was 15-of-23 for 183 yards with one touchdown. Wagner caught 14 passes for 200 yards for the Eagles while Everson had 11 catches for 135 yards. Both players caught a touchdown pass.

UW-Stout totaled 368 yards of offense, including 101 rushing and 267 passing. Kattre had 58 yards rushing on 20 attempts and one touchdown while finishing 12-of-17 passing for 249 yards with two touchdowns. Kyle Provos was two-of-four passing for 18 yards. Korth finished with four receptions for 83 yards and a touchdown.

UW-L had 27 first downs to UW-Stout's 16, but the Blue Devils controlled the time of possession, 31:45 to 28:15. UW-Stout was three-of-13 and UW-L six-of-17 on third-down.

Drew Kiefer led UW-L with seven tackles while Pomputis had 12 tackles for UW-Stout.

He has led UW-L to three Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) titles (2002, 2003, 2004) and guided the Eagles to four appearances in the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Division III Playoffs in his first seven years.



UW-L is coming off a 9-2 mark a year ago, its 35th winning season in the last 37 seasons. The Eagles went 6-1 in the WIAC last year, finishing in second-place. UW-L advanced to the NCAA III Playoffs in 2006, defeating Bethel University (Minn.) 28-21 in the first round before a 24-21 loss at second-ranked UW-Whitewater in the second round.

He has been selected the WIAC Coach of the Year three times (2002, 2003, 2004).

Terry is no stranger to the UW-L program and tradition. Terry, 51, was a 13-year-old ballboy when his father, Bill, served as an assistant coach for La Crosse. Larry went on to eventually play at UW-L, starring as a kickoff returner, before beginning his own coaching career.

Terry coached Ripon College to a 25-29-1 record - including a conference championship - in six seasons during the mid-80s. With his 49-25 (.662) mark at UW-L, Terry enters the 2007 campaign with a 74-54-1 (.578) career record in 13 years. Along with the head coaching stint at Ripon, he also served as offensive line coach at John Carroll University for three seasons and spent one season at Bowling Green State University as a graduate assistant.

Since Terry joined the Eagles' staff as offensive coordinator in 1988, UW-L has compiled a 165-50 (.767) record, won 11 WIAC titles, and made four national championship game appearances, winning two. Terry earned a bachelor's degree in physical and health education from UW-L in 1977, a master's degree in physical education from Bowling Green in 1978, and a doctorate in athletic administration from the University of New Mexico in 1990. While at New Mexico he chose to do his dissertation on the academic performance of athletes. He continues to show a strong commitment to the academic success of his athletes and believes that football is the "icing on the academic cake."

He has assembled an experienced coaching staff and is well known for his ability to recruit student-athletes by showing genuine interest in their future. "Our staff works well together because of our familiarity," says Terry. "We all share the same thoughts on a strong family approach which has been so important to our success."

La Crosse 41, River Falls 17

The Falcons fell behind 28-0 and lost at UW-La Crosse, 41-17, Saturday afternoon at Memorial Field.

The Eagles opened up with the first points of the game on an impressive 80-yard 12 play drive which was capped by a Corey Geldernick two-yard touchdown. The drive ate up 4:04 off the clock.

Later in the first quarter, UWL struck again this time putting together a 34-yard three play drive which was capped off by another Geldernick touchdown run this time from nine yards out to make the score 14-0.

The Eagles ended the first quarter in dominating fashion putting together another touchdown drive. The Eagles scored through the air on a 12-yard John Schumann laser to Ted Everson to make the score 21-0 after the first quarter. The drive covered 47 yards and it took six plays.

UWL got the ball back early in the second quarter and they wasted little time getting on the board as they scored two plays later on a 66-yard Dan Hall dash that made the score 28-0. The drive took only two plays and it covered 79 yards.

The Falcons finally got on the board with 4:31 left in the half on a three-yard fourth-and-goal Beau DeBruin touchdown run. The drive covered four yards and it took four plays. The score was set up

when Falcon linebacker Dan Buker recovered a UWL fumble at the La Crosse four.

The Eagles answered right back on their next possession going an impressive 83 yards in 12 plays which was capped off by a Dylan Rude 23-yard field goal with only 1:01 left in the half. The drive took 3:20 off the clock. The score at recess was 31-7 Eagles.

The Eagles took the opening possession of the second half and raced down the field going 80 yards in 12 plays which was capped by a Schumann three-yard touchdown run to make the score 38-7.

The Falcons got on the board midway through the third quarter on a 45-yard Spasimir Bodurski field goal. The drive covered five yards and it took four plays. The field goal was set up when Bruce Baillargeon recovered a La Crosse fumble at the UWL 33.

UWL ended the third quarter in style with another scoring drive. They went 41 yards in 10 plays and Rude capped the drive off again with another field goal, this time from 22 yards out, to make the score 41-10 going into the fourth quarter.

RF was the only team to score in the fourth quarter on a 5-yard Jeremy Wolff touchdown. It was an impressive 80-yard 10 play drive and it ate up 4:36 off the clock. That ended the scoring.

The Falcons were led by Wolff and DeBruin as they ran for 59 and 58 yards each and one touchdown apiece. Wolff was 6-10 passing for 62 yards. On defense the Falcons were led once again by Andy Kolstad who had nine solo and 12 total tackles.
