Titan Stadium (Oshkosh, Wis.)

* The Falcons go on the road to end the 2007 season at UW-Oshkosh on Saturday. Game time is set for noon. The game was originally set to start at 1 p.m., but a starting time change was needed to accommodate a NCAA regional soccer match that will be played at the stadium at 6 p.m.

* Last weekend the Falcons lost a 49-34 WIAC game at Ramer Field to La Crosse. The game was tied, 21-21, at the half, but UWL outscored the Falcons, 28-13, in the second half. Oshkosh took a 35-20 win at UW-Platteville.

* This is the 53rd meeting between the teams and the Falcons hold a 35-16-1 lead in the series that dates back to 1920. UW-O won last year's game at Ramer Field, 24-0.

* UWRF freshman wide receiver Michael Zweifel set a WIAC single game receptions record against La Crosse. He had 18 catches for 149 yards and one touchdown. The old record was 17 catches held by three players. He continues to lead the WIAC in catches (85) and receiving yards (945). He has set a Falcon record for season receiving yards and receptions.

* Falcon senior running back Nathan Anderson went over the 100 yard mark for the 21st time in his career against La Crosse. He finished with 143 yards and he scored four touchdowns. His career best is a 230 yard effort against Eau Claire in 2005. He has set a school career rushing mark and enters Saturday's game with 4,010 yards.

* Falcon senior linebacker Bruce Baillargeon continues to lead the WIAC in tackles with 124. Twice he has had more than 20 tackles in a game. He also leads the conference in fumbles forced (3).

* Falcon senior end Gregg Neumann continues to lead the WIAC in sacks (11.5). He had two against La Crosse. He leads the WIAC in tackles for loss (14). He has 22.5 career sacks.

* Junior quarterback Storm Harmon had his best day as a Falcon throwing the ball against La Crosse. He set a UWRF single game completion record against La Crosse with 34. He has thrown for a WIAC leading 2,067 yards this year. He has tied or broke six UWRF passing records; game completions (34), game attempts (49), season yards (2,067), season completions (192), season attempts (321) and touchdowns in a game (4).

* Falcon Coach John O'Grady, in his 19th season at UWRF, has a 98-88-3 career record. He is a 1979 graduate of UWRF and is third among active WIAC coaches in wins. He is 15-3-1 against UW-O.

La Crosse 49, River Falls 34

Despite freshman wide receiver Micahel Zeifel's record-setting day, River Falls was outscored 21-13 in the second half as a tied game at half-time turned into a 49-34 victory for La Crosse.

Zweifel caught 18 passes on the day, breaking the WIAC record of 17 for passes caught in a single game, a record that he tied last week.

The story of the day was RF's inability to stop the big play. La Crosse scored on touchdowns of 94 yards and 51 yards and racked up 251 kick return yards, averaging 50.2 yards per kick return.

The Falcons began the game with an eight-play 78-yard touchdown drive, capped by senior running back Nathan Anderson's first touchdown of the day from one yard out, putting the Falcons ahead 7-0.

La Crosse responded by throwing a 51-yard touchdown pass from Griffin Moe to Dan Hall on the second play of the ensuing drive, tying the game at 7-7.

RF's next drive stalled on the LC 36 yard line and the Falcons were forced to punt and put the LC offense back on field with its drive starting at the LC 22 yard line.

On the fifth play of the next LC drive senior defensive end Gregg Neumann forced a Moe fumble that gave RF the ball back on the LC 38 yard line. Anderson rushed the ball seven times on the ensuing drive for 33 yards, including a four-yard touchdown run that put RF back on top, 14-7 with 1:30 left in the first quarter.

The 14-7 Falcon lead only lasted 12 seconds when LC's Eric Donoval returned the RF kickoff 80 yards for the touchdown.

The score stood at 14-14 until the 3:23 mark of the third quarter when LC running back Eric Donoval capped a 10-play, 90-yard drive with a 19-yard touchdown run that put the Eagles back on top 21-14.

Junior quarterback Storm Harmon went 5-5 for 65 yards on the next drive, including a 38-yard bomb to freshman wide out Nate Thorseon. That deep ball set up a three-yard touchdown pass from Harmon to Zweifel to tie the score at 21 with only 28 seconds until half time.

RF dominated the first half in nearly every statistic but the score. The Falcons ran 51 plays compared to the Eagles' 23. RF out-gained LC on the ground and through the air, combining for 296 total yards compared to LC's 188.

RF also had a 2-1 advantage in time of possession because of touchdown drives of 78 and 73 yards. But LC capitalized on good field position by running quick drives and scoring on big plays. LC averaged 8.3 yards per play in the first half compared to RF's 5.8.

The second half began just as exciting as the first. LC returned the opening half kickoff 77 yards down to the RF 15 yard line. From there the Eagles took only one play, a 15-yard touchdown pass, to recapture the lead, 28-21.

After the teams traded punts, RF began a drive on the LC 46 yard line at the 9:50 mark of the third quarter. The Falcons took 11 plays to march the 46 yards they needed for the touchdown. The drive was capped by a six yard Anderson touchdown run on fourth and goal that brought the score back to tied, 28-28.

Anderson had another huge day for the Falcons on the ground. He carried the ball 38 times for 143 yards and four touchdowns. Anderson now has 4,010 yards in his career and is the leading Falcon rusher of all time.

LC continued to have great field position as Dan Hall returned the RF kickoff 44 yards to the RF 46 yard line. The Eagles capitalized on the field position again as they marched 46 yards in eight plays. The highlight of the drive was Moe's 18-yard touchdown pass to Mike Schmidt that put LC ahead 35-28 with 12 seconds left in the third quarter.

The fourth quarter proved to be all Eagles. The first RF drive of the fourth quarter ended with a failed fake punt conversion on fourth and 12 from the RF 26 that led to a four-play, 29-yard LC touchdown drive to put the Eagles ahead 42-28.

The Falcons drove 71 yards in 11 plays on their next drive that ended with a Harmon incomplete pass on fourth and goal from the LC six.

On the very next play from scrimmage LC's Dan Hall rushed 94 yards from his own six yard line for the definitive touchdown blow that put the game out of reach at 49-28 with 8:51 left in the game.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is a determined football coach.

The Falcons have finished 3-7 in each of the last three seasons and O'Grady is determined to return the football program to the success it enjoyed in the past.

A big change came last season when the Falcons ran a zone offense. That ended a streak of 30-plus years of the Falcons utilizing the run oriented wishbone offense. As with any change, there were growing pains. But O'Grady saw improvements throughout the season.

"Our offense is a strong run oriented system. We have to be able to run and pass the ball. It is still what I consider a strong rushing offense, but we need to do both well."

O'Grady will coach the Falcon offense again in 2007 and will get plenty of support from Assistant Coach Andy Kotelnicki who is the team's offensive coordinator.

When the Falcons put together back-to-back NCAA playoff appearances in 1995 and 1996, the Falcon defenses dominated opponents and played a key role in the team's success.

Many of the defensive coaches return and that gives the team needed consistency in coaching methods and strategies. "Jeff Rogers (linebackers) and Woody Fangmeier (defensive line) are assistant coaches who will all be back," said O'Grady. "They will be crucial to our success. We've been running the system for three years and we're all still learning it. Having the assistant coaches back will help in continuing our defensive improvement." The addition of former Falcon Scott Imrie to the staff is also a key. He will coach the defensive backs – the position he played with the Falcons from 1993-96.

O'Grady enters his 19th year as head coach at UWRP and stands second in all-time football wins with a 95-82-3 overall record. Among WIAC active coaches he is second in wins and is seventh in all-time wins of all WIAC coaches. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 18 seasons with the Falcons.

In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the NCAA playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the NCAA playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14).

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 68-58-3 record in WIAC play.

O'Grady, 53, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UWRP in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UWRP students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 181 of 182 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching and business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UWRP graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UWRP for 34 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, a special teams coach for several NFL teams, has been a counselor for 30 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has given presentations at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 17 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football camp in Gilman, Wis. The camp was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 26, Jaclyn, 23 and Logan 20. Lindsey, a UWRP graduate, is completing her master's degree in curriculum and instruction at the University of St. Thomas. Jaclyn graduated in 2005 from the University of Minnesota with a degree in film studies. She is now working on a master's degree in film studies in Australia. Logan studied for two years at St. Thomas but has transferred to UW-La Crosse and is majoring in communications. He was a member of the Tommie cross country and track & field teams the past two years and will compete with the Eagles highly successful cross country and track & field teams.

Oshkosh 35, Platteville 20

Andy Moriarty totaled 370 yards from scrimmage in his second straight dominating performance to lead the Titans to a 35-20 victory over UW-Platteville on Saturday in Platteville.

Moriarty, who rushed 50 times for 288 yards and two touchdowns in last Saturday's (Oct. 27) 27-10 win over UW-Stevens Point, ran 40 times for 314 yards and three touchdowns while catching two passes for 56 yards against UW-Platteville.

In addition to recording the Titans' second-best, single-game rushing performance for the second straight contest, Moriarty also counted his 250th career point against UW-Platteville to replace teammate Lucas Raschke as UW-Oshkosh's all-time leading scorer. Raschke now ranks second in UW-Oshkosh history with 246 career points.

UW-Platteville (2-7/1-5 WIAC) wasted no time getting on the scoreboard. After taking the opening kickoff, Terry Belville found Dan Schwartz for a 48-yard completion all the way down to the UW-Oshkosh one-yard line. UW-Platteville's nine-play, 67-yard drive stalled there as the Titans' defense shut down the Pioneers and held them to a 20-yard field goal by Tony Smidl.

UW-Oshkosh's offense responded with a nine-play, 95-yard drive of their own on their next possession. After Steve Stoltz reeled in a 12-yard pass, Moriarty rushed for 13 yards and then caught a pass for a gain of 53. Joe Patek (Sr. • Cedarburg) then hit Kyle Nakatsuji for a 16-yard touchdown to put the Titans up 7-3.

A wild series of events seemed to shift the momentum to UW-Oshkosh in the middle of the second quarter. Following a Titans' punt, the Pioneers appeared to be driving until Belville was intercepted by Nate Heard. Heard returned the interception 72 yards for a touchdown to increase UW-Oshkosh's lead to 14-3.

Josh Wara continued the Titans' strong defensive effort on the next drive by intercepting a long pass at the UW-Oshkosh three-yard line. However, he couldn't hold onto the ball as Nick Grosso forced and recovered the fumble at the Titans' one-yard line. The Pioneers took advantage on the ensuing play with a one-yard touchdown run from Tyson Droessler.

Once again, UW-Oshkosh responded to the score in a hurry. Jeremy Roach set up the offense with great field position by returning a kickoff 30 yards. Moriarty then broke free on the first play of the drive and took the rush 59 yards for a touchdown. Moriarty, UW-Oshkosh's all-time leading rusher (4,282 yards), eclipsed 4,000 career rushing yards on the jaunt to put the Titans in front 21-10 at halftime.

The Titans got a 26-yard run from Moriarty on the second half's opening drive, but Justin Athey sacked Patek on third down to force a UW-Oshkosh punt. The Pioneers' Nick Grosso made another big play by blocking the punt from Raschke. Justin Thompson recovered the loose ball and took it to the Titans' nine-yard line. UW-Oshkosh's red-zone defense came through again, forcing UW-Platteville to settle for a 24-yard field goal by Smidl that cut the Pioneers' deficit to 21-13.

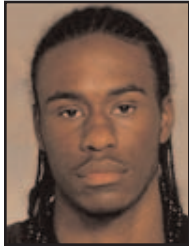
Bryan Kent came up with UW-Oshkosh's fourth interception of the day to assure the third period was a scoreless one. Kent picked off a Belville pass and returned it 30 yards to the UW-Platteville 15-yard line. Moriarty took over from there with two runs and got into the end zone from 10 yards out to stretch the Titans' advantage to 28-13.

UW-Platteville refused to go away and converted two clutch fourth down opportunities in the fourth quarter. Joe Burkeland entered the contest at quarterback and ran for 13 yards on fourth and three and completed a pass to Craig Patterson for 19 yards on fourth and eight to keep the drive alive. Belville concluded the possession with a seven-yard touchdown pass to Patterson that made the score 28-20.

UW-Oshkosh (6-3/3-3 WIAC) continued to give the ball to Moriarty on the next drive. Moriarty carried the football on all five plays and ran for a five-yard touchdown to give the Titans a 35-20 lead. He had gains of 38 and 30 yards on the possession.

Pat Cerroni was named Jan. 25 as the school's head football coach for the 2007 season.



Cerroni's appointment came two days after Phil Meyer resigned as UW-Oshkosh's head football coach to become the offensive line coach at the University of Minnesota.

"We're pleased to have Pat leading us for the upcoming 2007 season," said UW-Oshkosh Director of Athletics Allen Ackerman. "He will provide stability and consistency for our players and for our football program. This is an outstanding opportunity for Pat and we're all looking forward to a successful and exciting 2007 experience."

Cerroni, 41, has been UW-Oshkosh's defensive coordinator since the 2000 season. His position also included the supervision and guidance of all recruiting and summer camp activities related to the school's football program.

During the past seven seasons, especially the last five, Cerroni directed a UW-Oshkosh defense that ranked among the finest in the WIAC. Last fall, the Titans led the WIAC in red zone defense while ranking second in scoring defense and total defense. UW-Oshkosh also ranked second in the WIAC in total defense in 2003, 2004 and 2005 and third in 2002.

"I'm excited about this chance to lead the UW-Oshkosh football program," said Cerroni. "We all have worked hard to lay the foundation for this program the past seven years. My goal, and the goal of this staff, is to build on this foundation and keep it consistent. Our staff is committed to our players and we want all of them to be proud to be a Titan."

Cerroni came to UW-Oshkosh following three seasons as the head football coach at Menomonee Falls High School. In 1997, Cerroni guided the Indians to a 7-4 record and an upset of defending state champion Hartland Arrowhead High School in the first round of the Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association (WIAA) Division 1 Playoffs.

Prior to his head coaching stint at Menomonee Falls High School, Cerroni was as an assistant football coach at Hartland Arrowhead and Waukesha Catholic Memorial high schools. During his four seasons at Waukesha Catholic Memorial High School, Cerroni helped the Crusaders to Wisconsin Independent Schools Athletic Association (WISAA) Division 1 state titles in 1993 and 1996.

Last Season

Oshkosh 24, River Falls 0

The Falcon football team fell short of scoring on multiple possessions and was not able to stick with a strong Oshkosh offense as the Titans took a 24-0 win at Ramer Field Saturday night.

The first quarter made clear what the end result of the game would be. Both teams fizzled out on their first possession but Oshkosh capitalized on their second. Following a 2-yard punt return by the Titans' Steve Stoltz to the River Falls 45, UWO went on a mission to find paydirt. The anticipation did not last long thanks to Titan running back Andy Moriarty's 34-yard rumble to the RF 11. Moriarty would finish what he started three plays later on a 3-yard run for the game's first score.

The Falcons were forced to turn to the passing game due to minimal gain on the ground and proved to be somewhat successful. RF quarterback Jeremy Wolff locked in on receiver Josh Grover for much of the game. On the Falcons third possession on the game, Grover made his biggest impact with a 47-yard reception to bring RF to the Titan 47.

The drive continued into the second quarter, eventually ending in a Wolff toss up to Grover that was intercepted in the end zone by UWO's Ryan Radtke. Grover held the most impressive Falcon stat line of the night as he hauled in five receptions for 113 yards. Only two Falcon receivers caught passes, the other being Jake Jenson who

caught a seven yard dump off from Wolff in the second quarter to pick up a first down.

UWO would increase their lead with 9:53 remaining in the second quarter to 10 following a Lucas Raschke 36-yard field goal. The Titan field goal was their lone of the game as Raschke went 1-2 on the night, missing a 43-yard attempt in the fourth quarter.

Falcon running back Nathan Anderson was RF's only force on the ground as he closed out the half with three consecutive runs. Anderson rumbled to 101 yards in the game on 31 carries. It was his 13th 100+ yard rushing game of his career.

The second half did not prove to be any better for the Falcons. Behind by 17 following a UWO 57-yard touchdown reception by Steve Stoltz coming with 4:56 remaining in the third, RF was forced to rely on Wolff's passing arm. Wolff finished 6-20 passing for 120 yards. The Titan defense forced Wolff out of the pocket for much of the game and forced the senior quarterback to make plays on his feet. UWO kept Wolff on a leash and held him to only 18 yards on seven scampers. Wolff looked for Grover most the night and was unsuccessful on numerous attempts to get receiver David Ubbelohde the ball.

RF trailed by 17 going into the fourth and the Titan offense shattered any hopes of a Falcon comeback. RF was led in tackles by Ryan Agrimson, who racked up 11 in the game, seven being solo.
