The Game

- * The Falcons are at home again on Saturday when they host Pacific Lutheran at 1:30 p.m., at Ramer Field.
- * UWRF lost a 21-10 decision last weekend to St. John's at Ramer Field. The Falcons led, 10-0, at halftime, but SJU scored 221 third-quarter points to get the win. PLU opened its season at California Lutheran and went home with a 48-17 win.
- * This is the fourth meeting between the teams and the Falcons hold a 2-1 edge. PLU won the first game between the teams in 2004 (28-24). UWRF won at home in 2005 (45-14) and at PLU in 2006 (24-17).
- * Falcon senior running back Nate Anderson recorded his 15th career 100+ yard rushing game against a stingy St. John's defense. The workhorse carried the ball 30 times for 125 yards. He averaged 4.2 yards per carry.
- * The Falcons did not have a turnover in a 54-24 win over Hope on Sept. 1, but they made four in the loss to SJU. UWRF threw three interceptions and lost one of two fumbles.
- * Junior quarterback Storm Harmon had another good day. He was 20-39 passing for 210 yards and one touchdown. The SJU defense put a lot of pressure on Harmon and came up with three interceptions and four sacks. One interception was returned for a touchdown.
- * Falcon senior linebacker Bruce Baillargeon led the Falcons in tackles for the second straight week. He had 10 solo and 13 total stops. He leads the Falcons with 23 total tackles.
- * Senior end Gregg Neumann had six tackles including 2.5 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks against SJU. He has 12.5 career sacks.
- * Falcon Coach John O'Grady, in his 19th season at UWRF, has a 96-83-3 career record. He is a 1979 graduate of UWRF and is third among active WIAC coaches in wins.
- * PLU's Scott Westering has a 14-14 record and is in his fourth season with the Lutes.

- * After Saturday's game against Pacific Lutheran the Falcons do not play again until they open the WIAC season on Sept. 29 at UW-Stevens Point.

St. John's 21, River Falls 10

It was a tale of two halves at Ramer Field Saturday afternoon.

The ending had St. John's earn a come-from-behind 21-10 win over the Falcons in front of about 4,500 fans.

In the first half the Falcons scored 10 points to take a 10-0 lead into the locker room.

In the second half the Johnnies scored 21 points in the third quarter to take control of the contest.

The Falcon offense was completely shut down in the second half against the Johnnies, who entered the game as the nation's No. 3 ranked team.

The Falcons controlled play in the first half. After the Falcons went three and out to start the game, Falcon senior cornerback Shane Hanson intercepted a pass in the UWRF end zone that stopped a four-play, 29-yard SJU drive. SJU got the ball back after blocking a UWRF punt and taking over at the Falcon 13. But the Falcon defense stiffened and SJU missed a 27-yard field goal with 9:39 to play in the first quarter.

The Falcon offense then took control. Junior quarterback Storm Harmon completed 5-7 passes on the next drive including a 14-yard strike to freshman wide-out Michael Zweifel for the only Falcon touchdown of the day.

A 22-yard field goal by junior kicker Dan Keller was the only other scoring in the half as the Falcons took a 10-0 lead into halftime. The Falcons out-gained the Johnnies 213-91 in total offense and had the ball for nearly two-thirds of the first half.

The second half proved to be a different story with the Johnnies scoring three unanswered touchdowns in the third quarter. The first was a 1-yard Aaron Blackmore run that capped an 8-play, 61-yard opening half drive. Later in the quarter senior quarterback Alex Kofoed, who became St. John's all-time leader for total offense and passing yards during the game, completed a 36-yard touchdown pass to senior wide receiver Brian Weber. Then Johnnies senior cornerback Sam Gervais returned an interception 20 yards to end a quarter when the Johnnies only had the ball for 3:46 but scored 21 points.

The Falcons had chances in the fourth quarter. They started drives at the SJU 37, the UWRF 46 and the SJU 38. But the Johnnies defense didn't allow a point.

UWRF's Harmon completed 20-39 passes, a personal record for attempts, but was also intercepted three times, throwing two of them in the key third quarter. He passed for 210 yards. Senior running back Nathan Anderson had a good day gaining 125 yards on the ground. Sophomore tight end Ryan Hansen led the Falcons with seven receptions for 71 yards. Senior linebacker Bruce Baillargeon had 13 total tackles, 10 of them solo, and forced a fumble.

But in the end the No. 3 ranked Johnnies proved to be too much. St. John's Blackmore, a senior running back, gained 171 yards on the ground, the most by a SJU player since 2002.

Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is a determined football coach.

The Falcons have finished 3-7 in each of the last three seasons and O'Grady is determined to return the football program to the success it enjoyed in the past.

A big change came last season when the Falcons ran a zone offense. That ended a streak of 30-plus years of the Falcons utilizing the run oriented wishbone offense. As with any change, there were growing pains. But O'Grady saw improvements throughout the season.

"Our offense is a strong run oriented system. We have to be able to run and pass the ball. It is still what I consider a strong rushing offense, but we need to do both well."

O'Grady will coach the Falcon offense again in 2007 and will get plenty of support from Assistant Coach Andy Kotelnicki who is the team's offensive coordinator.

When the Falcons put together back-to-back NCAA playoff appearances in 1995 and 1996, the Falcon defenses dominated opponents and played a key role in the team's success.

Many of the defensive coaches return and that gives the team needed consistency in coaching methods and strategies. "Jeff Rogers (linebackers) and Woody Fangmeier (defensive line) are assistant coaches who will all be back," said O'Grady. "They will be crucial to our success. We've been running the system for three years and we're all still learning it. Having the assistant coaches back will help in continuing our defensive improvement." The addition of former Falcon Scott Imrie to the staff is also a key. He will coach the defensive backs – the position he played with the Falcons from 1993-96.

O'Grady enters his 19th year as head coach at UWRF and stands second in all-time football wins with a 95-82-3 overall record. Among WIAC active coaches he is second in wins and is seventh in all-time wins of all WIAC coaches. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 18 seasons with the Falcons.

In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the NCAA playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the NCAA playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14).

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 68-58-3 record in WIAC play.

O'Grady, 53, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UWRF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UWRF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 181 of 182 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching and business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UWRF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UWRF for 34 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, a special teams coach for several NFL teams, has been a counselor for 30 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has given presentations at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 17 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football camp in Gilman, Wis. The camp was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 26, Jaclyn, 23 and Logan 20. Lindsey, a UWRF graduate, is completing her master's degree in curriculum and instruction at the University of St. Thomas. Jaclyn graduated in 2005 from the University of Minnesota with a degree in film studies. She is now working on a master's degree in film studies in Australia. Logan studied for two years at St. Thomas but has transferred to UW-La Crosse and is majoring in communications. He was a member of the Tommie cross country and track & field teams the past two years and will compete with the Eagles highly successful cross country and track & field teams.

Pacific Lutheran 4 , California Lutheran 17

Each of the past two seasons, the Pacific Lutheran football team has gotten off to a slow start that has affected the remainder of the season. Such was not the case on Saturday as the Lutes made the most of seven Cal Lutheran turnovers to take a resounding 48-17 season-opening win at Mt. Clef Stadium.

It was total domination for the Lutes, who came up one yard shy of doubling Cal Lutheran's total yardage total. PLU netted 497 yards to just 249 for the Kingsmen, and it was in the rushing category that the Lutes really had their way as they gained 239 yards while limiting the hosts to minus five yards. PLU, which averaged more than three turnovers per game over the past two seasons, turned the ball over just once, that on a tipped end zone interception.

The Lutes jumped out to a 14-0 lead late in the first quarter, scoring a pair of touchdowns following Cal Lutheran turnovers. First, senior safety Evan Bratz made the first of his two interceptions and returned the ball to the Kingsmen 11-yard line. On third down, Anthony Canger swept in for a 7-yard touchdown run. On the ensuing possession, Cal Lutheran quarterback Jericho Toilolo fumbled the snap and Andy Holden fell on the ball for PLU. Lute quarterback Brett Gordon capped a four-play, 31-yard drive with a 21-yard keeper for the score.

After a Cal Lutheran field goal made the score 14-3, the Lutes scored a pair of second quarter touchdowns through the air. First, Gordon hit Chase Reed with a 23-yard score to cap a 67-yard drive, and then he connected with Craig Chiado on a 33-yard score, again following a CLU fumble recovered by Robert Thomsen.

The Kingsmen cut their deficit to 27-10 on a third quarter touchdown pass, but the Lutes responded with their best drive of the day for another score. Jacob Schonau-Taylor's one-yard run capped an 83-yard, 15-play drive that consumed 7:49 of the clock.

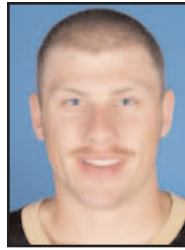
Yet another Cal Lutheran fumble led to the next Lutes' score, that coming on another one-yard plunge by Schonau-Taylor. The Lutes finished their scoring on a seven-yard run by freshman Kainoa Carlson, that set up when Kelly Morgan went 58 yards on his first collegiate carry.

The Kingsmen closed out the scoring with a touchdown in the waning seconds.

Canger led PLU's running game with 87 yards on 15 carries, while Gordon completed 22-of-36 passes for 249 yards with two touchdowns and one interception. Chiado was Gordon's favorite target as he finished with nine catches for 118 yards, though Reed was close behind with seven catches for 84 yards.

Defensively, the Lutes got a strong performance from Thomsen, a senior defensive end who had 3.5 tackles for loss and a quarterback sack among his team-high nine total tackles. Thomsen also recovered two fumbles. Neal Chalmers, Jeff Ebel and Matt Wolford all had five tackles, and Bratz had two of the Lutes' three interceptions.

Pacific Lutheran, which had lost four games in a row to start 2005 and three in a row to start last season, also ended a two-game losing streak to Cal Lutheran.

Scott Westering

has compiled a 13-14 overall record in three seasons as Pacific Lutheran University football head coach. Named to the position in February 2004, Scott took over for his father, Frosty, who served as PLU football head coach for 32 years.

He joined the coaching staff in 1981 and became the offensive coordinator two years later. During his coaching career, PLU has won two NAIA Division II and one NCAA Division III national championships and finished as the runner-up four times in 10 post-season appearances. He has coached 11 first-team All-Americans, including the 1999 NCAA Division III Player of the Year, Chad Johnson, and the Most Valuable Player of the 1999 national championship team, Anthony Hicks.

Westering played football at UCLA for one year before transferring to PLU, where he was a captain and All-America tight end on the 1980 NAIA national title team. Westering later had tryouts with the Buffalo Bills and San Francisco 49ers. He was inducted into the PLU Hall of Fame in 1998.

He earned his bachelor's degree in 1982 and his master's degree in 2002, both from PLU. He is also a physical education instructor at PLU.

Westering and his wife, Susan, an aerobics instructor at PLU, are the parents of three children, daughters Jordan and Jessi and son Kellen. The Westerings live in Puyallup.

The Falcons are 29-24 at Ramer Field since 1995. The Falcons last winning season at Ramer Field was in 2000, when they went 3-1. In conference play, the Falcons are 25-18 at Ramer Field since 1995, with their last winning season in 2001, when they finished 2-1. The Falcons last undefeated season at Ramer Field was in 1998, when they went 5-0 overall and 4-0 in conference play.

UWRF On The Road

The Falcons are 28-37 on the road since 1995. The Falcons last winning season on the road was in 2000, when they went 3-2 overall and 3-1 in conference play. The Falcons are 20-19 on the road in conference play since 1995. In 1999 and 2000 the Falcons finished with 3-1 records on the road in conference play.

UWRF At Neutral Sites

The Falcons are 4-1 at neutral sites since 1995. They have not played a neutral site game since 2000, when they lost to Bemidji State at the Metrodome, 23-20.

UWRF Football History

The first year of Falcon football was in 1895 when the team finished with a 2-0 record after playing and beating New Richmond High School twice. The first game against a collegiate team was in 1899 when the Falcons lost to Superior, 12-0. It wasn't until 1923 when the Falcons started playing only collegiate teams. UWRF has won 18 WIAC titles, third most of all WIAC institutions. The Falcons have a 476-317-49 record in 103 seasons.

Last Season

RIVER FALLS 24, PACIFIC LUTHERAN 17

The Falcons offense scored all of its points in the third quarter and the UWRF defense forced six turnovers as the visiting Falcons defeated Pacific Lutheran, 24-17, in a non-conference game played Saturday at Sparks Stadium.

The two teams combining to give the ball away 11 times. The Falcon defense picked off three PLU passes and recovered three fumbles. The Falcons offense lost three fumbles and threw two interceptions.

UWRF turned the ball over on each of its first three possessions and the Lutes scored after two of them.

Taking the ball on the Falcons' 30-yard line following a fumble recovery, the Lutes scored in two plays. Junior quarterback Brett Gordon connected with Craig Chiado on a 21-yard scoring play. It was the first collegiate pass thrown by Gordon. Later in the quarter and following a Brent Frank interception, the Lutes added three points in Pat Burke's 25-yard field goal.

That margin held into the third quarter when a pair of Bruce Baillargeon interceptions on consecutive PLU possessions turned the momentum to the Falcons.

Baillargeon's first interception and 29-yard return gave the

Falcons the ball at PLU 20-yard line, and on the next play UW-RF quarterback Jeremy Wolff broke through a tackle and went the distance to cut the Falcons deficit to 10-7. Following the second interception, UW-RF took over at its own 24-yard line. After a one-yard loss, Wolff hit Josh Grover behind the PLU secondary for a 77-yard scoring play. The extra point kick by Spasimir Bodurski gave the Falcons a 14-10 lead.

UWRF stretched the advantage to 21-10 after Gordon was sacked and fumbled. Nathan Renk recovered at the PLU 8-yard line for the Falcons, who scored three plays later on Wolff's one-yard scoring run. On the ensuing kickoff, PLU ran some trickery on the return when Chase Reed threw across the field to Brent Frank, who raced down the left sideline for an apparent score. The play was called back, however, when it was ruled the Reed's throw was an illegal forward pass.

With 1:41 left in the third period and following PLU's fourth turnover - this a fumble in as many possessions - Bodurski kicked a 42-yard field goal to give the Falcons a 24-10 lead.

The Lutes got back into the game, driving 64 yards on eight plays and scoring early in the fourth period on Gordon's 25-yard pass to Reed. In their final four possessions, however, the Lutes punted twice, threw an interception and turned the ball over on downs.
