## The Game

\* The Falcons play their second game of the season, and first at home, on Saturday when they host St. John's at 1 p.m., at Ramer Field.

\* St. John's is ranked No. 3 in this week's D3Football.com poll. Mount Union (1-0) is No. 1 followed by Whitewater (1-0).

\* This is the fourth meeting between the teams and the Johnnies hold a 3-1 lead in the all-time series. SJU has won three straight games in the series including a 41-9 decision at Clemens Stadium last year.

\* Falcon senior running back Nate Anderson has had 14 100+ yard rushing games in his career. He just missed the mark last week at Hope; he finished with 94 yards. He may have passed the 100 yard mark but he was taken from the game in the second half due to the heat.

\* The Falcons have not won a home opener since 1998 when they defeated Southwest State, 30-27.

\* Punter Eric Stoller played in his first collegiate game and averaged 36 yards on four kicks. He had one downed inside the 20 and had a long of 42.

\* Despite 78 points being scored, neither UWRF or Hope turned the ball over. Hope fumbled, but made the recovery.

\* The 54 points is the most scored by a Falcon team since a 65-44 win over Eau Claire on Oct. 14, 2000. The season-opening win for the Falcons was the first since the 1996 season.

\* A win on Saturday would give the Falcons a 2-0 record and it would be the first time since the 1996 season that UWRF started the season 2-0.

\* Falcon Coach John O'Grady, in his 19th season at UWRF, has a 96-82-3 career record. He is a 1979 graduate of UWRF and is third among active WIAC coaches in wins.

\* SJU's John Gagliardi is in his 59th season as a head college coach and his 55th year with the Johnnies. He has a 443-120-11 (.781) collegiate career record and a 419-114-10 (.782) record at SJU.

**River Falls 54, Hope 24**

The Falcons exploded for 54 points in a 54-24 season-opening win at Hope College in Holland, Mich.

Sophomore quarterback Storm Harmon's first collegiate start was a memorable one. He completed 17-24 passes for 306 yards and four touchdowns. He finished just three yards short of setting a single game passing record. Jerry Trooien passed for 309 yards in a game against Whitewater in 1969. The four touchdown passes ties a single game mark. Adam Kowles threw four touchdown passes in a 1995 game against Eau Claire.

Freshman wide receiver Michael Zweifel also put his name in the records book while playing in his first collegiate game. He caught 10 passes for 158 yards. The 10 receptions breaks the school record of nine set by Joe Rozak against Whitewater in 1969.

The Falcons scored the first three times they had the ball to grab a 22-0 lead. On the team's first possession, Harmon hit tight end Ryan Hansen over the middle for a 43-yard scoring play that capped a five-play, 73-yard drive. Running back Nathan Anderson scored the two-point conversion. Fullback Cory Danielson scored on a at three-yard run with 8:08 to play and with Dan Keller's extra point the Falcons led 15-0. The drive covered 76 yards in nine plays. Just three minutes later Zweifel caught a 21-yard pass from Harmon to cap a seven-play, 49-yard drive. With just seven seconds to play in the first quarter, Hope got on the scoreboard on a 32-yard field goal.

The Falcons scored 11 points in the second quarter to take a 33-3 lead into halftime.

At 10:59 wide receiver Josh Grover and Harmon connected on a 45-yard pass play. The Falcons took just two plays to go 47 yards for the score. Tight end Connor Graves scored on a two-point conversion pass play. Keller then booted a 28-yard field goal with 6:38 to play in the first half.

Hope got some life in the second half when they scored on a four-yard touchdown pass to make it a 33-10 game. But the Falcons struck back with 2:03 to play in the third quarter when Graves grabbed a six-yard pass from Harmon to make it 40-10.

The teams didn't let up in the fourth quarter with each club scoring two touchdowns.

Hope climbed to within 40-17 on a five-yard pass play with 11:54 to go in the game. But freshman quarterback Ryan Luessenheide, in her first collegiate series, led the Falcons on a 12-play, 48-yard drive. Luessenheide scored on a one-yard run to give UWRF a 47-17 lead.

The Flying Dutchman scored with 3:40 to play on a 34-yard passing play that culminated a 10-play, 63-yard drive. The Falcons got the ball back one more time and didn't waste the opportunity. Running back Brandon Trzebiatowski scored on a 40-yard run with 2:38 to play to end the offensive onslaught.

UWRF gained 505 total yards with 336 coming throw the air and 169 on the ground. Anderson led the Falcon rushing attached with 94 yards on 17 carries. Luessenheide completed 4-6 passes for 30 yards. Grover had six catches for 108 yards, Hansen three for 60 and Graves two for 10. Grover returned two kick offs for 53 yards.

The Falcon defense also played well in limiting Hope to 116 rushing and 344 total yards. Linebacker Bruce Baillargeon led the Falcons with three solo and 10 total tackles. End Michael Mueller had nine tackles. Strong safety Joe Simonson and defensive back Ross Potter each had eight tackles. The Falcons have seven tackles for loss led by end Steve Marish who had two and one-half, including a sack. UWRF had four total sacks - Potter, linebacker Jesse Goebel and tackle Mike Larson had the others.

## Head Coach John O'Grady

John O'Grady is a determined football coach.

The Falcons have finished 3-7 in each of the last three seasons and O'Grady is determined to return the football program to the success it enjoyed in the past.

A big change came last season when the Falcons ran a zone offense. That ended a streak of 30-plus years of the Falcons utilizing the run oriented wishbone offense. As with any change, there were growing pains. But O'Grady saw improvements throughout the season.

"Our offense is a strong run oriented system. We have to be able to run and pass the ball. It is still what I consider a strong rushing offense, but we need to do both well."

O'Grady will coach the Falcon offense again in 2007 and will get plenty of support from Assistant Coach Andy Kotelnicki who is the team's offensive coordinator.

When the Falcons put together back-to-back NCAA playoff appearances in 1995 and 1996, the Falcon defenses dominated opponents and played a key role in the team's success.

Many of the defensive coaches return and that gives the team needed consistency in coaching methods and strategies. "Jeff Rogers (linebackers) and Woody Fangmeier (defensive line) are assistant coaches who will all be back," said O'Grady. "They will be crucial to our success. We've been running the system for three years and we're all still learning it. Having the assistant coaches back will help in continuing our defensive improvement." The addition of former Falcon Scott Imrie to the staff is also a key. He will coach the defensive backs – the position he played with the Falcons from 1993-96.

O'Grady enters his 19th year as head coach at UWRF and stands second in all-time football wins with a 95-82-3 overall record. Among WIAC active coaches he is second in wins and is seventh in all-time wins of all WIAC coaches. In WIAC play O'Grady has led the Falcons to one first place finish (1998), three second place finishes (1994, 1995, 1996) and five third place finishes (1989, 1992, 1999, 2000, 2001). He has had winning seasons in 10 of his 18 seasons with the Falcons.

In 1998, the Falcons surprised most WIAC observers. The team finished 7-3 overall and 5-2 in the WIAC good for a tie for first place. In 1996 the team finished 9-2 overall and lost to La Crosse (44-0) in the first round of the NCAA playoffs. In 1995 the Falcons were 9-3 overall. The nine wins tied the school record. In the NCAA playoffs the Falcons beat Central, Iowa, (10-7) but then lost to La Crosse (28-14).

O'Grady was named the 1995 WIAC Coach of the Year. His teams have compiled a 68-58-3 record in WIAC play.

O'Grady, 53, played for the Falcons (linebacker) from 1972-75 and earned four letters. He was the team captain and voted most dedicated in 1975 when the Falcons won their first WIAC title in 18 years.

He coached for two years at Miami University of Ohio as an offensive line coach and offensive special teams coordinator. Before that, he coached at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (1985-86) as an offensive line coach and special teams coordinator, at Kent State University, Ohio, where he was offensive coordinator/offensive line and offensive special teams coordinator (1983-84), and at the University of Wisconsin as a part time assistant coach of tight ends and special teams (1981-82). He also was an assistant at UW-River Falls (1976-80) as a linebacker, secondary and special teams coach.

O'Grady played football at Sullivan High School, Chicago, Ill., from 1968-71 and was team captain, most valuable player and winner of a coach's award as a senior. He is a native of Worcester, Mass.

He earned his undergraduate degree in physical education from UW-River Falls in 1979 and his master's degree in supervision and instructional leadership from UWRF in 1983. Besides coaching football, O'Grady teaches classes in the University's health and human performance department.

O'Grady is a firm believer in education and helps all UWRF students in pursuit of collegiate degrees. In his career as head coach, 181 of 182 Falcon football players, who have completed four seasons of eligibility, have earned undergraduate degrees. Several have gone on to highly successful careers in education, coaching and business.

He runs three summer football camps - Wishbone, Kickers and Big O & D. About 400 participants and 75 coaches, many of them are UWRF graduates, attend the camps each summer. The Kickers Camp has been a mainstay at UWRF for 34 years and has had top NFL and college kickers attend as counselors. Gary Zauner, a special teams coach for several NFL teams, has been a counselor for 30 years.

O'Grady is well known as a speaker and clinician throughout the midwest. He has given presentations at the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association spring clinic several times and has addressed participants at the Indiana Wishbone Coaches Association clinic. He has been invited to give clinics in Wisconsin, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Indiana and Minnesota. For the past 17 years he has worked with former Falcon football player and teammate, Darryl Herrick, at a football camp in Gilman, Wis. The camp was established by Herrick, who is the superintendent of the Cedarburg school district, in memory of a nephew who was killed in a hunting accident.

He and wife, Jody, have three children: Lindsey, 26, Jaclyn, 23 and Logan 20. Lindsey, a UWRF graduate, is completing her master's degree in curriculum and instruction at the University of St. Thomas. Jaclyn graduated in 2005 from the University of Minnesota with a degree in film studies. She is now working on a master's degree in film studies in Australia. Logan studied for two years at St. Thomas but has transferred to UW-La Crosse and is majoring in communications. He was a member of the Tommie cross country and track & field teams the past two years and will compete with the Eagles highly successful cross country and track & field teams.

## St. John's 55, Marietta 14

The nationally-ranked Saint John's University football team opened its 2007 season with a 55-14 win over Marietta College, Ohio, in front of 7,764 fans at Clemens Stadium.

SJU out-gained the Pioneers 484-187 in the game in addition to an 8-for-8 showing in the red zone. Senior quarterback Alex Kofoed was 18 of 24 passing for 249 yards and three touchdowns, two of which were six-yard connections to sophomore wide receiver Ben Vanderheyden.

Kofoed opened the scoring with a two-yard touchdown pass to sophomore running back Kellen Blaser. A 34-yard field goal by junior place kicker/punter Russell Gliadon gave the Johnnies an early 10-0 lead. Vanderheyden caught his first touchdown pass, which was also his first career reception, with 12:49 left in the second quarter. Kofoed added a one-yard touchdown run halfway through the second quarter, followed by a 35-yard field goal by Gliadon to close out the first half with SJU ahead, 27-0. Gliadon's became the first SJU kicker since Anthony Schmidt (Sept. 24, 2005 at Gustavus Adolphus) to successfully kick two field goals in a game.

Kofoed hit Vanderheyden with another six-yard touchdown pass to open the second half and rest the first-team offense for good. Junior wide receiver Bryan Busack extended the Johnnies' lead to 41-0 with a four-yard touchdown reception from sophomore quarterback Jordan Hansel. Freshman quarterback Joe Boyle slashed his way for a 13-yard touchdown run late in the third quarter to give SJU a 48-0 lead. Sophomore linebacker Ethan Eid intercepted an errant pass from Marietta sophomore quarterback Dexter Hughes and returned it 89 yards to paydirt, ending the scoring for SJU. The interception return for touchdown is the fourth longest in SJU history.

Marietta fought back in the fourth quarter with two touchdowns in the final 3:30. Freshman tight end Camden Dierkes caught a nine-yard pass from sophomore quarterback Ryan Merrill to spoil the shutout. Shortly after, sophomore running back George Davis scampered for a six-yard touchdown to end the scoring for both teams.

Senior wide receiver Brian Weber led the Johnnies with 117 yards on six catches, while junior tight end Brett Saladin caught five passes for 79 yards. Senior running back Aaron Blackmore led the SJU running attack with 69 yards on 17 carries (4.1 avg.).

Defensively, senior safety Kevin Boegel and junior defensive end Mike Schumacher collected six tackles each. Junior defensive lineman Joe Luke added 3.0 tackles for loss including 1.5 sacks in the game. Freshman linebacker Billy Lawrence and junior defensive back Derek Stifter added an interception each for the Johnnies, who forced four turnovers total in the contest.

Hughes led the Pioneers with 119 yards thru the air, while George Davis gained 42 yards on 11 carries. Freshman wide receiver Ryan Dawson totaled 58 yards receiving on five catches.

## John Gagliardi is



the first active head coach to be inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame (Class of 2006), Saint John's University legendary head coach John Gagliardi will begin his record 59th season as a collegiate head football coach and 55th season as head coach in Collegeville in 2007. The winningest coach all-time in college football history, Gagliardi (Guh-lahr-dee) currently owns a 443-120-11 (.781) collegiate career record and a 419-114-10 (.782) record at SJU. Gagliardi's 58 years of collegiate coaching is the most in college football history, surpassing the old record of 57 years held by former University of Chicago and Pacific University coach Amos Alonzo Stagg (1890-1946).

Gagliardi tied the all-time collegiate win record, held by former Grambling State head coach Eddie Robinson, on Nov. 1, 2003 and broke the all-time record on Nov. 8, 2003 on the way to a perfect 14-0 season and an NCAA championship.

Gagliardi's coaching career began when his high school coach at Trinidad, Colo. Catholic was drafted into World War II, Gagliardi, as captain, took over the reins at the age of 16 in 1943. His teams won four conference titles in Gagliardi's six years of coaching high school at Trinidad Catholic and St. Mary's in Colorado Springs.

After graduation from Colorado College in 1949, his first college coaching position was at Carroll College in Helena, Mont. The college was thinking about dropping football because of losing seasons and lack of interest.

Gagliardi led Carroll to three conference titles in his first four seasons as a college coach. Gagliardi coached basketball and baseball and also won championships.

His success caught the attention of Saint John's University in Collegeville, Minn. Saint John's needed a coach to succeed the legendary Johnny "Blood" McNally, a charter member of the Professional Football Hall of Fame.

Compared to Carroll, Saint John's football program was healthy before Gagliardi's arrival but not exactly thriving. SJU had not won a conference title in 15 years. Gagliardi took over the program in 1953 with a mandate to turn the program around. Meanwhile, Blood offered this gloomy prediction: "Nobody could ever win at Saint John's."

Once again, Gagliardi surprised the skeptics by winning the MIAC title that fall. He also won championships with SJU's track team, and he also coached the SJU hockey team for five seasons, compiling a 42-25-1 record, which is still the best career winning percentage of any hockey coach in school history.

The Johnnies opened the game up quickly scoring on their first possession. Mike Patnode scored on a six-yard run, which capped off an eight play 88-yard drive. Midway through the first quarter the Falcon defense stepped up and scored a touchdown on Jamie Bisch's 39-yard interception return to make the score 7-6 after a missed Spasmir Boduski extra point. The score after the first quarter was St. John's leading 7-6.

St. John's scored quickly in the second quarter after a botched punt attempt. Patnode scored on the next play this time from six-yards out to make the score 13-6 after a missed extra point. On RF's next possession Jermey Wolff through a pass that was intercepted by John Cloeter and returned to the 34-yard line. The Johnnies scored three plays later on a Alex Kofoed pass to Mike Lofboom from four yards out to cap off a three play 34-yard drive to make the score 20-6 SJU. Shane Hanson recovered a Lofboom fumbled punt return with 18 seconds left in the first half. Bodurski's 25-yard field goal with one second left in the half capped off a three play seven-yard drive to make the score SJU leading 20-9 at recess.
