

Proposal for program changes in Modern Language Majors and Minors

The following changes in the Modern Language programs would need to be made to match with the changes in Wisconsin Teaching Laws.

Professional Education:

Remove TED 414 and 423 from the professional education requirements.

Rational: This would reflect changes in license laws comparable with other approved Early Childhood - Adolescence (K-12) programs offered through River Falls.

Modern Language Education first and second majors with the following options/subplans:

- Option in German Education
- Option in French Education
- Option in Spanish Education

Current program requirement in the major

Required supporting coursework:

- TED 437 Secondary Techniques in Modern Languages 2 cr.
- ##### 350 phonetics course specific to option

Proposed Change

- Add - TED 448 Techniques of Elementary Education: Modern Languages 2 cr. To the list of required supporting coursework

Rational: Adding the 2 credit elementary techniques is necessary due to the changes in the licensing rules The developmental range of instruction for modern languages was changed from grades 6-12 to K-12. (early childhood through adolescence)

Current supporting course requirement:

- TED 437 Techniques of Middle/Secondary Education: Modern Language

Proposed Change: Replace TED 437 with TED 448 Techniques of Elementary Education: Modern Languages

Rational: New course reflects instructional methods to appropriate license level.

German Minor Elementary Education Option/subplan

Current supporting course requirement:


